A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

October is Respect Life Month and is dedicated to the most holy rosary. The rosary is a familiar and powerful devotion. Repeating the Hail Mary on each bead while meditating on a particular mystery of our faith reminds us that Mary is the model disciple who reflected on all that Jesus said and did in her heart, and she desires to bring us closer to Jesus. No human person has loved and known Jesus better than His own mother, and is that not the desire of every Christian, to know and love Christ? When we pray the rosary, we pray it with our mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary. When the beloved disciple stood at the foot of the cross, our Lord gave Mary to him and to all disciples when He said, "Behold your mother." Mary is our mother who helps us to stay close to her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. A few years ago, when a friend was having a hard time at work, I gave him a rosary. He kept it in his pocket, and every time he felt angry or discouraged, he would simply grasp the rosary and then feel himself calming down. This was so because every time we hold the rosary we hold our Blessed Mother's hand. Just as she comforted the beloved disciple at the foot of the cross, she does the same for us in our daily lives. I encourage you to rekindle your love for Mary. The more we come to know her and love her, the more she directs us to her Son. So during this month of the most holy rosary, pray the rosary as individuals, families, and even as small groups. Carry the rosary with you, having that reminder that we never walk alone but have the support of our Lord as well as of Mary and the angels and saints.

Don't forget that the annual pet blessing in honor of St. Francis will be next Sunday, October 2nd, at 6:30 pm in front of the rectory. RICA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) also begins next Sunday. RICA prepares adults to become Catholic and receive all or some of the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation) this Easter. It is not too late to join.

Let us stay close to our Lord, the Blessed Mother, and one another, and let us continue to keep one another in prayer.

Así como ella consoló al discípulo amado al pie de la cruz, ella hace lo mismo por nosotros en nuestra vida diaria. Les animo a reavivar su amor por la Virgencita. Lo más que la conocemos y la amamos, lo más que nos dirige a su Hijo. Entonces, durante este mes del rosario, recen el rosario como individuos, familias y en grupos. Lleven el rosario con ustedes, recordando que nunca caminamos solos pero que tenemos el apoyo de nuestro Señor, la Virgen María, los ángeles y los santos.

No olviden que la bendición de las mascotas es el próximo domingo, 2 de Octubre, a las 6:30 pm. RICA (Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos) también comienza el próximo domingo. 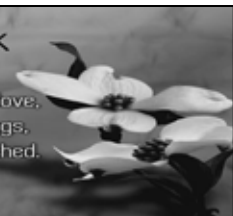

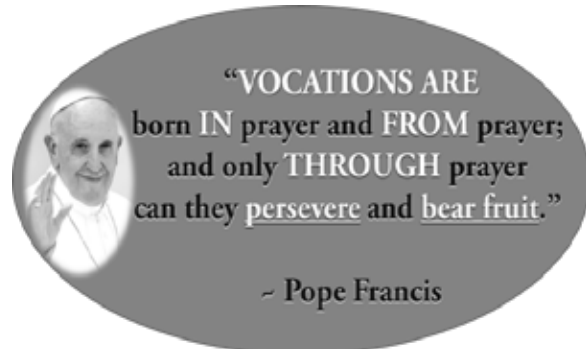

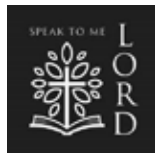

For, “the Gospel of God’s love for man, the Gospel of the dignity of the person and the Gospel of life are a single and indivisible Gospel” (EV 2).

May mothers in need experience Christ's loving care as we seek to live out His Gospel of life.
