

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, St. James writes in our second reading, "Be doers of the word and not hearers only." In our Gospel, as our Lord criticizes the Pharisees for being hypocritical in their critiques and their practice of the faith, He draws attention to the importance of the interior life: "From within people, from their hearts, come evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy,



blasphemy, arrogance, folly." The Pharisees were often so distracted by the externals that they forget about what was internal. eternal, and essential. Without a strong foundation, on what can we stand? So our patron saint, St. John Paul II, reminded us of the relationship between the contemplative life and the apostolic life, between prayer and action, in his address to the General Chapter of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts on September 21, 2000, "Only in the depths of contemplation can the Holy Spirit transform your hearts; and only if your own hearts are transformed will you be able to fulfil the great task of helping others so that the Spirit may guide them 'into all the truth' (Jn 16: 13), which is the essence of the Christian mission. Social structures will never be able to be perfected or improved without a genuine conversion of hearts. Both of these must go together " Conversion of heart leads to authentic justice. Contemplation and quiet prayer are essential. If we want change on the outside, we must begin on the inside. We want to think of Christ and spend time with Him, in whom every virtue is present, and allow His goodness to transform us. If we want to do what the Word says, we must listen to the Word. Let us not simply go through the motions of faith and of life, but let us be attentive to Christ in prayer and at the Mass. Let us stay close to our Lord, who has the words of everlasting life. Let us listen to His words and be attentive to how we can allow Him to transform us and make us holy. Then may we be doers of the word, allowing our Lord whom we have received in Word and Sacrament to work through us in our daily lives.

Know of my continued prayers for you. Let us continue to remember one another in prayer.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este fin de semana, Santiago escribe en nuestra segunda lectura: "Pongan en práctica esa palabra y no se limiten a escucharla." En nuestro Evangelio, cuando nuestro Señor critica a los fariseos por ser hipócritas en sus críticas y en su práctica de la fe, llama la atención sobre la importancia de la vida interior: "lo que sí lo mancha es lo que sale de dentro; porque del corazón del hombre salen las intenciones malas, las fornica-

ciones, los robos, los homicidios, los adulterios, las codicias, las injusticias, los fraudes, el desenfreno, las envidias, la difamación, el orgullo y la frivolidad." Los fariseos estaban distraídos por lo externo que se olvidaban de lo interno, eterno y esencial. Necesitamos una base sólida. Por eso nuestro santo patrón, San Juan Pablo II, nos enseñó la relación entre la vida contemplativa y la vida apostólica, entre oración y acción, en su discurso a la Congregación de los Sagrados Corazones el 21 de septiembre de 2000, "Sólo en las profundidades de la contemplación puede el Espíritu Santo transformar vuestros corazones; y sólo si el propio corazón es transformado se puede cumplir con la gran tarea de ayudar a los demás para que el Espíritu les guíe 'hasta la verdad completa' (Jn 16, 13), que es la esencia de la misión cristiana. Las estructuras sociales nunca podrán perfeccionarse y elevarse sin una auténtica conversión de los corazones. Ambos aspectos deben ir juntos ... " La conversión del corazón conduce a la justicia auténtica. La contemplación y la oración silenciosa son esenciales. Si gueremos un cambio por fuera, debemos empezar por dentro. Queremos pensar en Cristo y pasar tiempo con él, en quien se encuentran todas las virtudes, y dejar que su bondad nos transforme. Si queremos poner en práctica la palabra, debemos escuchar la palabra. No pasemos simplemente por los movimientos de la fe y de la vida. Pero estemos atentos a Cristo en la oración y en la Misa escuchando sus palabras y estando atentos a cómo podemos permitirle que nos transforme y nos santifique. Entonces, pongamos en práctica la palabra, permitiendo que nuestro Señor, a quien hemos recibido en Palabra y Sacramento, obre a través de nosotros en nuestras vidas diarias.

Conozcan mis continuas oraciones por ustedes y sigamos recordándonos unos a otros en oración.



Special collection for Haiti recovery efforts set for weekend of Sept. 11-12

The people of Haiti have suffered greatly in recent days, as both an earthquake and tropical storm have struck the country located in the Caribbean Sea. Numerous lives have been lost, and many Church properties, along with homes and businesses, have been severely damaged or destroyed.

Catholic Relief Services is on the ground providing humanitarian aid, and the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Subcommittee on the Church in Latin America has approved \$10,000 grants to each of the three most affected dioceses. But more help is needed.

In his role as USCCB president, Archbishop Gomez of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles has called for a voluntary, special collection to support the USCCB Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund to provide additional aid to Haiti. The Diocese of Joliet has set the weekend of Sept. 11-12 for this special collection.
