

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

This weekend we celebrate Trinity Sunday. The doctrine of the Holy Trinity may seem abstract when we first think about it: there is one God consisting of three divine persons, to whom we refer as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. However, it comes from practical experience. God has revealed Himself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The disciples witnessed Christ praying to the Father. Jesus said that He Himself was sent by the Father and has come to do the Father's will. He promised that He would send an

advocate, the Holy Spirit, from the Father. When Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in the form of a dove and the voice of the Father was heard from the clouds. However, Jesus always spoke of them as one. They are one in mission, majesty, will, and substance. God is a Trinity, a communion of equal persons, who perfectly relate to and love one another. This is not self-enclosed and static, but dynamic and perfect. God, out of love for us whom He has made in His image and likeness, sent the Holy Spirit upon us at the moment of baptism to dwell within us, uniting us to the Son and thus making us adopted children of the Father. We participate in this relationship, this union; we share in the life of the Trinity. Living in relationship with God, or in friendship with God, is known as living in a state of grace. May we continue to care for that beautiful gift of grace by avoiding sin, living virtuously and charitably, and staying close to our Lord through prayer and the devout reception of the sacraments. May we continue to grow in friendship with God, who extends friendship to us

Next weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ. We give special attention and honor to our Lord Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. Our children are receiving their first Holy Communion on Saturday, and on Sunday, on the feast itself, we will have a special outdoor, bilingual Mass at 1pm. It will be on 10th Street, in front of the parish office. Following the Mass, we will have a Eucharistic procession with ice cream afterwards. In the case of inclement weather, there will be two simultaneous Masses, one in the church and the other in the Settles Center.

We are beginning a Year of the Eucharist in the parish (June 1, 2021-May 31, 2022). There are prayer cards for everyone. At 6:30pm every Sunday during the Year of the Eucharist, I will lead Vespers (Evening Prayer) with Benediction as well as give a short talk about the Eucharist, the Mass, and different aspects of our liturgies and rituals. Our faith is profound and rich, and there is so much to reflect on. The first one is June 6th. I hope you can come. Know of my continued prayers for you, and let us continue to remember one another each day in prayer.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:


Este fin de semana celebramos el Domingo de la Trinidad. A veces la doctrina de la Santísima Trinidad parece abstracta cuando lo pensamos por primera vez: hay un solo Dios formado por tres personas divinas, a quienes llamamos Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Sin embargo, lo sabemos por la experiencia práctica. Dios se ha revelado a nosotros como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Los discípulos vieron a Cristo orando al Padre. Jesús dijo que él mismo fue enviado por el Padre y que ha venido para hacer la voluntad del Padre. Él

prometió que enviaría un abogado, el Espíritu Santo, del Padre. Cuando Jesús fue bautizado, el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre él en forma de paloma y se escuchó la voz del Padre desde las nubes. Sin embargo, Jesús siempre habló de ellos como uno solo. Son uno en misión, voluntad y sustancia. Dios es una Trinidad, una comunión de personas iguales, que se relacionan perfectamente y se aman. No está encerrado en sí mismo, ni estático, sino dinámico y perfecto. Dios, por amor a nosotros que nos ha hecho a su imagen y semejanza, ha enviado al Espíritu Santo sobre nosotros en el momento del bautismo para que vivamos en Dios. uniéndonos al Hijo y haciéndonos hijos adoptados del Padre. Participamos en esta relación, esta unión. Vivir en relación con Dios, o en amistad con Dios, es vivir en un estado de gracia. Que nosotros sigamos cuidando ese hermoso don de gracia por evitar el pecado, vivir virtuosamente y con caridad y acercarnos al Señor por la oración y la recepción devota de los sacramentos. Que sigamos creciendo en amistad con Dios, quien nos ofrece la amistad.

El próximo fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi, el Cuerpo de Cristo. Damos especial atención y honor a nuestro Señor Jesucristo presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Nuestros jóvenes recibirán su primera comunión el sábado, y el domingo, en la fiesta misma, tendremos una misa especial bilingüe al aire libre a la 1 pm. Estará en la calle 10, frente a la oficina parroquial. Después de la Misa, tendremos una procesión eucarística, y un helado después. En caso de inclemencias del tiempo, celebraremos dos Misas simultáneas, una en la iglesia y otra en el gimnasio.

Estamos comenzando un Año de la Eucaristía en la parroquia (del 1 de junio de 2021 al 31 de mayo de 2022). Hay tarjetas de oración para todos. A las 6:30 pm todos los domingos durante el Año de la Eucaristía, dirigiré las Vísperas con Bendición y daré una breve charla sobre la Eucaristía, la misa y varios aspectos de nuestras liturgias y rituales. Nuestra fe es profunda y rica, y hay mucho en qué reflexionar. El primero es el 6 de junio. Espero que puedan venir. Estoy rezando por ustedes; recordemos rezar por nuestra comunidad todos los días.



May 30, 2021 Trinity Sunday Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40 Romans 8:14-17 Matthew 28:16-20

Go! In Matthew's gospel, the last words of Jesus to the disciples before ascending have three key elements: go, baptize, I'm with you. Therefore, living after the resurrection of jesus means three things. 1) Do not stay where it is safe; shed your doubt; go everywhere to everyone. 2) Baptizing into and teaching about resurrected life go together. That is why the baptismal catechumenate always spends so much time and effort in formation before an Easter Vigil. Time with parents and their babies, too. 3) We are not alone. Matthew ends with Jesus declaring, "I am with you always", just as this gospel began with the Virgin's birth of Emmanuel (God with us).

- What doubt do I have about God, about belief, about Church, about living in this world? Where can I turn?
- What ongoing formation in baptismal living do I need now?
- ◆ To whom am I called to "go" someone to be with, to do for?
