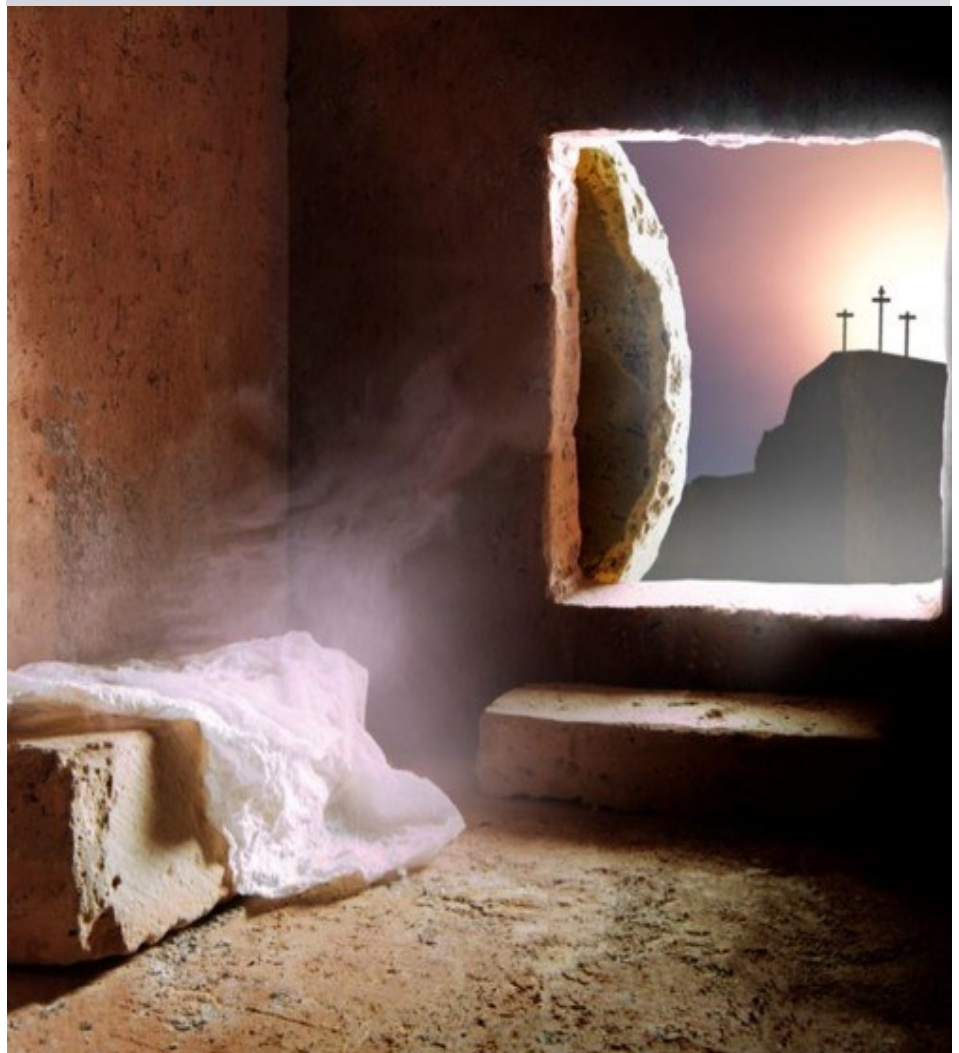

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

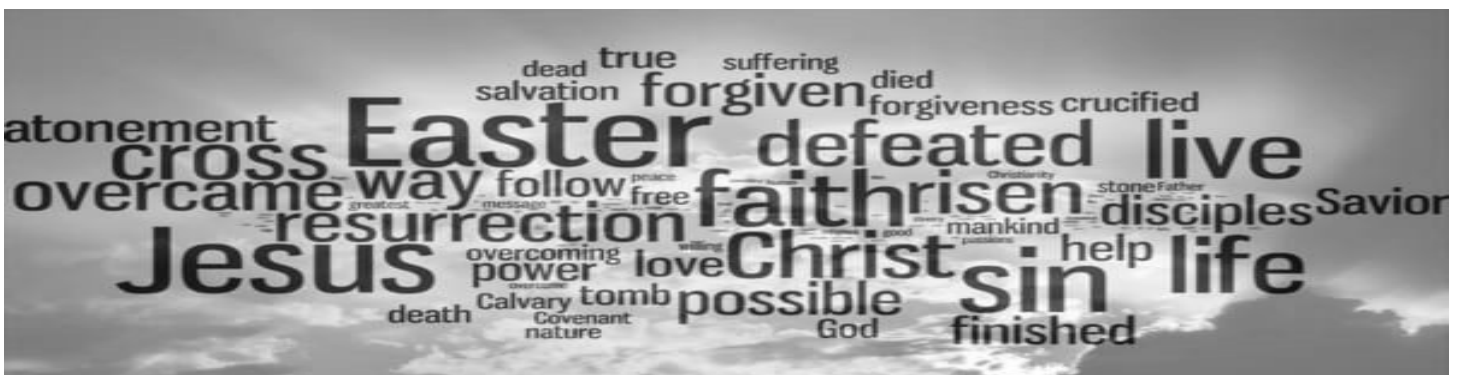
¡El Señor ha resucitado! ¡Aleluia!

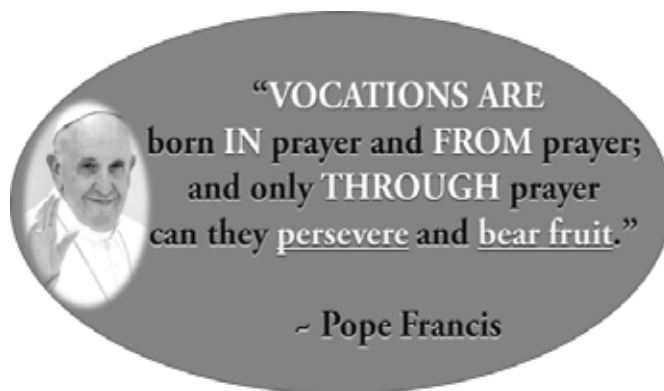

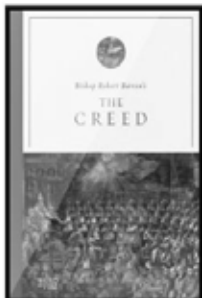
