

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the summer begins to wind down and school and many activities begin again, I would like to recommend using the many great feast days this month to help keep us focused. The saints are people with whom we can relate. They walked this planet like us and strove for holiness. They received the mercy of God and lived in friendship with Christ, hoping to persevere to that eternal friendship with God in heaven.



I would like to give you a glimpse of the many inspiring feast days during the month of August. The month began with St. Alphonsus Liguori (8/1) who was a holy bishop that encouraged holiness through devotions and the moral life. St. John Vianney (8/4) was a parish priest who would hear confessions for up to twelve hours a day. The Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major (8/5) reminds us that Mary is the Mother of God and that with God all things are possible. The Transfiguration (8/6) gives us a glimpse of the glory of the Resurrection that follows the cross. St. Dominic (8/8) founded an order to preach the Gospel. St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (8/9) was a Jewish philosopher who converted, became a Carmelite nun, and died at Auschwitz in World War II. St. Lawrence (8/10) showed us humor in the midst of his martyrdom. St. Clare (8/11) emptied herself and embraced a poor life so she could be filled with the riches of God's love. St. Maximilian Kolbe (8/14) took the place of a prisoner at Auschwitz in World War II, dying for his neighbor. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (8/15) reminds us of our destination in heaven. Her queenship is celebrated on 8/22. St. Monica (8/27) prayed every day that her son, St. Augustine, would return to the faith. St. Augustine (8/28) wandered from the faith but returned to it and became a great bishop. The Passion of St. John the Baptist (8/29) recalls how St. John the Baptist, who pointed out Christ and prepared the way of the Lord, was put to death for his preaching.

As we remember and honor the saints, don't forget to join us next Sunday, August 14th, for our procession in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. I will celebrate a bilingual Mass at 11:30am and bless the students before they return to school as well as give them blessed miraculous medals. We will then process outside with a statue of the Blessed Mother as the children lead us in the holy rosary. We will then end with ice cream sundaes and elote. Let us continue to honor our blessed Mother and the saints as well as invoke their prayers. May the saints encourage us and inspire us as we walk together on this pilgrim journey toward heaven, and may we continue to remember to pray for one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El verano empieza a terminar, la escuela y muchas actividades van a comenzar de nuevo muy pronto. Me gustaría recomendar usar los muchos días festivos de este mes para ayudar a mantenernos enfocados. Los santos son personas con las que podemos relacionarnos. Caminaron por este mundo como nosotros y luchaban por la santidad. Recibieron la misericordia de Dios y vivían en amistad con Cristo, esperando perseverar esa eterna amistad con Dios en el cielo.

Quiero compartir con ustedes algunos días de fiesta durante el mes de agosto. El mes comenzó con San Alfonso Liguori (1/8), que era un obispo santo que promovía la santidad de los laicos, el clero y los religiosos a través de las devociones y la vida moral. San Juan Vianney (8/4) era un sacerdote que escuchaba confesiones por doce horas al día. La dedicación de la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor (8/5) nos recuerda que María es la Madre de Dios y también que para Dios todo es posible. La Transfiguración (8/6) nos da una vista de la gloria de la Resurrección que sigue después de la cruz. Santo Domingo (8/8) fundó una orden para predicar el Evangelio. Santa Teresa Benedicta de la Cruz (8/9) era una filósofa judía que se convirtió, entró a las carmelitas y murió en Auschwitz en la Segunda Guerra Mundial. San Lorenzo (8/10) nos mostró humor en medio de su martirio. Santa Clara (8/11) vivía una vida pobre para que pudiera llenarse de las riquezas del amor de Dios. San Maximiliano Kolbe (8/14) tomó el lugar de un prisionero en Auschwitz en la Segunda Guerra Mundial, muriendo por su prójimo. La Asunción de la Bienaventurada Virgen María (8/15) nos recuerda nuestro destino en el cielo. Su reinado se celebra el 22. Santa Mónica (8/27) rezó todos los días para que su hijo, San Agustín, volviera a la fe. San Agustín (8/28) se desvió de la fe, pero volvió a ella y se convirtió en un gran obispo. La Pasión de San Juan Bautista (8/29) nos recuerda que él señaló a Cristo, preparó el camino del Señor y fue ejecutado por su predicación.

Mientras recordamos y honramos a los santos, no olviden participar en nuestra procesión en honor a la Santísima Virgen María el próximo domingo 14 de agosto. Celebraré una misa bilingüe a las 11:30 am y bendeciré a los estudiantes antes de que regresen a la escuela y les daré medallas milagrosas bendecidas. Luego saldremos en procesión con una estatua de la Santísima Madre mientras los niños nos guían en el santo rosario. Terminaremos con helado y elote. Sigamos honrando a nuestra Santísima Madre y a los santos, invocando sus oraciones. Que los santos nos animen e inspiren mientras caminamos juntos en este peregrinaje hacia el cielo, y que sigamos recordando orar unos por otros.
