THE HOLY RHYTHM OF LIFE IN OUR PARISH

We are in summer mode. While other times of the year can be very busy and full of liturgical and social events, these months can be quieter and easy-going. But that doesn't mean that we take a break from the holy things of God. In some ways, the summer months tend to become the "catch up" time for the things that we wish we had some time to do, or to accomplish some other goals that had to be set aside for other things more pressing. With this in consideration, I have a few things to share with the entire community.

SABBATH WEEKS. Starting this fiscal year, we are going to observe what I call "sabbath weeks" once every quarter. During these weeks, we will try to take some break from being so busy. It doesn't mean that we will completely stop from doing what we are usually doing, but simply to take a break from things that we can take a break from, and to avoid creating more things to do during those weeks. For example, we will still have our faith Formation program, but we will make sure that during that week, we will not have parent meetings and mentoring sessions. I also ask that meetings that can be suspended or postponed be actually suspended and postponed in observance of parish sabbath weeks. We are a very busy parish with so much going on all the time, and so these weeks are meant to balance our lives and allow us to breathe and process internally the things that we are doing. These "short rests" are to be treated as holy, just as our active ministries are holy. The first of these weeks is July 13-19.

COMMUNITY BUILDING. I feel very strongly that we have to make more intentional plans on building community and growing in our parish life, our spiritual and practical bonds as members of the same family of faith. There are many areas that can offer promising connections among ourselves, and we need to tap these and enrich them for our benefit. It is my personal desire as your pastor to reach deeper into the recesses of our community, and the stretch into the fringes. This fiscal year, I am calling our parishioners to a greater effort of community building, in order to strengthen our parish as a whole, and hopefully encourage greater participation in our ministries, greater awareness of the pastoral needs of our people and a greater sense of renewal for Jesus. I am optimistic, hopeful and excited about where this initiative can take us this year. I am positive that it will create new rhythms in the synchronizing movements of our life as God's people.

WORDS OF THANKS. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our parish council and parish pastoral council for their diligence and devotion to giving feedback and due counsel to me to have a bigger perspective of our church family. We have made some major successes this year, I believe more than they recognize. I also want to thank our commission heads/coordinators who have religiously rallied people to common goals and accountability in ministry. Thanks to the team of Teri O'Connor who have diligently helped to stabilize our records over the past two years. As we have now normalized our operation, I want to acknowledge their efforts to bring us current with our parish records. I also want to thank Dave Stejkowski and those who are spending time to create a stewardship environment in our parish. I thank Rende Langlois who has devotedly kept our parish facilities in excellent shape, and for patiently addressing the loopholes in our building management. There are so many more to thank, I am just naming some areas that I have been keenly aware of areas where outstanding work has been done. God bless our ministers!

The rhythm of life in our parish continues. Let's rally toward excellence!

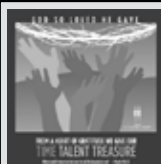

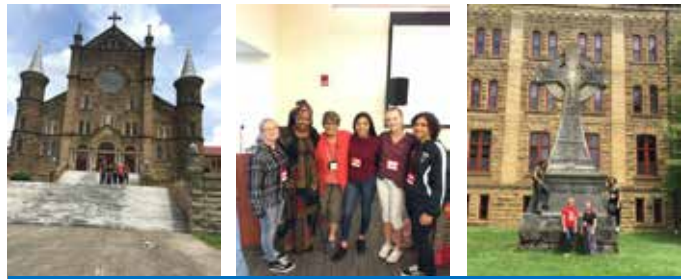
