FINAL WEEKS OF THE FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year 2018-2019 is almost over! As many of you know, the Diocesan fiscal year always begins in July and ends on the last day of June. And so, as far as managing the parish is concerned, we are in the phase of tying things up. That is why, I want to take this bulletin article as an opportunity to provide a broad idea of how we have been this year that is coming to a close.



SECOND YEAR OF OUR PARISH. We have accomplished so much in two years as a new parish, and I can feel that this year, many things have started to settle down, and some of the anxieties of parishioners seem to have lessened, as we continue to become a cohesive parish. Time does magic when it comes to these things, and I thank God for the time to allow the dust to settle after all the moving and turning that we have done over the past few years.

FINANCIAL REALITIES. As part of managing the parish, we had to be very watchful of what was going on with finances. With two priests working for the parish, three locations still needed to be somehow maintained, and lots of ministry work to be accomplished through the staff, we have indeed been floundering in keeping our finances afloat. With the decline in financial giving this year, we were faced with possible major shortfalls in our budget. But thanks to our finance council, and some parishioners' feedback, we made major adjustments in our staff and personnel, managed to produce some fund sources out of our existing assets, developed some fundraising initiatives, and negotiated with our diocesan and school responsibilities, we are ending up with a forecast not as critical as how it looked in December 2018. I am hoping to provide a full report for our parish in the soonest possible time.

FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM. I have to say that one of our biggest success stories this year is our Faith Formation Program. With a new curriculum and pedagogical strategy, and a greater emphasis on developing a genuine relationship with God, through prayer, mentoring and creative learning environment, the fruits of our initiatives this year have proven to be very rewarding. It wasn't perfect, but we have indeed achieved new levels of growth and participation that we have not seen in our catechetical program for years. Thanks to our FFP administration, boards, mentors and especially our catechists and aids this year, for their diligence and commitment in helping our young grow in their faith and love of God.

FR. JOHN AND FR. NESTOR. As we were finishing this year, I want to acknowledge that once upon a time, Fr. Sunny Fr. John and then Deacon Nestor, were together in the priest's house, and had a joyful time together, sharing stories, songs, laughter, food and priestly fraternity. We are obviously three different people in many ways, and yet, I believe we really got along very well. This is that one moment in time that we have been together, and it will never happen again in the same way, but I think of it with so much gratitude and joy.

PROUD OF OUR PARISH. When I think of the many things that we have done this year, and the many people that we have served, as well as the many ways that we may have grown in our faith and our unity as a parish, I have to say that I am proud of all of it. We are a happy, holy and healthy parish, passionately bringing Jesus to everyone and everyone to Jesus.

As we enter the new fiscal year, I am full of joyful expectations, because I believe that this year, we will really grow in various ways like we have never known before. Please take time to thank the Lord for what the Holy Spirit has been leading us as a family of faith. God bless our parish!

Juan y en aquel entonces Diácono Nestor, compartimos historias, cantos, carcajadas, alimentos y fraternidad sacerdotal. 




