THE SEASON OF GROWING, BLOSSOMING AND FRUIT-BEARING

As you can notice, my dear parishioners, growing well is not something that just happens without putting in the work. We have to do our part in order to achieve the best possibilities and actualize our greatest spiritual potentials. In other words, while we all have to do our best and then God will do the rest. In our parish, we have many available opportunities for growing spiritually. Available in our very own church are many pathways to learn about God and grow in our relationship with him, but nothing will happen until we do something with it. We will not get to where God want us to be until we actually take the steps on the pathway that He has set out for us. Christianity and salvation are not God spoon-feeding us with His Divine Life, but it is a mutual and interactive engagement between God and His people. Don't believe the cults that say, "You don't have to do anything..." Those who can read the Scriptures well will tell us that our relationship with God is an open invitation to acts of sanctification.

So, this is my prayer as your pastor: "May this summer find us bearing fruits that will last forever in the Kingdom of God." If you find yourself running out of ideas or feeling unsure where to begin or proceed, talk to me or to Fr. John Horan. We will be happy to give you some ideas.

Soon enough, I will be leaving for my pilgrimage to Poland and East-Central Europe. If you have some prayer requests that you want me to take to Our Lady of Czestochowa or to the Shrine of the Divine Mercy, or to the Infant Jesus of Prague, please write them down and leave them in the sacristy next weekend, or drop them off at the parish office. Otherwise, know that I will be praying for all of you in my holy journey. God bless our parish!

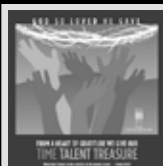

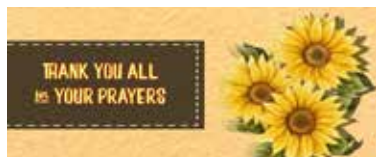
