A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Luke recounts the story of our Lord's ascension into heaven on the fortieth day after His resurrection and that Jesus instructed his apostles "not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for 'the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit... It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth'" (see Acts 1:1-11). The Ascension leads to Pentecost. Jesus ascended into heaven to bring us there, for where the head has gone in glory the body hopes to follow by the grace of God. To continue to unite us to Christ and sanctify us in order that we may share in the love of God now and forever, the Father and the Son have sent the Holy Spirit upon us. As our souls animate our bodies, the Holy Spirit animates the Body of Christ, the Church. The sacraments are effective because of the Holy Spirit. We can pray because of the Holy Spirit received in baptism. The Holy Spirit continues the work of Christ to unite us to the Father and Son. The apostles prepared for the reception of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost by spending the nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost in prayer. What were they doing when the Holy Spirit came? They were at prayer with the Blessed Mother. Let us imitate them in prayer as we receive the Holy Spirit through our apostolic Church.

I can not think of a better way to celebrate that day when the Holy Spirit radically united us to God than to consecrate the parish to the Blessed Sacrament. By the power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus' words do what they say when spoken by the priest. The Eucharist draws us together in location and in spirit. Receiving our Lord, we are one in the Lord. I invite you to join me at all of the Masses next weekend in reciting the prayer by which we consecrate the parish to the Holy Eucharist. The 11:30 a.m. Mass will be the principal Mass of consecration. It will be bilingual and will be followed by a reception. I hope you can join us.

Let us continue to stay close to our Lord who sanctifies us and draws us into the heights of heaven through His Holy Spirit.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En la primera lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, San Lucas nos cuenta la historia de la ascensión de nuestro Señor al cielo el cuadragésimo día después de su resurrección y que Jesús instruyó a sus apóstoles, "No se alejen de Jerusalén. Aguarden aquí a que se cumpla la promesa de mi Padre, de la que ya les he hablado: Juan bautizó con agua; dentro de pocos días ustedes serán bautizados con el Espíritu Santo... A ustedes no les toca conocer el tiempo y la hora que el Padre ha determinado con su autoridad; pero cuando el Espíritu Santo descienda sobre ustedes, los llenará de fortaleza y serán mis testigos en Jerusalén, en toda Judea, en Samaria y hasta los últimos rincones de la tierra" (ver Hechos 1:1-11). La Ascensión nos dirige hacia Pentecostés. Jesús ascendió al cielo para llevarnos allí, porque donde la cabeza ha ido en gloria, el cuerpo espera seguirla por la gracia de Dios. El Padre y el Hijo han enviado el Espíritu Santo sobre nosotros para continuar uniéndonos a Cristo y santificarnos para que recibamos el amor de Dios ahora y por siempre. Así como nuestras almas animan nuestros cuerpos, el Espíritu Santo anima el Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia. Los sacramentos son eficaces por el Espíritu Santo. Podemos orar por el Espíritu Santo recibido en el bautismo. El Espíritu Santo continúa la obra de Cristo para unirnos al Padre y al Hijo. Los apóstoles se prepararon para la recepción del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés pasando los nueve días entre la Ascensión y Pentecostés en oración. ¿Qué estaban haciendo cuando vino el Espíritu Santo? Estaban en oración con la Santísima Madre. Imitémoslos en la oración mientras recibimos el Espíritu Santo a través de nuestra Iglesia apostólica.

No se me ocurre mejor manera de celebrar ese día en que el Espíritu Santo nos unió radicalmente a Dios que consagrar la parroquia al Santísimo Sacramento. Por el poder del Espíritu Santo, las palabras de Jesús hacen lo que dicen cuando las pronuncia el sacerdote. La Eucaristía nos une en el lugar y en el espíritu. Recibiendo a nuestro Señor, somos uno en el Señor. Les invito a unirse a la parroquia en todas las Misas del próximo fin de semana recitando la oración por la cual consagraremos la parroquia a la Sagrada Eucaristía. La Misa de las 11:30 a.m. será la Misa principal de consagración. Será bilingüe y será seguido por una recepción. Espero que te puedas unir a nosotros.

Sigamos estando cerca de nuestro Señor que nos santifica y nos lleva a las alturas de los cielos a través de su Espíritu Santo.

Mission

The mission of Totus Tuus is to inspire in young people a true longing for holiness, a deep desire for daily conversion, and an openness to their vocation by constantly challenging them to give themselves entirely to Christ through Mary and by continually strengthening their prayer lives in imitation of Her.

Method

Totus Tuus calls upon college students and seminarians from the Catholic Diocese of Joliet and across the United States to carry this mission to every young person they encounter. Totus Tuus leaders are hired for their energy, enthusiasm, love for the faith, commitment to spiritual growth, ability to work with a team, and desire to work with youth.

Leaders are trained, grouped into teams of four, and sent out to a different parish every week for six weeks, where they conduct a week-long "parish mission," teaching and inspiring the parish's youth.

It is through the teams' example of authentic Christian living, centered on prayer and the sacraments, that they are able to be witnesses. "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses" (Evangelii Nuntiandi, 41). The youth see that these teachers who are joyful and on fire with the Catholic faith and long for the same thing in their lives.

Additionally, the daily schedule of Totus Tuus revolves around the Mass, the Sacraments, and prayer. A summer given entirely to God and the young people of the Catholic Diocese of Joliet would not be possible otherwise.

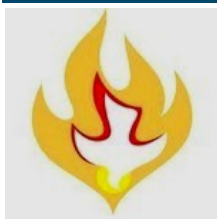
