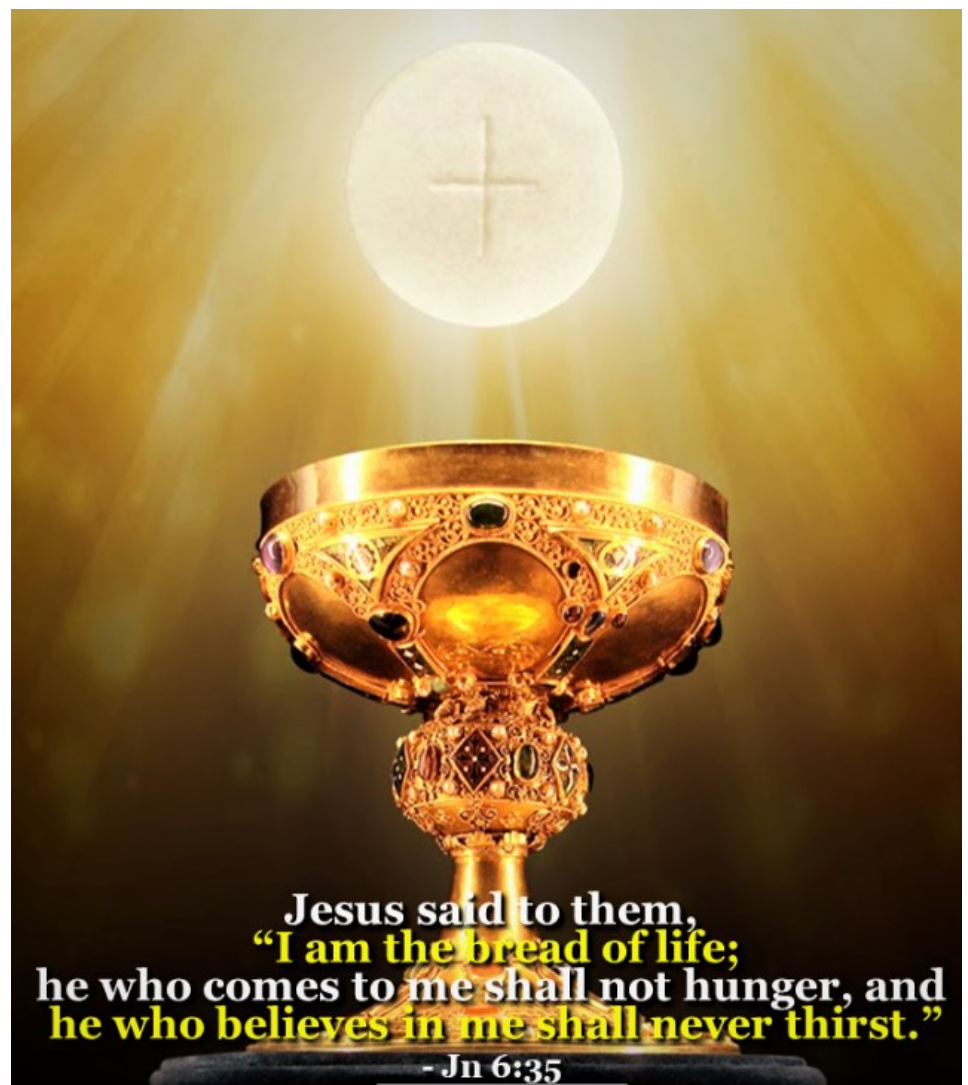

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel for the next four weeks will be from Jesus' Bread of Life discourse from the sixth chapter of the Gospel according to St. John. Jesus teaches us that He is the bread that has been sent down from heaven to give life to the world. I would like to share with you a reflection on this passage from Pope Benedict XVI. May we continue to recognize Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and grow in friendship with Him.

The first element of eucharistic faith is the mystery of God himself, trinitarian love. In Jesus' dialogue with Nicodemus, we find an illuminating expression in this regard: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God sent the Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him" (Jn 3:16-17). These words show the deepest source of God's gift. In the Eucharist Jesus does not give us a "thing," but himself; he offers his own body and pours out his own blood. He thus gives us the totality of his life and reveals the ultimate origin of this love. He is the eternal Son, given to us by the Father. In the Gospel we hear how Jesus, after feeding the crowds by multiplying the loaves and fishes, says to those who had followed him to the synagogue of Capernaum: "My Father gives you the true bread from heaven; for the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven, and gives life to the world" (Jn 6:32-33), and even identifies himself, his own flesh and blood, with that bread: "I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh" (Jn 6:51). Jesus thus shows that he is the bread of life which the eternal Father gives to mankind. (Pope Benedict XVI, *Sacramentum Caritatis*, 7)



Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

El evangelio de las próximas cuatro semanas será del discurso del Pan de Vida de Jesús en el sexto capítulo del Evangelio según San Juan. Jesús nos enseña que Él es el pan enviado del cielo para dar vida al mundo. Me gustaría compartir con ustedes una reflexión del Papa Benedicto XVI sobre este pasaje. Que continuemos reconociendo a Jesús en la Sagrada Eucaristía y crezcamos en amistad con él.

En Cristo,

El primer elemento de la fe eucarística es el misterio de Dios mismo, el amor trinitario. En el diálogo de Jesús con Nicodemo encontramos una expresión iluminadora al respecto: «Tanto amó Dios al mundo, que entregó a su único Hijo, que quien crea en Él no perecerá, sino que tendrá vida eterna. Porque Dios envió a Su Hijo al mundo, no para condenarlo, sino para que el mundo sea salvado a través de Él» (Jn 3,16-17). Estas palabras muestran la fuente más profunda del regalo de Dios. En la Eucaristía, Jesús no nos da "algo," sino a sí mismo; Él ofrece su propio cuerpo y derrama su propia sangre. Así, nos da la totalidad de Su vida y nos revela el origen supremo de este amor. Él es el Hijo eterno que el Padre ha entregado por nosotros. En el Evangelio escuchamos como Jesús que, después de alimentar a la multitud multiplicando los panes y los peces, les dice a aquellos quienes lo siguieron hasta la sinagoga de Cafarnaúm: "Mi Padre les da el verdadero pan del cielo; porque el pan de Dios es Él, que baja del cielo, y da la vida al mundo" (Jn 6,32-33); e incluso se identifica a sí mismo, su propia carne y sangre, con ese pan: "Yo soy el pan vivo que ha bajado del cielo: el que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo daré por la vida del mundo, es mi carne" (Jn 6,51). Jesús muestra así que es el pan de vida que el Padre eterno da a los hombres. (Papa Benedicto XVI, *Sacramentum Caritatis*, 7).

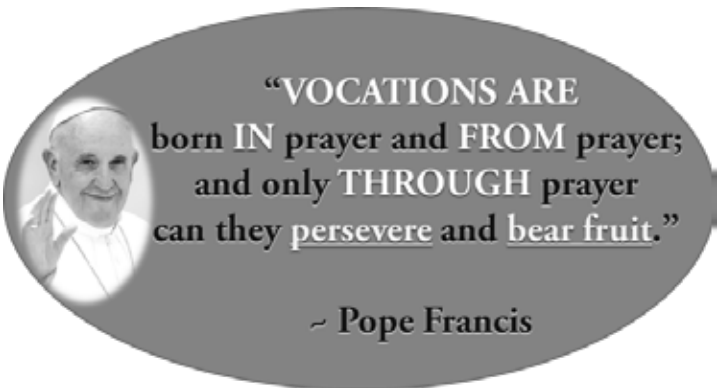

More Than Manna, More Than Bread and Fish

During the Exodus, the Lord rained down bread (manna) each day to feed those in flight. Last Sunday, after being filled with bread and fish, the crowd pursued Jesus for more food. Rightly exasperated, Jesus patiently shifts the conversation from bread from heaven to True Bread. He ends by saying: "I am the bread of Life." What looks like bread is more than bread. More than we can imagine!

OCIA (formerly RCIA)-“Come Journey With Us”

OCIA, or the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is the process in which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church. Participants go through a process of nurturing their relationship with God, becoming familiar with the Catholic teachings and practices, studying the Gospel, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation.

OCIA, or the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is open to ALL who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith:

- a non-baptized person.
- a member of another Christian church who is interested in the Catholic faith.
- a baptized Catholic who has not received First Communion or Confirmation, or
- a Catholic who has been away from the Church and desires to become an active member again.

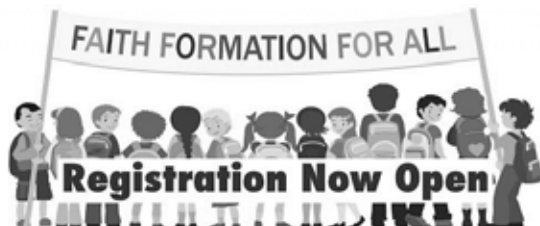

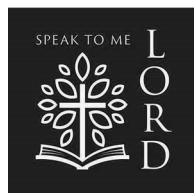
