A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR


UNA NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

This month's theme for our Year of the Eucharist is "Adoration". It is a great gift to spend time with our Lord present in the Eucharist, to have an audience with the King of kings. He humbly comes to us under the appearances of bread and wine to nourish us and strengthen us on the journey. He actually comes to us in every Mass. He is true to His word and does what He says. He

gives Himself to us. In a restless and noisy world, our Lord invites you to spend some quiet time with Him, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest" (Mt. 11:28). Before and after Mass and immediately after communion, adore the Lord present in the Holy Eucharist. In addition to Holy Mass, we have adoration every Monday from noon to 5pm as well as from 8am to 6pm on the first Friday of the month and from 9pm to 5am on the first Saturday of the month (families from 9pm to 11pm and men from 11pm to 5am per the guidelines of the Nocturnal Adoration Society). In adoration, the consecrated host (in which Jesus is truly and really present) is placed in a monstrance upon the altar for us to then spend time with him in prayer. It is gift to guiet the soul and spend time in prayer. Prayer is powerful. Our patron saint, Pope John Paul II wrote of the importance of prayer in the parish: "Yes, dear brothers and sisters, our Christian communities must become genuine 'schools' of prayer, where the meeting with Christ is expressed not just in imploring help but also in thanksgiving, praise, adoration, contemplation, listening and ardent devotion, until the heart truly 'falls in love'. Intense prayer, yes, but it does not distract us from our commitment to history: by opening our heart to the love of God it also opens it to the love of our brothers and sisters, and makes us capable of shaping history according to God's plan" (Novo Millennio Ineunte, 33). Let us continue to open our hearts to the love of the Lord and remember one another in prayer.

El tema de este mes de nuestro Año de la Eucaristía es "Adoración". Es un gran regalo pasar tiempo con nuestro Señor presente en la Eucaristía, tener una audiencia con el Rey de reyes. Él viene humildemente a nosotros bajo las apariencias de pan y vino para nutrirnos y fortalecernos en el camino. De hecho, viene a nosotros en cada Misa. Es fiel a su palabra y hace lo que dice. Él se entrega a nosotros. En un mundo

inquieto y ruidoso, nuestro Señor les invita a pasar un rato tranquilo con él, "Vengan a mí todos los que están fatigados y agobiados, y yo les daré alivio." (Mt. 11,28). Antes y después de la Misa e inmediatamente después de la comunión, adoren al Señor presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Además de la Santa Misa, hay adoración todos los lunes de 12pm a 5pm, el primer viernes de mes de 8am a 6pm y el primer sábado de mes de 9pm a 5am (familias de 9pm a 11pm y hombres de 11pm a 5am según las reglas de la Sociedad de Adoración Nocturna). En adoración, la hostia consagrada (en la que Jesús está verdadera y realmente presente) se coloca en una custodia sobre el altar para que pasemos tiempo con él en oración. Es un regalo para aquietar el alma y dedicar tiempo a la oración. La oración es poderosa. Nuestro santo patrón, el Papa Juan Pablo II, escribió sobre la importancia de la oración en la parroquia: "Sí, queridos hermanos y hermanas, nuestras comunidades cristianas tienen que llegar a ser auténticas 'escuelas de oración', donde el encuentro con Cristo no se exprese solamente en petición de ayuda, sino también en acción de gracias, alabanza, adoración, contemplación, escucha y viveza de afecto hasta el 'arrebato del corazón'. Una oración intensa, pues, que sin embargo no aparta del compromiso en la historia: abriendo el corazón al amor de Dios, lo abre también al amor de los hermanos, y nos hace capaces de construir la historia según el designio de Dios" (Novo Millennio Ineunte, 33). Continuemos abriendo nuestros corazones al amor de Dios y recordándonos unos a otros en oración.






