Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we hear about humility. Our first reading, which is from the Book of Sirach, begins, "My child, conduct your affairs with humility" (3:17). In the Gospel, our Lord says, "For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted" (cf. Lk. 14:1, 7-14). Humility is defined in the Catechism of the Catholic Church as "the virtue by which a Christian acknowledges that God is the author of all good. Humility avoids inordinate ambition or pride, and provides the foundation for turning to God in prayer." When we live with humility, we are well-grounded. It helps turn our attention to God and others, thus being able to fulfill the Lord's commandments to love God and neighbor. Humility and meekness are the adjectives our Lord Himself used to describe His heart in Matthew 11:29. So let us ask the Lord for the grace of humility: to recognize our limitations, our need for God's grace, the blessings and gifts from God, and the daily opportunities to love and honor God and others. St. Augustine said it well, "It was pride that changed angels into devils; it is humility that makes men as angels." Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto thine.

Our Faith Formation Program begins soon. So if you have not yet registered your child, please do so soon. Know of my continued prayers for you. Let us continue to keep one another in prayer.

Este domingo, escuchamos sobre la humildad. Nuestra primera lectura, que es del Libro de Eclesiástico (Sirácide), comienza: "Hijo mío, en tus asuntos procede con humildad" (3:17). En el Evangelio, nuestro Señor dice: "Porque el que se engrandece a sí mismo, será humillado; y el que se humilla, será engrandecido" (cf. Lc. 14: 1, 7-14). La humildad se define en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica como la virtud por la cual un cristiano reconoce que Dios es el autor de todo bien. La humildad evita la ambición desmesurada u orgullo, y construye la fundación para orar. Cuando vivimos con humildad, estamos bien fundamentados. La humildad nos ayuda a estar atentos a Dios y a los demás, y así poder cumplir los mandamientos del Señor de amar a Dios y al prójimo. Humilde y manso son los adjetivos que nuestro Señor mismo usó para describir su corazón en Mateo 11:29. Entonces, pidamos al Señor la gracia de la humildad: reconocer nuestras limitaciones, nuestra necesidad de la gracia de Dios, las bendiciones y los dones de Dios, y las oportunidades diarias de amar y honrar a Dios y a los demás. San Agustín lo dijo bien: "Fue el orgullo lo que convirtió a los ángeles en demonios; es la humildad lo que hace a los hombres como ángeles." Jesús, dulce y humilde de corazón, óyenos.

The ecumenical phase begins on September 1 with the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and concludes on October 4 with the feast of Saint Francis. It is a special time for all Christians to pray and work together to care for our common home. Originally inspired by the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople, this Season is an opportunity to cultivate our "ecological conversion", a conversion encouraged by [Saint John Paul II](#) as a response to the "ecological catastrophe" predicted by [Saint Paul VI](#) back in 1970.

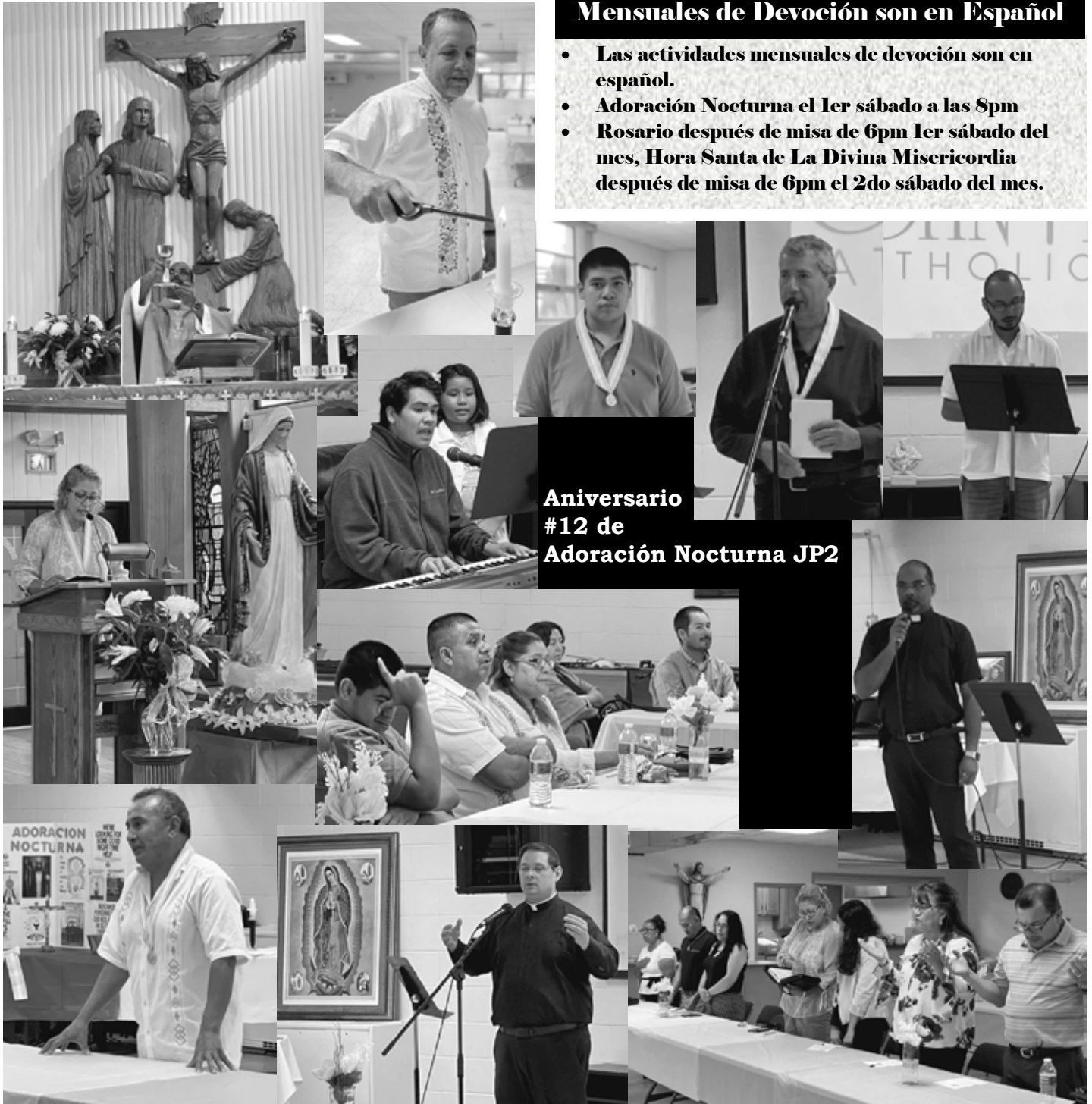
