

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

My Dear Children Who Recently Made Their First Holy Communion.

Congratulations for receiving Holy Communion last weekend for the very first time! This was a special weekend for you. You received Jesus, who is present in the Eucharist. The night before Jesus died for us, He took bread and said, "This is my body, given up for you," and he took a chalice

filled with wine, saying, "This is the chalice of my blood, the blood of the new and eternal covenant which will be poured out for you and for many..." You have been told many times how much Jesus loves you. The world saw how much He loves us when He died on the cross and rose from the dead for us. As Jesus began this most loving action, He gave us the Eucharist. His loving gift of Himself continues through the Church in every Mass. Jesus loves you so much that gives you Himself as your bread; He is our food for the journey of life. At every Mass, Jesus strengthens us and calls us together to be united to Him. At the Last Supper, when Jesus gave us the sacrament of the Eucharist, He prayed that we would be one in Him: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower... Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit..." (Jn. 15:1, 4-5a). Every time we come to Holy Communion, we renew our union with God; we remain in Him, and He in us. Let us stay close to Jesus and give Him thanks for the most holy gift of the Eucharist. May this sacrament give us strength, and may we stay close to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, joyfully and lovingly receiving Him in Holy Communion this weekend and always.

I look forward to celebrating the Corpus Christi Mass and procession with you on the 19th of June. May our Lord watch over and bless you and your families. I am praying for you; please continue to pray for me and one another.

¡Felicidades por recibir la Sagrada Comunión por primera vez hace una semana! Fue un evento especial para ustedes. Recibieron a Jesús, quien está presente en la Eucaristía. La noche antes de que Jesús muriera por nosotros, tomó el pan y dijo: "Este es mi cuerpo, entregado por ustedes", y luego tomó un cáliz lleno de vino, diciendo: "Este es el cáliz de mi sangre, la sangre

de la alianza nueva y eterna que será derramada por ustedes y por muchos ... " Ustedes han escuchado muchas veces que Jesús nos ama mucho. El mundo vio el amor de Dios cuando Él murió en la cruz y resucitó de entre los muertos por nosotros. Cuando Jesús comenzó esta acción de amor, nos dio la Eucaristía. Su amorosa entrega de sí mismo sigue en la Iglesia a través de cada misa. Jesús nos ama tanto que se da a sí mismo como nuestro pan; Él es nuestro alimento para el viaje de la vida. En cada misa, Jesús nos fortalece y nos llama a unirnos a Él. En la Última Cena, cuando Jesús nos dio el sacramento de la Eucaristía, Él rezó que seamos uno en Él: "Yo soy la vid verdadera, y mi Padre es el viñador ... Permanezcan en mí, como yo en ustedes. Así como el sarmiento no puede dar fruto por sí mismo si no permanece en la vid, tampoco ustedes pueden hacerlo si no permanecéis en mí. Yo soy la vid, ustedes los sarmientos el que permanece en mí y yo en él, ése da mucho fruto..." (Jn. 15: 1, 4-5a). Cada vez que recibimos la Sagrada Comunión, renovamos nuestra unión con Dios: permanecemos en Él y Él en nosotros. Permanezcamos cerca de Jesús y démosle gracias por el regalo santísimo de la Eucaristía. Que este sacramento nos fortalezca, y que permanezcamos cerca de Jesús en la Sagrada Eucaristía, recibiéndolo con alegría y amor en la Sagrada Comunión este fin de semana y siempre.

También me dará mucho gusto celebrar con ustedes la misa y procesión de Corpus Christi el 19 de junio. Que nuestro Señor los guarde y bendiga a ustedes y a sus familias. Estoy rezando por ustedes, por favor, sigan rezando por mí y por sus hermanos en Cristo de la parroquia.
