A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this day, the disciples of Jesus praised Him as He entered Jerusalem, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." However, the tone abruptly changed, and only a few days later, the palm and olive branches were replaced by the wood of the cross. On Palm Sunday, Christ was lifted up by shouts of praise. On Good Friday, Christ was lifted up on the cross. On Easter Sunday, Christ was lifted up in glory and lifts us up by His mercy and grace.



Hosanna is not only the song of the first disciples; it is our song. We acclaim it at every Mass as we greet and receive our Savior coming among us to offer the sacrament of the sacrifice of His body and blood, the Eucharist: "Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest." Holy Week is remembered and realized in every Mass, which is when Christ comes to us and offers Himself on our behalf as He did on that first Good Friday. The Eucharist is the perpetual memorial of the sacrifice of Christ, recalling the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus. Every Mass reaches back to the sacrifice of Christ, and in it, He gives Himself to us, holding nothing back. He walks with us and gives us mercy, hope, and salvation.

My prayer is that as we walk with Jesus this Holy Week, remembering the most powerful, humble, and loving act the world has ever seen, we may also become ever more aware of the timelessness of Jesus' loving act of redemption, memorialized in the very sacrament Jesus instituted as He began His work of salvation on Holy Thursday: the Holy Eucharist, the Mass. May this week be an opportunity to see, know, and love Christ as well as be a time for renewal: renewing our faith and our awareness of Christ's presence, mercy, and redemption. I would like to encourage you to take part in the special liturgies and devotions this week. May each and every one of you have a blessed and fruitful Holy Week and a Happy Easter.

The Easter Vigil

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

En este día, el domingo antes de la crucifixión de Jesús, nuestro Señor entró a Jerusalén y sus discípulos le saludaron con alabanzas: "¡Hosanna! ¡Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor, el rey de Israel!". Sin embargo, el tono cambió bruscamente y los ramos fueron reemplazados por la madera de la cruz. El Domingo de Ramos, Cristo fue elevado por gritos de alabanza. El Viernes Santo fue elevado por la cruz. El Domingo de Pascua, fue elevado en la gloria y entonces nos eleva por su gracia y misericordia.

Hosanna no es solamente el canto de los primeros discípulos; es nuestro canto. Es la canción que aclamamos en cada misa para saludar y recibir a nuestro salvador que viene entre nosotros para ofrecer el sacramento del sacrificio de su cuerpo y sangre, la Eucaristía: "Santo, Santo, Santo es el Señor, Dios del universo. Llenos están el cielo y la tierra de tu gloria. Hosanna en el cielo. Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor. Hosanna en el cielo." La Semana Santa es recordada y realizada en cada misa, cuando Cristo viene a nosotros y se ofrece como lo hizo en el primer Viernes Santo. La Eucaristía es el memorial perpetuo del sacrificio de Cristo, recordando la pasión, la muerte y la resurrección de Jesús. Cada misa se remonta al sacrificio de Cristo y en la eucaristía encontramos a Cristo que se ofrece él mismo por amor a nosotros, camina con nosotros y nos da misericordia, esperanza y salvación.

Mi oración es que mientras caminamos con Jesús en esta Semana Santa, recordando la acción más poderosa, humilde y amorosa que el mundo ha visto, estemos más conscientes de la intemporalidad de la acción de amor y redención de Jesús, recordada en el sacramento que Jesús instituyó cuando comenzó su obra de salvación el jueves santo: la Sagrada Eucaristía, la misa. Esta semana es una oportunidad de ver, conocer y amar a Cristo y renovar nuestra fe. Me gustaría animarles a participar en las devociones y liturgias especiales de Semana Santa y el Domingo de la Pascua de la Resurrección. Que todos y cada uno de ustedes tengan una Semana Santa bendecida y una Feliz Pascua.


MAUNDY THURSDAY

Jesus shared the feast of the Passover with His disciples. The Last Supper established Communion, sharing in the elements of bread and wine in remembrance of Jesus' sacrifice. Later, Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane and prayed in agony to God the Father. It was in the garden that Jesus was betrayed with a kiss by Judas Iscariot and arrested.



GOOD FRIDAY

Jesus was wrongly sentenced to death by crucifixion. Soldiers pierced His with a crown of thorns. Jesus then carried His own cross to Golgotha where He was mocked and insulted as He was nailed to the wooden cross. After many hours, Jesus breathed His last breath and died. By dying on the cross, Jesus paid for the sins of all mankind.




HOLY SATURDAY

This is the seventh day of the week, the day Jesus rested in the tomb. Jesus' body lay in His tomb, where it was guarded by Roman soldiers throughout the day. Holy Saturday is a time of reflection and waiting, the time of weeping that lasts for the night while awaiting the joy that comes in the morning.



EASTER SUNDAY

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most important event of the Christian faith. Early Sunday morning, several women went to the tomb and discovered that the large stone covering the entrance had been rolled away. An angel announced Jesus' resurrection. Jesus Christ made at least five appearances as recorded in the gospels.


