Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

November is traditionally set aside to pray for the faithful departed. So I encourage you to pray each night or after grace before meals for those who have died using the words "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they

rest in peace." It is also praiseworthy to visit the cemetery and pray for those who are buried there, especially those who have nobody praying for them. Remembering as a parish those who have gone before us, I encourage you to write the name of a loved one or a friend who has died in our Book of Remembrance, which is placed by the church entrance. Throughout the month of November, we remember in our prayers at Mass as well as in our personal prayers those who are listed in the Book of Remembrance. It is an act of love to accompany our brothers and sisters in Christ as they make their final journey to the eternal wedding feast of heaven.

As we near the end of Ordinary Time and approach Advent, which prepares us for the Christmas Season, we will celebrate the great Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, on November 22nd. Christ is the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end, the one in whom we find peace, joy, and salvation. With the many obligations and celebrations surrounding Thanksgiving and Christmas, I would like to encourage you to be intentional about making Advent a time to truly prepare yourselves to receive Christ anew. That is best done through reflection and prayer. Our Lord gives us the parable of the wise virgins who are ready with lighted lamp to receive the bridegroom when he arrives. Let us keep our hearts fixed on celebrating and receiving Christ, the beloved of our souls.

Our Lord is good. Let us stay close to Him and continually receive Him into our hearts and our lives. Please continue to pray for me and one another, and know of my prayers for you.




