

Our parish is two years old! It seems like we are so young, inexperienced, unstable and have much to learn. And yes, these are partial truths, but on the other hand, we come from deep roots, from the stock of rich old traditions and centuries of faith and spiritual work. This weekend, we celebrate the second year of our foundation, and as your founding pastor, I am elated with the fact that we have accomplished so much in just two years. Thanks be to God, for He is good and faithful.

And in the spirit of what we celebrate, allow me to tell you how proud I am of our parish community.



1. Eucharist-centered and Kerygma-inspired Liturgies. Our celebration of the Holy Mass is the very heart of everything that we do as a community of faith. We are very intentional at making sure that Jesus is the heart of our worship, in prayer, song, Word and Eucharist. We focus on our divine encounter, keeping in constant harmony with the tradition of the Universal Church. We also have a culture of eucharistic devotion in our parish, as well as a deep Marian spirituality.

2. Harmonious Diversity. There is no parish in Kankakee County or perhaps in the neighboring deaneries as diverse as St. John Paul II. If you want to truly experience the Catholicism of the Church, this is the parish to be part of. I am proud of the fact that we can celebrate bilingual masses very smoothly, and we have many programs for various sectors of the community where African Americans, Asians, Latinos, Africans, men and women, children or teens, rich and poor, seniors and youth, democrats and republicans, converts and cradle Catholics can co-exist and participate harmoniously in the life of the Church.

3. Ground-Breaking Evangelization Efforts. We are constantly looking for new ways to evangelize, and to teach the faith to others. Our Faith Formation Program achieved major successes this year because of a curriculum centered on relationship with God and the Church. We have several Bible Study Groups, all of which are reaching some sectors of the population, and are attracting people beyond our parish. We have a number of evangelization groups centered on the youth, which is in dire need of the Gospel. These include our Hearts of Hope Youth Group, our Young on Fire Ministry, our weekly Liturgy of the Word for Children, and our youth programs through Family Bridges.

4. Relevant and Collaborative Outreach Ministries. Our East Campus, at the former St. Teresa Parish, is home to many of our outreach programs, and it is a gem or a place rich in opportunities to serve the poor and the needy in our local community. From our food pantry and free clinic, to our clothing closet, seasonal giving tree and feeding programs, we must have one of the most outstanding outreach ministries in the entire Diocese of Joliet. I am also happy that we are collaborating with the larger community in many of these efforts.

5. Thriving Main Campus. Especially now that we are in the summer months, our main campus here in West Kankakee is so conducive to outdoor fellowship and prayer. We are surrounded by beautiful trees and plants, and our buildings are well maintained. The open field across the Settles Center is becoming more and more inviting to the young for playing soccer or simply hanging out with friends and families. The Garden Angels have positioned themselves to keep our environment full of beautiful flowers and plants through the blooming months!

For being two years old, we are doing pretty well. Thank you, dear parishioners of St. John Paul II, for being an excellent family of faith! And so, this weekend, let's pray together that God may continue to enflame the gifts of the Spirit in each of us, to bring Jesus to everyone and everyone to Jesus! Happy Foundation Day!




