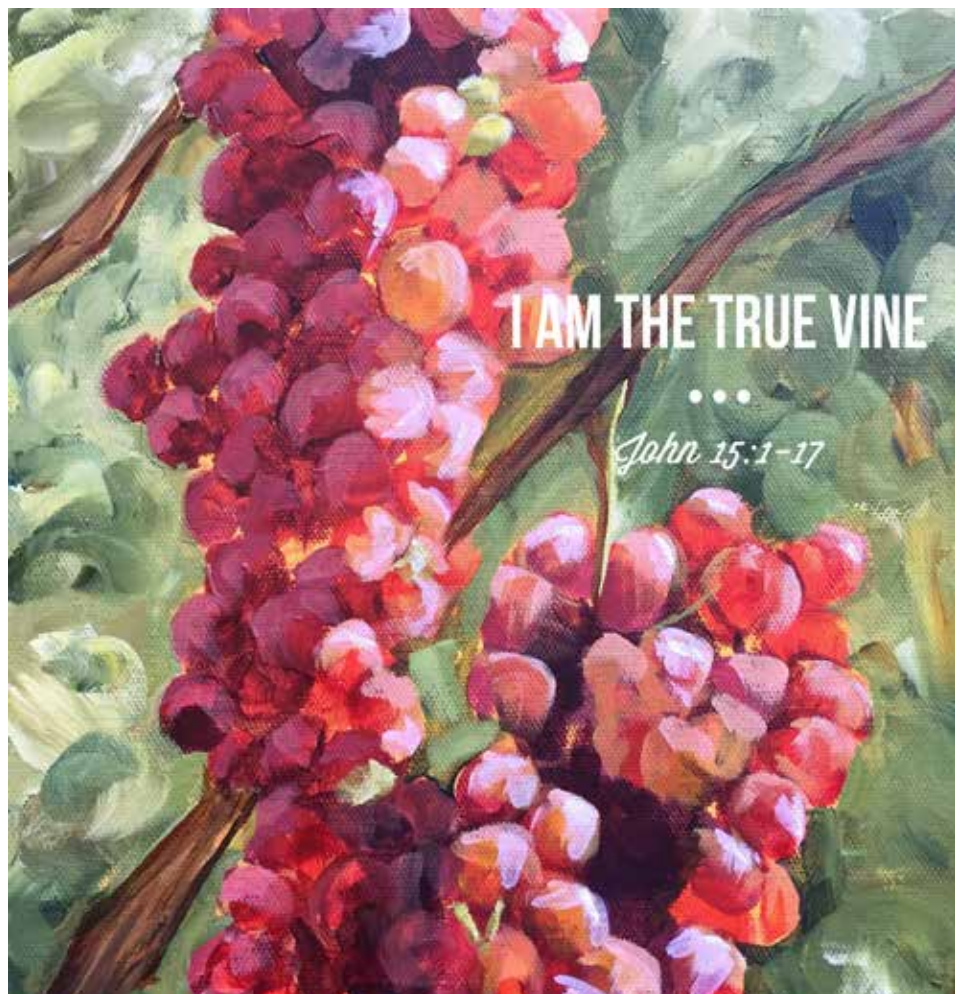

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we hear in the Gospel this weekend that Christ is the vine and we are the branches, I cannot help but think of Baptism and the Holy Eucharist. In Baptism, we received the gift of the Holy Spirit and became members of the Body of Christ. Jesus Himself gave us the sacrament of His Body and Blood in the Eucharist the night before He offered Himself on the cross for our salvation. In the Eucharist, Jesus gives us Himself as our bread; He is our food for the journey of life. He strengthens us and calls us together to be united to Him.

At the Last Supper, when He instituted the sacraments of the Eucharist and the Priesthood and gave us the commandment to love one another, He prayed that we would be one in Him and persevere in being in communion: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit..." (Jn. 15:1-5a). We need Jesus. He gives us life, and He brings us together into one family in faith. Every time we come to Holy Communion, we enter anew into union with God; we remain in Him, and He in us, when we receive Jesus in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Let us remain close to our Lord, who is our vine, and give Him thanks for the sacred gift of the Holy Eucharist. May this sacrament give us strength and bear much fruit in our daily lives.

Don't forget that this month is dedicated to the Blessed Mother. It is good to pray an extra rosary throughout this month, remembering that she loves us and brings us closer to her Son. Perhaps you can offer a rosary for our young people who are preparing for their First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Please also continue to pray for me and one another, and know of my prayers for all of you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Cuando escuchamos en el evangelio este fin de semana que Cristo es la vid y nosotros los sarmientos, pienso en el Bautismo y la Sagrada Eucaristía. En el bautismo, recibimos el don del Espíritu Santo y nos convertimos en miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo. Jesús mismo nos dio el sacramento de su Cuerpo y Sangre en la Eucaristía la noche antes de ofrecerse en la cruz por nuestra salvación. En la Eucaristía, Jesús es nuestro pan; él es nuestro alimento para el camino de la vida. Él nos fortalece y nos llama a unirnos a él.

En la última cena, cuando instituyó los sacramentos de la Eucaristía y el Sacerdocio y nos dio el mandamiento de amarnos los unos a los otros, rezó para que fuéramos uno en él y perseveráramos en la comunión: "Yo soy la verdadera vid y mi Padre es el viñador. Al sarmiento que no da fruto en mí, él lo arranca, y al que da fruto lo poda para que dé más fruto. Ustedes ya están purificados por las palabras que les he dicho. Permanezcan en mí y yo en ustedes. Como el sarmiento no puede dar fruto por sí mismo, si no permanece en la vid, así tampoco ustedes, si no permanecen en mí. Yo soy la vid, ustedes los sarmientos; el que permanece en mí y yo en él, ése da fruto abundante..." (Jn. 15: 1-5a). Necesitamos Jesús. Él nos da vida y nos une en una sola familia en la fe. Cada vez que venimos a la Sagrada Comunión, entramos de nuevo en unión con Dios; permanecemos en Él, y Él en nosotros, cuando recibimos Jesús en el sacramento de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Permanezcamos cerca de nuestro Señor, nuestro vid, y démosle gracias por el don sagrado de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Que este sacramento nos dé fuerzas y dé muchos frutos en nuestras vidas diarias.

No olviden que este mes está dedicado a la Santísima Madre. Es bueno rezar un rosario extra a lo largo de este mes, recordando que ella nos ama y nos lleva a su Hijo. Quizás puedan ofrecer un rosario para nuestros jóvenes que se están preparando para su Primera Comunión y Confirmación. Por favor también continúen rezando por mí y por los demás, y conozcan mis oraciones por todos ustedes.

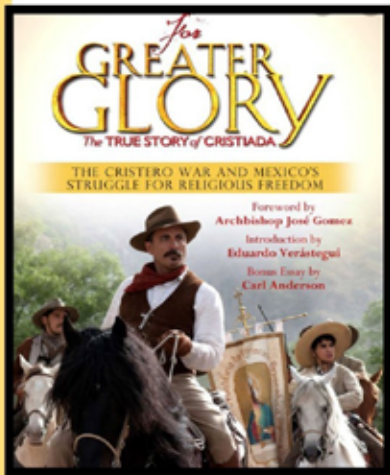

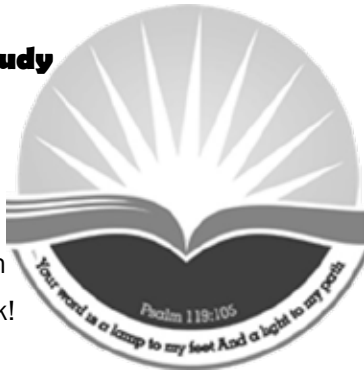
