A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Gospel from Mark 6:30-34 concludes, "When he (Jesus) disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things." Jesus is the Good Shepherd who loves us. At times we can go astray; sometimes we can drift through life or become distracted. Christ, the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep, never abandons us. He cares for us and wants us to be gathered together with Him. He has done so in our lives first by uniting us to Himself in baptism and bringing us together as a Church, feeding us in the Holy Eucharist, restoring our relationship in Confession, and calling us to be united in Him in heaven for all eternity. Pope Benedict XVI said it well at his first Mass as Pope when he preached about Jesus as the Good Shepherd: "He leaps to his feet and abandons the glory of heaven, in order to go in search of the sheep and pursue it, all the way to the Cross. He takes it upon his shoulders and carries our humanity; he carries us all – he is the good shepherd who lays down his life for the sheep." Christ is the one who carries us still. Let us stay close to our Lord. Let us listen to the voice of the Shepherd in prayer, Scripture, and the teachings of the Church; let us be cared for by our Shepherd through the sacraments; and let us follow our Shepherd in the way of virtue and charity.

Let us also remember in prayer Sister Teresa, who is celebrating her fiftieth anniversary this weekend. May our Lord continue watch over her and the Missionary Sisters of the Holy Family. Know of my prayers for you, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

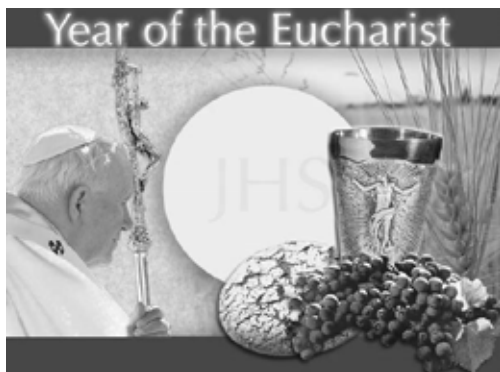


Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

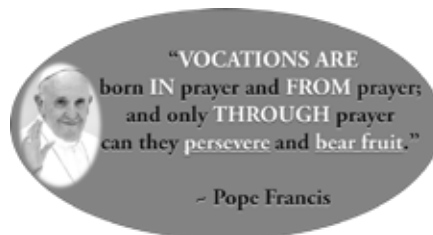

God Bless You on your 50th Jubilee Anniversary

My name is Sr. Teresa Lawicka. I am the youngest of 9, born September 16, 1953 in a small village in Poland.

My religious vocation goes way back from my parents' strong Catholic Faith. Sunday Mass, 1st Friday observance such as Mass attendance, Confession and Holy Communion reception was our family's regular practice. Evenings without Family prayer, Holy Rosary and Bible reading was incomplete in the Lawicka family. Thus, community life for me was basically a continuation of what was started in my family.

Respect and obedience were expected behavior in my home or else we faced consequences.

I was dreaming of becoming a religious sister since I was very young. I wanted to look like my older sister who was already serving God for a number of years as a Missionary Sister of the Holy Family. When I graduated from grade school and turned 15 years old, I decided to enter the convent. Eight months later, I entered novitiate and received my habit and white veil (now this was a big deal). Two years later (1971) I had my first vows. After a while my superior decided to send me to high school and eventually nursing school. I worked at the hospital for 3 years after which I came to USA.

My USA journey began in 1984 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. It was very challenging for me to learn English and also work. Sisters at home helped me a lot with the language but I found it easier to learn English while working with English speakers. I worked at St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee for 32 years during which, working with oncology patients was the most rewarding. Helping others, especially in a lot of discomfort, accepting the diagnoses like cancer, dealing with the loss of family members and the list goes on. My gold was listening to others, praying for them and with them. My favorite prayers are the Chaplet to Divine Mercy and the Rosary.

Overall, I would say the most challenging part of my last 50 years was having to learn a new language, yet the most rewarding of all was 'Service to People', especially the Sick'. To everyone wondering what is God's will for them, personal relationship with Jesus, Constant prayers is the key to discovering his will for you.
