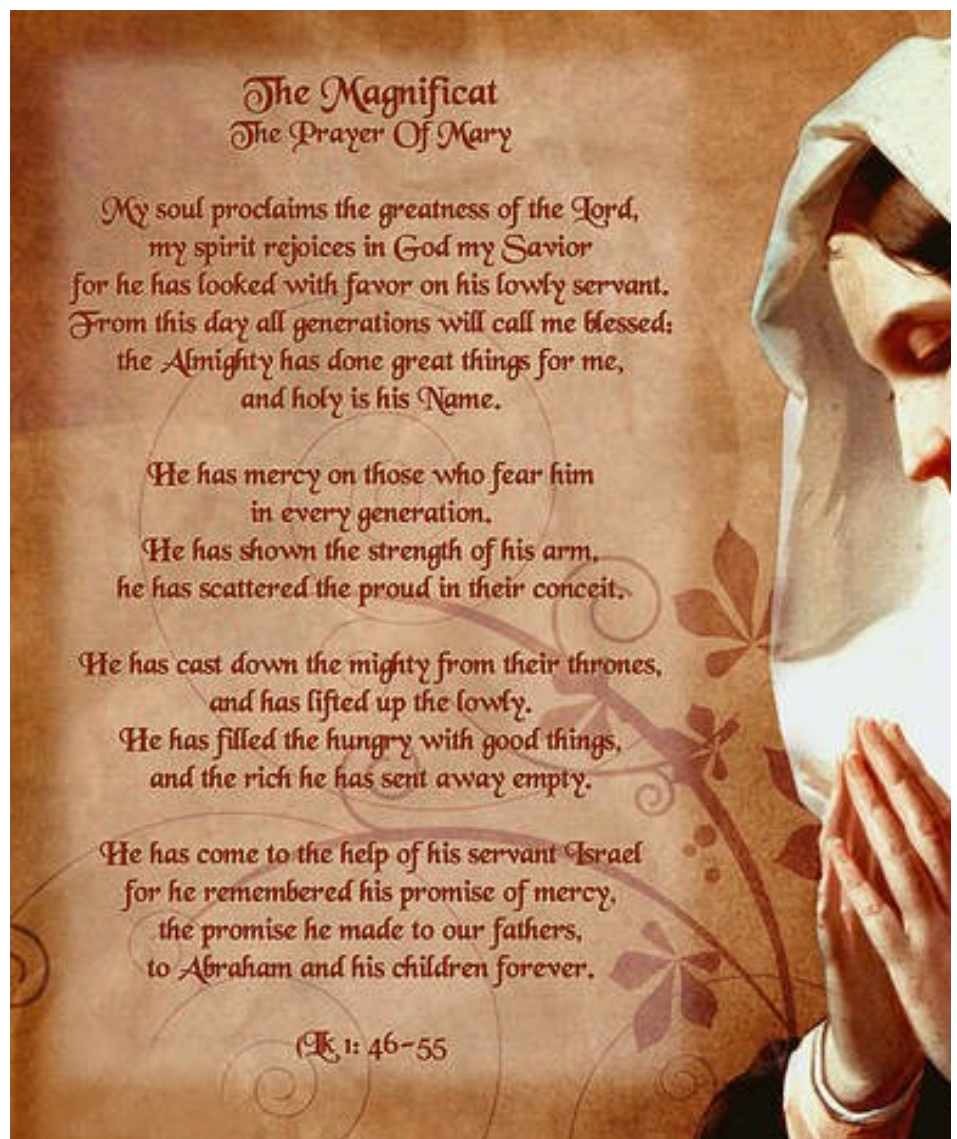

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

*"Ite inflammate omnia: Go, set the world on fire!"*

These were the words of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus, the Jesuits. These words have inspired countless men and women to abandon quests for fame and fortune and to work for the Kingdom of God, to not work for passing glory but for the eternal glory of God. These words inspired St. Francis Xavier, the patron saint of our diocese, to give his life to the Lord and be a great missionary and apostle to faraway lands, to baptize thousands of souls and bring them to Christ. These words come from the mouth and the heart of Jesus Himself in today's Gospel: "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" Jesus' heart burns for you and desires to set us and the world on fire with His divine love. May we continue to open our hearts to Him in prayer and allow Him to set our hearts aflame. This relationship with Christ has the ability to transform us. It has the ability to spread like wildfire into the other areas of our lives: our families, our friendships, our workplaces, our schools, our teams... May the fire of Christ's love continue to reach our hearts and transform the world.

We are mindful that this is a part of the mission of the Church: to set the world on fire. We are called to make our families, communities, workplaces, and villages more radiant with the love, peace, joy, mercy, and justice of Christ. We do not do this alone. One stick on fire is just a match, but a bundle of sticks makes a blazing torch. How beautiful it is when we come together at the Mass to receive the holy Eucharist, to be loved by God who humbly gives Himself to us under the appearance of bread and wine. How glorious it is when we spend time together being loved by Christ through His sacraments and then bring that same charity we have received to the world. Let us stay close to the fire. Let us stay close to the sacraments. Let us remain faithful to prayer. Let us love the Lord and one another.

Please continue to keep one another in prayer, especially George Arocha as he prepares to be ordained a deacon this Saturday as well as our teachers and students as school begins. I can assure you of my continued prayers for you.

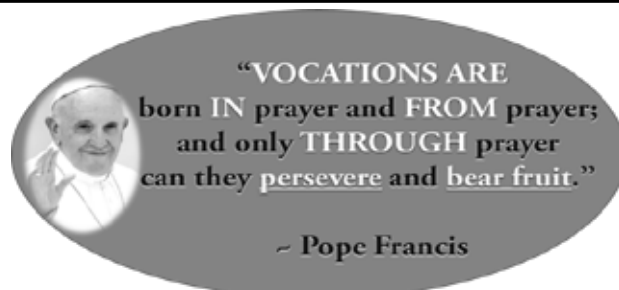

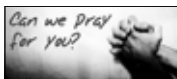

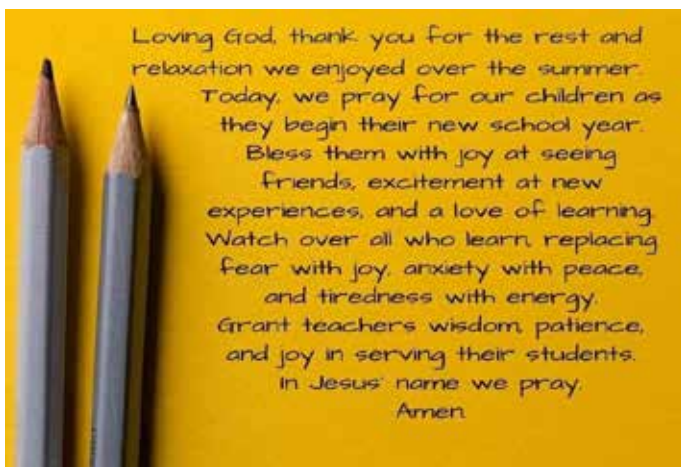
