A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As summer begins, we think about summer vacations, Fourth of July holidays spent with family and friends, and time outdoors under the sun. Everybody needs a break. We are not made to work twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Not only are annual vacations and holidays throughout the year important for us, but the Lord's Day is critical. Sunday is our day of rest and celebration.

Every Sunday, we remember that first Easter Sunday, when our Lord conquered sin and death by rising from the dead, and we celebrate that day with the very sacrament our Lord instituted as He began the work of redemption: the Holy Eucharist. Sunday is meant to be set aside as time for God and family. It is tempting to approach Sunday like any other day or to fill the day with chores and tasks left over from the weekend's to-do list. However, our souls need that day of rest, spending it in charity: loving God and neighbor.

I would also like to encourage you to give yourself a break each day, to recharge the soul through prayer. The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines prayer as "the elevation of the mind and heart to God in praise of his glory; a petition made to God for some desired good, or in thanksgiving for a good received, or in intercession for others before God." In her autobiography, St. Therese of Lisieux wrote, "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." When we look toward heaven and lift up our hearts to God, we approach that throne of grace by which a weary soul receives refreshment. It is like going to the well, and our Lord extends to us the very same life-giving water that will bubble up within us and last forever that he promised the Samaritan woman. Let us take a break each day and turn to our Lord in prayer. There we can find peace, hope, mercy, wisdom, and joy. So I encourage you to find time each day or throughout the day for prayer. Then, the prayer of St. Augustine will ring true for each of us: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord. And our heart is restless until it rests in you."

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El verano ya empieza y entonces pensamos en las vacaciones de verano, las fiestas del cuatro de julio con familiares, amigos y el tiempo al aire libre bajo el sol. Todo el mundo necesita un descanso. No estamos hechos para trabajar veinticuatro horas al día, siete días a la semana. Las vacaciones anuales y los días festivos durante el año son importantes para nosotros y además el día del Señor es crítico.

El domingo es nuestro día de descanso y festividad. Todos los domingo recordamos el primer domingo de Pascua, cuando nuestro Señor venció el pecado y la muerte por resucitar de entre los muertos y celebramos ese día con el mismo sacramento que nuestro Señor instituyó cuando comenzó la obra de redención: la Sagrad Eucaristía. El domingo debe reservarse como tiempo para Dios y la familia. Es una tentación de vivir el domingo como cualquier otro día o llenar el día con trabajo. Sin embargo, nuestras almas necesitan ese día de descanso, pasándolo en caridad, amando a Dios y al prójimo.

También me gustaría animarlos a darse un descanso cada día a través de la oración. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica define la oración como "la elevación del alma hacia Dios o la petición a Dios de bienes convenientes." En su autobiografía, Santa Teresita de Lisieux escribió: "La oración es un impulso del corazón, una sencilla mirada lanzada hacia el cielo, un grito de reconocimiento y de amor, desde dentro de la prueba como desde dentro de la alegría." Cuando miramos hacia el cielo y elevamos nuestros corazones hacia Dios, nos acercamos al trono de gracia donde el alma cansada encuentra descanso y paz. Orar es ir a la fuente de nuestro Señor quien nos extiende la misma agua vivificante que prometió a la mujer samaritana. Tomemos un descanso cada día y vamos a nuestro Señor en oración. Allí podemos encontrar paz, esperanza, misericordia, sabiduría y alegría. Por eso les invito a reservar tiempo cada día o durante el día para orar. Luego la oración de San Agustín será nuestra: "Nos hiciste, Señor, para Ti; y nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descanse en Ti".








FR ROY MEET AND GREET


