A PLEA FOR OUR LITURGY

This weekend, and the weeks following, we would like to highlight as a parish the importance of liturgical ministry.

Liturgy is considerably the most important aspect of our life as a parish – our worship, our rituals, our sacramental life, our encounter with God in prayer. We are the Church, and as such, our first and most important work is to pray, and our highest form of prayer is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. As Christians, this is first and foremost what we do. Consider the First Apology of St. Justin Martyr for the basic lines of the order of the Eucharistic celebration. He wrote to the pagan emperor Antoninus Pius (138-161) around the year 155, explaining what Christians did:

- a. *On the day we call the day of the sun, all who dwell in the city or country gather in the same place.*
- b. *The memoirs of the apostles and the writings of the prophets are read, as much as time permits.*
- c. *When the reader has finished, he who presides over those gathered admonishes and challenges them to imitate these beautiful things.*
- d. *Then we all rise together and offer prayers for ourselves. . .and for all others, wherever they may be, so that we may be found righteous by our life and actions, and faithful to the commandments, so as to obtain eternal salvation.*
- e. *When the prayers are concluded we exchange the kiss.*
- f. *Then someone brings bread and a cup of water and wine mixed together to him who presides over the brethren.*
- g. *He takes them and offers praise and glory to the Father of the universe, through the name of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and for a considerable time he gives thanks that we have been judged worthy of these gifts.*
- h. *When he has concluded the prayers and thanksgivings, all present give voice to an acclamation by saying: 'Amen.'*
- i. *When he who presides has given thanks and the people have responded, those whom we call deacons give to those present the "eucharisted" bread, wine and water and take them to those who are absent.*

It is amazing how similar and consistent the Catholic liturgy has been since its roots! That is how rich our liturgical tradition is, and truly, to be part of it, and to minister for it, is a real honor.

Over the next few weeks, we are inviting our parishioners to consider an active participation in our liturgical life, by taking part in our various liturgical ministries, particularly as readers, extraordinary ministers of holy communion, ushers and greeters, and altar servers. We also want to invite more parishioners to be part of our music ministries. As far as I am concerned, these are the ministries that are non-negotiable, in other words, that our parish cannot continue to exist if we are not able to satisfactorily serve these ministries well. I personally ask you, as your pastor, to take to heart this invitation, and to help us continue to legacy that comes from the roots of our faith. Thank you to the current existing ministers, and to those who will heed our plea. God bless the Church, God bless St. John Paul II Parish!

UNA SÚPLICA PARA LA LITÚRGIA

Este fin de semana, y las semanas siguientes, queremos enfocarnos como parroquia en la importancia del ministerio litúrgico.

La liturgia se considera el aspecto de más importancia en nuestra vida como parroquia – nuestro culto, veneración, rituales, nuestra vida sacramental, nuestro encuentro con Dios en la oración. Nosotros somos la Iglesia, y como tal, nuestra más importante tarea es la oración, y nuestra oración más valiosa es el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Cómo Cristianos, esto es lo primero que hacemos. Consideremos la Primera Apología de San Justín Mártir por las líneas básicas de la orden de la celebración Eucarística. Él escribió al emperador pagano Antoninus Pius (138-161) alrededor del año 155, aclarando lo que hacen los Cristianos:

- a. *En el día que llamamos el día del sol, todos los habitantes de la ciudad y del campo se reúnen en el mismo lugar.*
- b. *Los recuerdos memorables de los apóstoles y las escrituras de los profetas se leen hasta que el tiempo lo permita.*
- c. *Cuando el lector ha terminado, el que preside sobre la asamblea los amonesta y los desafía a imitar estas cosas hermosas.*
d. Entonces todos juntos nos ponemos de pie y ofrecemos oraciones por nosotros mismos...y por los demás, donde quiera que se encuentren, para que así nos encuentren virtuosos en nuestra vida y acciones, y fieles a los mandamientos, y así obtener la salvación eterna.
- e. *Cuando terminamos las oraciones intercambiamos el beso.*
- f. *Entonces alguien trae el pan y una copa de agua y vino revueltos y los presentan al que preside sobre la asamblea.*
- g. *Él los toma y ofrece alabanza y gloria al Padre del universo, por medio del nombre del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo y toma bastante tiempo en dar gracias por haber sido juzgados dignos de recibir estos dones.*
- h. *Cuando él ha finalizado las oraciones y agradecimientos, todos los presentes aclaman diciendo: 'Amen.'*
- i. *Cuando el que preside ha dado gracias y la gente ha dado respuesta, aquellos a quienes llamamos diáconos dan a los allí presentes el pan "consagrado", vino y agua y llevan esto a los ausentes.*

Es asombroso y consistente cómo ha sido la liturgia Católica desde sus raíces! Nuestra liturgia es muy rica en su tradición, y en realidad, el participar en la obra y suministrarlo, es verdaderamente un honor.

En las semanas siguientes, estamos invitando a nuestros feligreses a considerar una participación activa en nuestra vida litúrgica, y tomar parte en los varios ministerios litúrgicos, como lectores, ministros extraordinarios de la Santa Comunión, ujieres y recepcionistas, y acólitos. También queremos invitar a más feligreses a ser parte de nuestro ministerio de música. Por lo que a mí respecta, estos ministerios no son negociables, en otras palabras, nuestra parroquia no puede continuar su existencia si no podemos satisfactoriamente cumplir bien con estos ministerios. Yo personalmente les ruego, como su pastor, tomar a corazón esta invitación, y ayudarnos a continuar la herencia que viene de las raíces de nuestra fe. Gracias a los ministros presentes, y aquellos que van a responder a nuestra súplica. ¡Dios bendiga Su Iglesia, Dios bendiga a la Parroquia San Juan Pablo II!


