A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"It is the Lord," the Beloved Apostle John said with excitement to Simon Peter as they sat in the boat at the break of dawn struggling to bring in the nets filled with fish because they cast their nets to the side where the stranger had told them. That stranger on the shore was Jesus, risen from the dead. Although they were only one hundred yards away from shore, Peter did not wait for the boat to be brought to shore. He put on his garments, jumped out of the boat, and swam to our Lord. What must have gone through Peter's

mind at that moment? Perhaps excitement to see his beloved Messiah.

Perhaps guilt for denying three times that he knew Jesus the eve of Jesus' crucifixion. Perhaps nostalgia. After all, three years ago, Jesus called Peter to be an Apostle in a similar fashion when he advised Peter to cast their nets out into the deep after having fished all night and catching nothing (see Lk. 5:1-11). At that moment they ended up catching so many fish that their nets were tearing and the boats were in danger of sinking. Peter turned to Christ and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man," and Jesus replied. "Do not be afraid: from now on you will be catching men." In today's Gospel, after the resurrection, the nets were strong enough and Jesus asked Peter three times, "Do you love me?" Each time reminded Peter of his denial, and after each of Peter's responses. Jesus instructed Peter, our first pope, to take care of the flock even to the end of his life. This moment was truly grace-filled. Our risen Lord showed mercy to Peter, expressed His confidence in Peter, and encouraged Peter to fulfill his own vocation by calling to mind how he was first called. In our own lives, we can at times feel lost. We can make mistakes or lose the excitement, drive, and commitment that had motivated us. This can occur in all vocations-in our particular vocations as priests, religious, and married persons as well as in our shared vocation as Christians called to holiness, to loving God and neighbor. Sometimes we lose that spark. It is important that we make use of this Easter Season to recover the spark of loving Christ, and it begins by recalling His love for us. After all, we can love God because he has first loved us (see 1 Jn. 5:7-12). Our risen Lord is present, and we can meet Jesus who comes to us and loves us through the sacraments, particularly in the Eucharist and confession. We also want to encounter our Lord in daily prayer. I encourage you to spend some time thinking about your baptism and praying with that. For most of us, before we could say a word, our Lord washed our souls clean from the stain of original sin and gave us his Holy Spirit in the sacrament of baptism, calling us to live in his love. Also, reflect on your First Holy Communion and remember how excited you were to receive Jesus in the Sacrament of his Body and Blood, the Eucharist. May we continue to recognize our Lord as the Beloved Disciple did, and may we, like Saint Peter, hurry to meet Him.

In Christ, Fr. Matt Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

"Es el Señor," dijo Juan el apóstol amado, con emoción a Simón Pedro mientras estaban en la barca al amanecer luchando por traer las redes llenas de peces porque echaron sus redes al lado donde el hombre en la orilla les instruyó a ellos. El hombre era Jesús, resucitado de entre los muertos. Aunque estuvieron a cien metros de la orilla, Pedro no esperó a que trajeran la barca a la orilla. Se vistió, se tiró al agua y nadó hacia nuestro Señor. ¿En qué estaba pensando San Pedro en ese momento? Quizá emoción por ver a su Mesías.

Tal vez culpa por negar tres veces que conoció a Jesús la noche antes de la crucifixión. Tal vez la nostalgia porque hace tres años, Jesús llamó a Pedro a ser Apóstol de manera similar cuando le aconsejó a Pedro que echara las redes en las aguas más profundas después de pescar toda la noche y no haber pescado nada (ver Lc. 5:1-11). En ese momento recogieron una cantidad tan grande de peces que las redes se les rompían y las dos barcas comenzaron a hundirse. Luego Pedro le dijo a Cristo: "Apártate de mí, Señor; soy un pecador," y Jesús le respondió: "No temas; desde ahora serás pescador de hombres." En el evangelio de hoy, después de la resurrección, las redes eran suficientemente fuertes y Jesús le preguntó tres veces a Pedro: "¿Me amas?". Cada vez le recordaba a Pedro su negación, y después de cada una de las respuestas de Pedro, Jesús instruyó a Pedro, nuestro primer papa, a cuidar su rebaño. Este momento fue lleno de gracia. Nuestro Señor resucitado mostró misericordia a Pedro, expresó su confianza en Pedro y animó a Pedro a cumplir su propia vocación recordando cómo fue llamado hace tres años. En nuestras vidas, a veces cometemos errores o perdemos los sentimientos, impulsos y compromisos que nos animaban. Esto es cierto para todas las vocaciones. en nuestras vocaciones particulares como sacerdotes, religiosos y casados y en nuestra vocación universal como cristianos llamados a la santidad, a amar a Dios y al prójimo. A veces perdemos el fuego. Es importante que aprovechemos este Tiempo Pascual para recuperar el fuego del amor de Cristo y recordar su amor por nosotros y su presencia en nuestras vidas. Podemos amar a Dios porque él nos ha amado primero (ver 1 Jn. 5:7-12). Él está presente y nos ama, particularmente en los sacramentos de la Eucaristía y la confesión. Además, gueremos encontrar a nuestro Señor en la oración diaria. Les animo a que pasen un tiempo pensando en su bautismo y orando con eso. A la mayoría de nosotros, antes de que pudiéramos decir una palabra, nuestro Señor lavó nuestras almas de la mancha del pecado original y nos dio su Espíritu Santo por el bautismo, llamándonos a vivir en su amor. Reflexionen sobre su Primera Comunión y recuerden cuán emocionados estuvieron de recibir a Jesús en el Sacramento de su Cuerpo y Sangre, la Eucaristía. Que sigamos reconociendo a nuestro Señor como lo hizo el Discípulo Amado, y que, como San Pedro, nos apresuremos a encontrarlo.
