Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. The theme is, "I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you." This reminds me of my first chalice. The chalice I used for my first Mass as a priest, which I still use today, has a diamond in the base of the chalice. That diamond is from the engagement ring of my great grandmother. When she died, her daughters decided to keep the diamond to be put in the chalice of the first priest in the family. Every time I use that chalice and look at that diamond I think about how blessed I am to have received the faith through my family and how our precious faith has brought me into a much larger family: the family of God, the Church. As we celebrate Catechetical Sunday, let us pray for parents, who are the primary catechists for their children, as well as for the parish catechists. May we continue to hand on the faith we have received and live in unity and charity as one family in faith. Remembering one another in prayer, I would like to conclude with prayers for our catechists and parents.

Lord God, source of all wisdom and knowledge, you sent your Son, Jesus Christ, to live among us and to proclaim his message of faith, hope, and love to all nations. In your goodness bless our brothers and sisters who have offered themselves as catechists for your Church. Strengthen them with your gifts, that they may teach by word and by example the truth that comes from you. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

God our Father, let your peace settle within the hearts of these mothers, fathers, and guardians. Give them strength and wisdom as they care for their children. Show them how to raise their families with patience and tenderness. Give them strength during the times of greatest difficulty and help them recognize the little joys that are part of each day. May they grow in wisdom, understanding, and grace. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ, who is one with you and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen.
