#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

#### UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In our Gospel this weekend, we hear that the risen Lord appeared to the Apostles and "opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, 'Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning



from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things." You are witnesses of these things. The Apostles saw Christ risen in the flesh. Jesus even ate in front of them. He was not a ghost. The Apostles saw the risen Lord and were able to understand what the resurrection meant when they received the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. From that day on, they incessantly preached the Good News near and far. Their witness was constant and authentic. They did not teach, sanctify, and lead for profit, and nor was it the popular or easy thing to do. They suffered persecutions, imprisonment, and even martyrdom. Why did they persevere? Because they were convicted, and they were strengthened and guided by the Holy Spirit. The Apostles saw with their own eyes that Lord has truly been raised. Christ has conquered sin and death and has given us the gifts of the Holy Spirit, grace, and eternal life. The promise of heaven awaits.

So today we recall that we have received such a precious gift: the faith handed down to us from the Apostles. Through the ministry of the Apostles, they handed down what they had received: not just teachings, but also the Holy Spirit, the same Holy Spirit that descended upon them on Pentecost. The Holy Spirit is at work through the Church and in the sacraments. We profess this during the creed when, after professing faith in the Holy Spirit, we profess our belief in the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church.

Let us take this time to ask the Risen Lord to renew our faith so that we can be authentic and joyful witnesses to the Good News. Christ has truly been risen. Alleluia!




