

Alleluia! The words of praise to God for the gift of salvation through Jesus Christ! Alleluia! How sweet to shout these special ancient words of praise, together as a Church with all the faithful throughout the world, on Easter Sunday.

Alleluia, sin does not have the final word, but God's mercy and self-giving love! I am always moved to my knees whenever I think of how God has shown us the power of His Divine Love, through the resurrection of Jesus. When we are buried in the misery of sin, God tells us that He has our back and will call us forth by the flesh to enter in His Kingdom. God loves us this much that He restores our broken relationship with Him and made it even more special, because humanity got to see the Incarnation and Resurrection. On Easter Vigil, we proclaim the words "O happy fault!" because by sin, we got to see the amazing glory of God in Jesus Christ. I encourage us to share this message to as many people as we can, because everyone needs to hear this. This is the heart of our victory cry.

Alleluia, death does not prevail, but everlasting life in Jesus Christ! At the heart of Holy Week, I presided over the funeral of Bonnie Greg, whose story of faith and courage amidst her suffering has personally encouraged me to carry my own cross through all the challenges of my priestly ministry. How appropriate indeed that she passed away on the eve of Palm Sunday, so that she can experience the glory of Easter from the other side of life. She who has carried her cross graciously and with confidence gets to see the full splendor of the resurrection. That Jesus is victorious over death gives us a blessed reassurance that as we cling to Him, we may share His Cross, but will also share in His resurrection. One way or the other, we experience loss in this life, be it the loss of relationship, the loss of something special, or the loss of our very own self. These forms of death open the door to the fullness of the essence of our being, as we are purified and renewed by the water of life. We are indeed people of the resurrection because of our baptism; we rise to everlasting life through the doorways of loss and death. What a great message for many of us who experience loss in our lifetime.

Alleluia, I thank God for you! During the Lenten Season and everything else leading to this new Season, our church has worked hard and devoted much time, talent and treasure to offer a meaningful and solemn Lenten journey. Our Holy Week went very well, and this is all because of the generosity of so many. I thank you for your efforts, and I ask God to bless you abundantly.

Beloved parishioners, I greet you and your loved ones with the holy greeting: Happy Easter! I pray that this time of rebirth and renewal bring us joy and unfailing hope as a community of faith. May this season be filled with reasons to be grateful, and opportunities to manifest of our love of God and His Church. On behalf of Fr. John Horan, Deacons Nestor, Greg, David and Rocco, our staff and parish leaders, I greet you with great jubilation: Happy Easter!





Proyectos de ley del aborto EXTREMOS
Presentados en la Asamblea Legislativa de Illinois

HB 2467 y SB 1594:

Deroga la Ley de Notificación a los Padres sobre el Aborto de Illinois

La ley actual exige que se le notifique a alguno de los padres o al tutor legal cuando un menor de edad busca practicarse un aborto. Incluye una exención para aquellos niños que sufrieron abusos físicos o sexuales. Se aprobó en 1995, sin embargo, no se implementó hasta 2013 gracias a un fallo *unánime* del Tribunal Supremo de Illinois.

HB 2495 y SB 1942:

- *Deroga* la prohibición estatal actual de los abortos por nacimientos parciales.
- Define el aborto como un derecho fundamental.
- Elimina el clínicas de abortos de los reglamentos para procedimientos médicos importantes.
- Elimina el requisito de que solo los médicos pueden realizar un aborto.
- Nos encontramos estudiando el proyecto de ley para generar un mayor impacto.




