Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday we begin Passiontide. There are only two more weeks until Easter. One of the aspects most noticeable about this time is the covering of the statues and crucifixes with purple veils. This recalls St. John's observation in the eighth chapter of the Gospel that Jesus Himself hid during the last couple of weeks before His betrayal and crucifixion. These two weeks, along with the devotions and liturgies that accompany them, help us to be more aware of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord and enter into it. Every Good Friday since I was a kid, I have tried to remain silent from noon to three, because that is when our Lord hung upon the cross. Setting that time aside on Good Friday in a quiet and simple manner helps me to experience the crucifixion of our Lord. During these next two weeks, I ask you to be intentional about praying, particularly with our Lord's final days before the Resurrection. The Stations of the Cross, the Gospel accounts of the Passion of Christ, reflections on the Seven Last Words of Christ, the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, prayers before the crucifix, and the daily Mass readings are all helpful ways to reflect upon and meditate on our Lord's final days and enter into and experience the story. The story is full of drama, and the more we pray with it, the less we will see it simply as the Lord's story and more as our Lord entering into our story. He entered into the darkness and isolation of this world with us so that He would conquer it and give us hope. He also gave us someone to help us: the Blessed Mother. At the foot of the cross, the Beloved Disciple looked upon the cross, trying to make sense of the suffering and death of our Lord, and at that moment, our Lord gave Mary to the Beloved Disciple and to all disciples to be our mother. She shows us how to trust God and how to follow Him; she keeps us close to Jesus. If you haven't prayed the rosary in while, I encourage you to do so, particularly the Sorrowful mysteries. May our Blessed Mother keep you close to our Lord now and always.

Know of my daily prayers for you, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

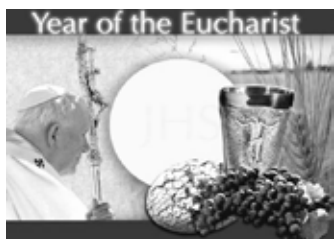
Este domingo comenzamos las dos semanas antes de la Pascua. Uno de los aspectos más notables de esta época es la cobertura de las estatuas y crucifijos con velos morados. Esta recuerda la observación de San Juan en el octavo capítulo del Evangelio que Jesús se ocultó durante las últimas semanas antes de su traición y crucifixión. Estas dos semanas con sus devociones y liturgias nos ayudan a estar más conscientes de la

Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección de nuestro Señor y entrar en ellas. Todos los Viernes Santos desde que yo era niño, he tratado de estar en silencio desde el mediodía hasta las tres porque es cuando nuestro Señor estuvo en la cruz. Establecer ese tiempo los Viernes Santos en una manera tranquila y sencilla me ayuda a experimentar la acción de Cristo. Durante las próximas dos semanas, les pido que ustedes estén intencionales sobre la oración, particularmente con los últimos días de nuestro Señor antes de la Resurrección. Las estaciones del Vía crucis, las lecturas de la Pasión de Cristo, las reflexiones sobre las siete últimas palabras de Cristo, los misterios dolorosos del rosario, las oraciones ante el crucifijo y las lecturas diarias de la misa son formas útiles de reflexionar y meditar en los últimos días de nuestro Señor y experimentar y entrar en la historia. La historia está llena de drama, y lo más que oremos con ella, lo más que la Pasión del Señor no parezca simplemente ser la historia del Señor pero ser la historia de nuestro Señor entrando en nuestra historia. Entró en la oscuridad y el aislamiento de este mundo con nosotros para conquistarlo y darnos esperanza. También él nos dio alguien para ayudarnos: la

Santísima Madre. Al pie de la cruz, el discípulo amado miró a la cruz, tratando de entender el sufrimiento y la muerte de Cristo, y en ese momento nuestro Señor le dio a María al discípulo amado y a todos los discípulos para que sea nuestra madre. Ella nos enseña a confiar en Dios y seguirlo; ella nos mantiene cerca de Jesús. Si no han rezado el rosario desde hace mucho tiempo, les animo a que lo hagan, especialmente los misterios dolorosos. Que nuestra Santísima Madre nos mantenga cerca de nuestro Señor ahora y siempre.

Rezo por ustedes y por favor sigan rezando por mí y por los demás.

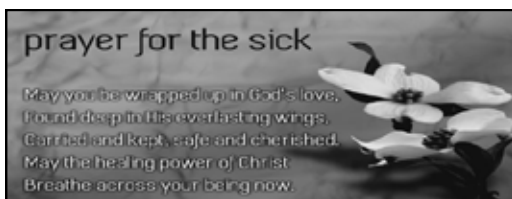

WHY DO CATHOLICS KNEEL?

If you attend a Catholic Mass you will see the first part of it consists of reading and preaching; we stand for the Gospel, but we sit for the other readings and for the preaching. But the Mass is more than just reading and preaching. The Mass is a sacrifice, and there are times--especially in the last part--when the faithful pray on their knees. Kneeling shows our humility before God.

Your question is a surprise because you probably should be asking yourself why you don't kneel in Protestant services. Scripture suggests you should. In Ephesians 3:14 Paul says, "I kneel before the Father," and in Acts 9:40 Peter "knelt down and prayed." The Catholic habit of kneeling is consistent with Scripture and is another manifestation of the continuity between the Church of the first century and the Catholic Church of today.

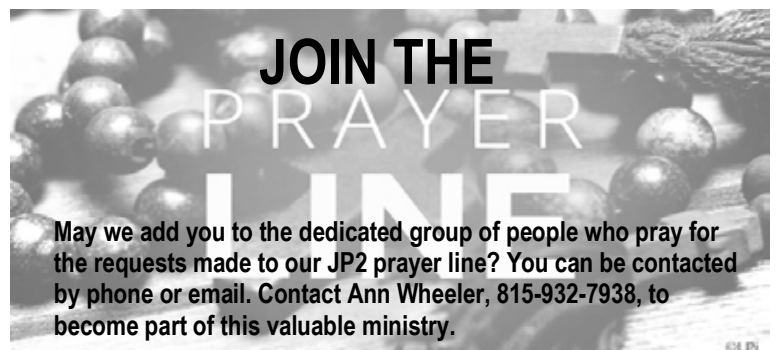

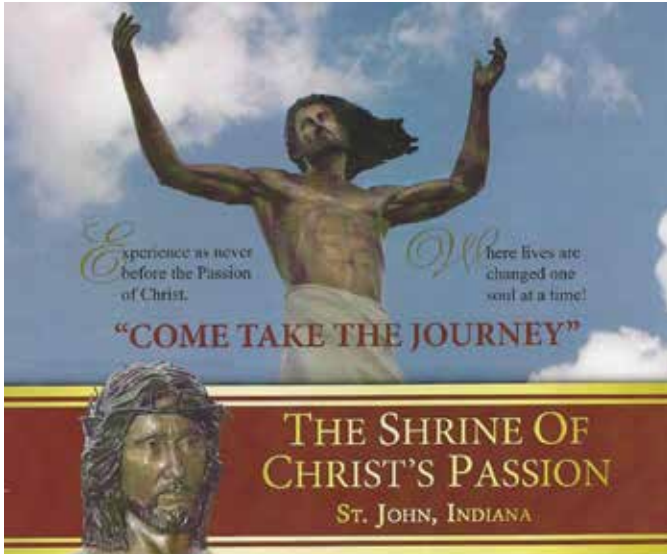
