

THE POWER OF INTERCESSIONS

Having just returned from my pilgrimage to Eastern Europe, although it is geographically Central Europe, I am privileged to inform our parish family that I spent a lot of time praying for you all, mostly in silence, during the journey. Most significantly, I prayed for our parish when I was in Wadowice, where our patron was born and grew up to his teenage years, before his family moved to Krakow. In this part of the world, I have seen many reminders of our community in Kankakee, and whenever that happened, I whispered some prayers for all of us. Here are some of the exact places where prayers were said:

1. The Church of St. Martin of Tours in Warsaw, where I celebrated the first mass of the pilgrimage. I sat gazing at a painting of St. Martin inside the church and was taken in some trance to pray for our parish.
2. The Blessed sacrament Chapel in Wadowice.
3. Inside the Church of Our Lady of Czestochowa, in front of one of her images where candles were being offered,
4. In Budapest, when we celebrated mass inside the Chapel of St. John Paul II, right next to the big basilica of St. Stephen.
5. In Prague, at the Shrine of the Infant Jesus of Prague
6. Wherever I saw pictures of St. John Paul II, which was often enough, I lost count.

I know that many of you have also prayed for me and my mother, and the rest of our pilgrims, for safety, and for a Spirit-filled journey, and so I want to say thank you, because it was exactly that – it was filled with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, even in the most challenging situations. It was also full of joy, which is a manifestation of the Holy Spirit.

The intentions and prayer requests sent by many of you have been offered in every church where we celebrated masses, particularly in the Shrine of the Infant Jesus of Prague. To bring people's intentions and intercessions is one of the most meaningful aspects of going on a pilgrimage. It has helped me believe more in the power of intercession, the positive results of praying for one another, and seeking other's prayers. I cannot count the many times that I was told that prayer requests have been granted, or how prayers have become a source of strength for people going through challenging times. Even while I was away on pilgrimage, I have received a number of messages thanking me for prayers granted, one being a healing from cancer by one of my former pilgrims from out of the state.

As your priest, I cannot encourage you enough to trust in the power of intercessions. When we pray for someone, grace overflows not only for the one we pray for, but also for the one who prays. It is a true win-win situation from the goodness of God. God works in such amazingly generous ways.

Here at St. John Paul II, we do pray intercessions every day, especially during the mass. We have a sick list in our bulletin where we can pray for fellow parishioners who need our prayers for healing. We have many parishioners who suffer many kinds of challenges and trials, who may not ask for prayers, but nonetheless receive spiritual grace when we pray for them. We teach our children to pray intercessions during their catechesis classes, and when we gather our youth at Young on Fire and Hearts of Hope. We use our social media accounts to seek prayers and petitions for those who desire such prayers. At the heart of it all, we are indeed a praying church, and we collectively believe in the power of intercessions. It is what makes us a strong Church. Let us then continue to build a culture of intercessions for many years to come.

EL PODER DE INTERCESIONES

Acabo de regresar de mi peregrinación del Este de Europa, geográficamente es Europa Central, es mi privilegio informar a nuestra familia parroquial que pasé bastante tiempo durante mi jornada rezando por todos, generalmente en silencio, y muy especialmente en Wadowice, donde nació y creció nuestro patrono, y en su juventud la familia se trasladó a Krakow. En esta parte del mundo he visto muchos recordatorios de nuestra comunidad en Kankakee, y cuando eso sucedía, silenciosamente oraba por todos nosotros. Aquí hay unos lugares donde se elevaban las oraciones:

1. La Iglesia de San Martín de Tours en Warsaw, donde celebré la primera misa de la peregrinación. Me senté contemplando la pintura de San Martín y allí en un trance oré por nuestra parroquia.
2. La Capilla del Santísimo en Wadowice.
3. Dentro de la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa, en frente de una de sus imágenes donde se ofrecían velas.
4. En Budapest celebramos misa en la Capilla de San Juan Pablo II, que estaba enseguida de la basilica de San Esteban.
5. En Prague, en la Capilla del Niño Jesús de Praga.
6. Cuando veía pinturas de San Juan Pablo II, que era con frecuencia, perdí la cuenta.

Yo sé que muchos de ustedes rezaban por mí, por mi madre y por el resto de los peregrinos, por seguridad, y por una jornada llena del Espíritu, así es que, muchas gracias a todos, porque así fue todo– fuimos guiados por el Espíritu Santo, aún en situaciones desafiantes. También gozamos de gran alegría, que es la manifestación del Espíritu Santo.

Las intenciones y oraciones que se me confiaron fueron ofrecidas en cada iglesia donde celebramos misas, especialmente en la Capilla del Niño de Praga. El traer las intenciones e intercesiones de la gente tiene gran significado para los peregrinos. A mí me han ayudado a creer más en el poder de la intercesión, en los resultados positivos del rezar uno por el otro, y el pedir oraciones de otros. He perdido la cuenta de las muchas veces que me han dicho que las oraciones encomendadas se han concedido, o que las oraciones han sido fuente de fortaleza en tiempos desafiantes. Aún durante la peregrinación, he recibido numerosos mensajes dándome las gracias por favores concedidos, uno fue la sanación de cancer de un peregrino pasado residente en otro Estado. Como su sacerdote, incansablemente los animo a que confíen en el poder de la intercesión. Cuando rezamos por alguien, la gracia fluye no solo por quien oramos, pero también por el que reza. Es una situación de gran ganancia de la bondad de Dios. Dios obra en maneras maravillosas y grandiosas.

Aquí en San Juan Pablo II, rezamos intercesiones cada día, especialmente durante la misa. Tenemos una lista de los feligreses enfermos en el boletín que necesitan nuestras oraciones para sanación. Tenemos muchos feligreses que sufren todo tipo de desafíos, que no piden oraciones, pero reciben gracia espiritual cuando oramos por ellos. Enseñamos a nuestros niños a orar intercesiones durante sus clases de catequesis, y también cuando reunimos a nuestros jóvenes en los grupos Young on Fire y Hearts of Hope. Usamos el medio social para recibir peticiones para los necesitados de nuestras oraciones. En el corazón de todo, somos iglesia en oración que colectivamente creé en el poder de la intercesión. Eso es lo que nos hace una Iglesia fuerte. Hay que seguir construyendo una cultura de intercesión por muchos años venideros.

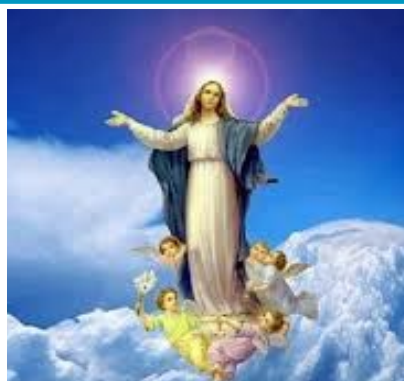

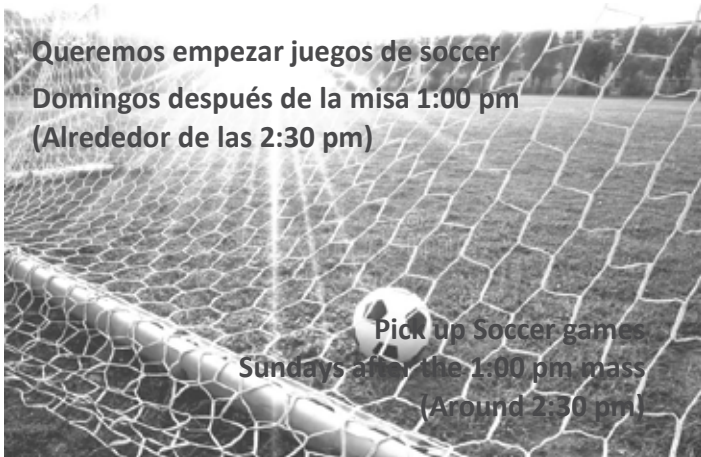

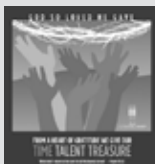
