A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, August 15th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Blessed Mother shows us how to pray and follow our Lord. At our Lord's first miracle in the Gospel according to John, it was Mary who went to our Lord and pleaded on behalf of the wedding party when they ran out of wine at the wedding feast in Cana, and it was Mary who then told the servants to do whatever Jesus tells them. When most of our Lord's disciples abandoned Him while He was being crucified, Mary was at the foot of the cross with the beloved disciple, St. John. Jesus looked down and gave Mary to the beloved disciple and to all disciples to be our mother when He said, "Behold your mother." On Pentecost, when the Apostles received the Holy Spirit in tongues of fire, Mary was with them in prayer in the upper room. Jesus Himself has given Mary to us to be our mother, to be with us in prayer, and to help us follow her Son and Lord.

Mary is the model disciple and our example. She shows us that the way to heaven is through her son, our Lord Jesus Christ. As we recall in today's feast that event when Mary was assumed into heaven, body and soul, the preface prayer of the Mass beautifully describes what we celebrate: "For today the Virgin Mother of God was assumed into heaven as the beginning and image of your Church's coming to perfection and a sign of sure hope and comfort to your pilgrim people; rightly you would not allow her to see the corruption of the tomb since from her own body she marvelously brought forth your incarnate Son, the Author of all life." She is close to our Lord, and she has been given to us to encourage us and help us to follow Him. Our Blessed Mother is praying for us and desires for us to be united with our Lord here on earth and forever in heaven. May we stay close to our Blessed Mother and invoke her motherly care through our devotions and prayers such as the rosary, the scapular, the *Memorare*, and the Hail Mary. The Blessed Mother is the one who brought our Lord to us; may she continue to bring us to our Lord and help us in following His will.

Con razón no permitiste, Señor, que conociera la corrupción del sepulcro aquella que, de un modo inefable, dio vida en su seno y carne de su carne a tu Hijo, autor de toda vida." Ella está cerca de nuestro Señor y nos ha sido entregada para animarnos y ayudarnos a seguirlo.
