Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last week, we saw St. Peter at his best. Simon Peter spoke on behalf of his brother Apostles and made a brilliant profession of faith. Then our Lord changed his name from Simon to Peter, which means “rock”, and made Peter our first pope, telling Peter that he is the rock on which Christ will build His Church as well as the keeper of the keys to the kingdom of heaven. St. Peter shined in that account because of his openness to God’s plan and revelation. However, today we see a different encounter. When our Lord speaks about how He must suffer and die in Jerusalem at the hands of the scribes, chief priests, and elders and then be raised on the third day, St. Peter rebukes our Lord. He doesn’t understand. The cross was difficult for St. Peter to comprehend, as it is difficult for many people. Our Lord then scolded St. Peter and told him, “You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do.” He then turned to the rest of the disciples and reminded them, “Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?” We are reminded that our lives are not given value by the acquisition of valuable things or comforts, but we profit truly when we spend ourselves in love of God and neighbor. St. Peter learned that lesson when our risen Lord forgave St. Peter for denying Him. St. Peter proclaimed it when he received the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. He testified to it by his words and actions, ultimately when he was crucified upside down on the Vatican Hill in Rome. St. Peter is a great example of perseverance. He did not always understand, but he always turned to Christ, and he was successful in the end. Let us ask St. Peter for his intercession that we who might also struggle with crosses may persevere with hope and that our lives may reflect the love of God that was demonstrated so perfectly and humbly on the cross.

Our faith formation program begins next week. Let us continue to pray for our students and teachers who have returned. May we continue to support and pray for one another, and know of my continued prayers for you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

La semana pasada, escuchamos sobre San Pedro en su mejor momento. Simón Pedro habló en nombre de los Apóstoles y proclamó una brillante profesión de fe. Entonces nuestro Señor cambió su nombre de Simón a Pedro e hizo de Pedro nuestro primer Papa, diciéndole a Pedro que él es la piedra sobre la cual Cristo edificará su Iglesia y también el guardián de las llaves del reino de los cielos. San Pedro brilló en ese relato debido a su apertura al plan y la revelación de Dios. Sin embargo, hoy leemos un encuentro diferente. Cuando nuestro Señor habla de cómo debe sufrir y morir en Jerusalén a manos de los escribas, sumos sacerdotes y ancianos y luego resucitar al tercer día, San Pedro trató de disuadir a nuestro Señor. La cruz era difícil de comprender para San Pedro y es difícil para muchas personas. Nuestro Señor entonces regañó a San Pedro y le dijo: “Tu modo de pensar no es el de Dios, sino el de los hombres.” Luego nuestro Señor dijo a los otros discípulos: “ El que quiera venir conmigo, que renuncie a sí mismo, que tome su cruz y me siga. Pues el que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; pero el que pierda su vida por mí, la encontrará. ¿De qué le sirve a uno ganar el mundo entero, si pierde su vida? ¿Y qué podrá dar uno a cambio para recobrarla?” Nos recuerda que nuestras vidas no reciben valor por la adquisición de cosas valiosas o comodidades, sino que nos beneficiamos verdaderamente cuando nos gastamos en el amor de Dios y del prójimo. San Pedro aprendió esa lección cuando nuestro Señor resucitado perdonó a San Pedro por negarlo tres veces. San Pedro la proclamó cuando recibió el Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. La testificó con sus palabras y acciones, últimamente cuando fue crucificado en la colina Vaticana en Roma. San Pedro es un gran ejemplo de perseverancia. No siempre entendió, pero siempre se volvió a Cristo y al final tuvo éxito. Pidamos a San Pedro su intercesión para que perseveremos con esperanza en la cruz y resurrección del Señor y para que nuestra vida refleje el amor de Dios que se demostró tan perfecta y humildemente en la cruz.

Nuestro programa de formación en la fe comienza la próxima semana. Continuemos orando por nuestros estudiantes y maestros que han regresado. Que podamos seguir apoyando y orando el uno por el otro, y conozcan mis oraciones continuas por ustedes.

**A Note From Fr. John
 Whoops - Teaching Error**

I realized that I taught something incorrect
 about faith and morals, and I want to
 correct it: on the weekend of Sunday,
 August 16th, I preached on questions of
 culture, race, and the humility of the
 Canaanite woman in Matthew 15:21-28.

In the midst of the homily I said something to the effect that "if
 someone steals to feed his starving family, he is still stealing." I
 came to realize that I was wrong about that. Here's a relevant
 passage from the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

**The seventh commandment forbids theft, that is,
 usurping another's property against the reasonable will of the
 owner. There is no theft if consent can be presumed or if
 refusal is contrary to reason and the universal destination of
 goods. This is the case in obvious and urgent necessity when
 the only way to provide for immediate, essential needs (food,
 shelter, clothing...) is to put at one's disposal and use the
 property of others. (CCC, 2408; cf. Gaudium et Spes, 69).**

This means that private property is still a good that must
 be respected, but the life-or-death needs of others (including
 hunger!) make a more urgent claim on the goods needed for
 survival. Since God expects the wealthy to share their surplus with
 those who need something to survive (Deut. 15:11; Prov. 21:13;
 Jam. 2:14-17), one's very property can already be said to *belong*
 to the person who is in a dire condition for going without. "*Feed the
 man dying of hunger, because if you have not fed him, you have
 killed him*" (Gaudium et Spes, 69, quoting a saying in the early
 Church Fathers).

Thus, I was wrong to say it is "still stealing" when someone
 takes what is needed to survive, such as taking food when a person
 or a family is starving. The one who is dying can take what is
 needed to survive. This would be true when all personal resources
 are extinguished and recourse to begging has also left one
 empty-handed (or perhaps there isn't time for begging). On the
 flip-side, if someone considers himself 'in need' but refuses to ask
 for help or takes things which are not necessary for survival, this
 would clearly be an instance of theft. Recent events of looting,
 despite claims of justification, appear to fit this designation.

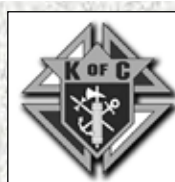

OCIA (formerly RCIA)-"Come Journey With Us"

OCIA, or the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is the process in which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church. Participants go through a process of nurturing their relationship with God, becoming familiar with the Catholic teachings and practices, studying the Gospel, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation.

OCIA, or the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is open to ALL who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith:

- a non-baptized person.
- a member of another Christian church who is interested in the Catholic faith.
- a baptized Catholic who has not received First Communion or Confirmation, or
- a Catholic who has been away from the Church and desires to become an active member again.

OCIA classes at St. John Paul II are held on Sunday mornings, beginning late September, and culminate in the celebration of sacraments at Easter-time. Call the parish office now to register or for more information at 815.933.7683.

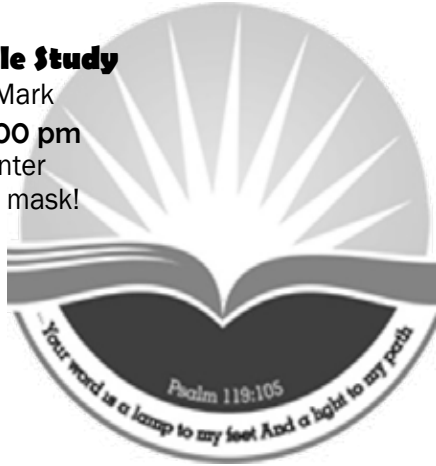


