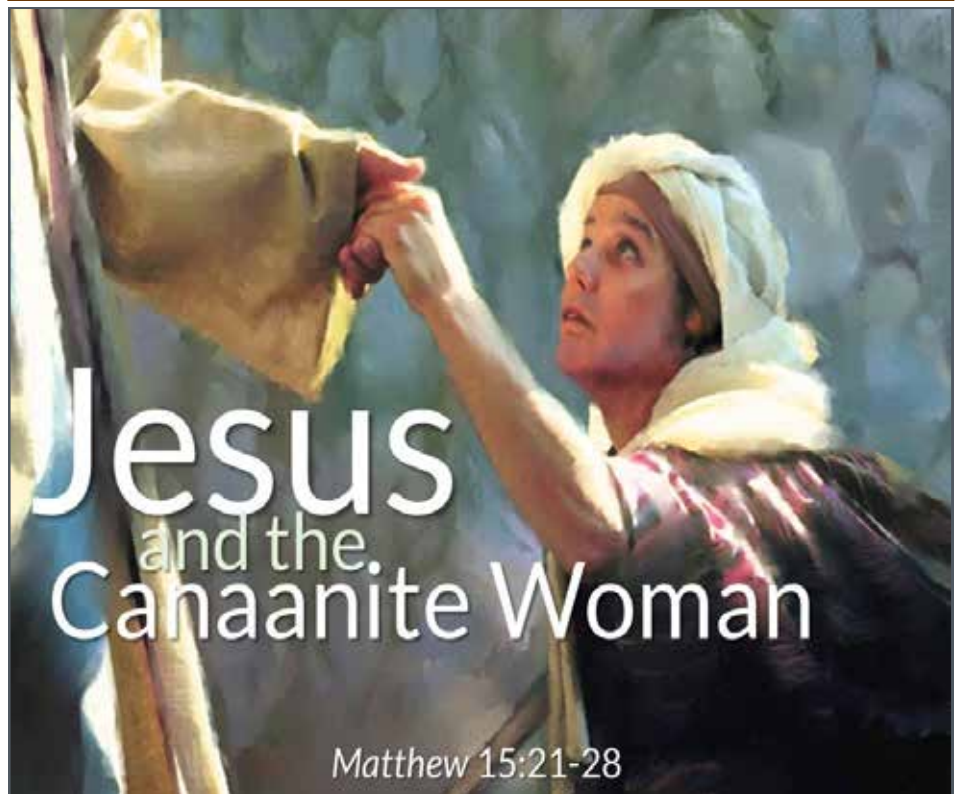

O Come Desired of Nations, Come

The Advent Hymn *Veni Veni Emmanuel* ends with a cry for the Lord, the “desired of nations,” to reign as King of all peoples by defeating sin and death. Although we are still a long way from celebrating Christmas, this Sunday’s Gospel reflects the same attitude of recognizing Jesus as the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. (Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!)

The Canaanite woman in today’s Gospel showed great perseverance in prayer as she begged Jesus to heal her daughter. As she is not from the race of Israel, it appears that Jesus rejects her claim and petition. He even implies she has no right to ask for “the food” that should go to the children, not to the “dogs”. Instead of turning away discouraged, she continues to cry out to the only one with the power to save. Jesus, after this test, affirms her as a woman of “great faith” and heals her daughter!

What are we to take from this Gospel? Is Jesus being a bully? - Or worse - a racist? Rather than rejecting the Lord as the haughty do, we should take the attitude of the supplicating woman: she was not offended! Jesus knew the humility of her heart before she asked, and to demonstrate her great faith, he tests her response. Not only do we see a strength of mind and character to endure hardship, but we are also called to imitate her perseverance. This is a gift Jesus gives to us, and it should help us accept God in humility rather than on demand.

Have you ever felt tempted to distance yourself from God because you did not get what you wanted? Many of the “children” (of Israel) whom Jesus names as his first priority do not ultimately receive him, but this woman does, and he has power to make her a child of God. As God has delivered all to disobedience to have mercy upon us all, so we should recognize our utter helplessness before Him and never tire of begging for his mercy. He is the desired of nations! He is the Messiah, the savior of the world!

Oh Ven Anhelado de las Naciones, Ven

El himno de adviento *Ven Oh Ven Emanuel* termina con una llamada al Señor, el “anhelo de las naciones,” para reinar como Rey de todas las naciones por su victoria sobre el pecado y la muerte. Aunque estamos todavía muy lejos de celebrar la Navidad, el evangelio de este domingo tiene la misma actitud de reconocer a Jesús como Rey de Reyes y Señor de Señores. (¡Aleluya! ¡Aleluya! ¡Aleluya! ¡Aleluya!)

La mujer cananea en el evangelio muestra una gran perseverancia en la oración mientras que le suplicaba a Jesús que sanara a su hija. Ya que ella no es de la raza de Israel, pareciera que Jesús rechazara su petición. Él además implica que no tiene derecho de pedir “la comida” que debe alimentar a los niños, y no a los “perros”. En vez de salir desanimada, la mujer continúa pidiendo al único que tiene el poder de salvar. ¡Jesús, después de esta prueba, afirma que ella es una mujer de “gran fe” y cura a la niña!

¿Qué debemos entender de este evangelio? ¿Es Jesús un poco grosero? – O peor aún – ¿un racista? No debemos rechazar al Señor como los orgullosos; lo mejor es tomar la actitud de la mujer en el evangelio: ¡ella no se ofendió! Jesús ya conocía la humildad de su corazón, y para mostrar a todos la grandeza de su fe, él la pone a prueba con la respuesta. No solo podemos ver una mente fuerte y carácter para soportar las dificultades, también nosotros somos llamados a imitar su perseverancia. Este es un regalo que Jesús nos da, y debería ayudarnos a aceptar a Dios con humildad, y no como nuestro derecho.

¿Nunca sentiste la tentación de alejarte de Dios porque no recibiste lo que estabas pidiendo? Muchos de los “hijos” (de Israel) de quien habla Jesús como su primera misión no lo reciben, pero esta mujer sí lo hace, y él tiene poder de hacerla hija de Dios. Como el Señor ha permitido que cayéramos en la rebeldía para manifestarnos a todos su misericordia, nosotros debemos reconocer nuestra total impotencia ante Él y nunca debemos dejar de pedir su misericordia. Él es el anhelado de las naciones. Él es el Mesías, ¡el Salvador del mundo!

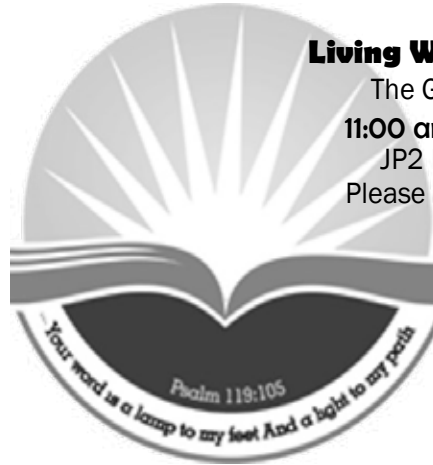

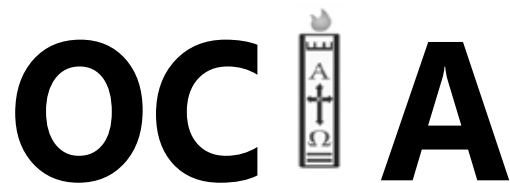

OCIA (formerly RCIA)-"Come Journey With Us"

OCIA, or the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is the process in which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church. Participants go through a process of nurturing their relationship with God, becoming familiar with the Catholic teachings and practices, studying the Gospel, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation.

OCIA, or the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is open to ALL who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith:

- a non-baptized person.
- a member of another Christian church who is interested in the Catholic faith.
- a baptized Catholic who has not received First Communion or Confirmation, or
- a Catholic who has been away from the Church and desires to become an active member again.

OCIA classes at St. John Paul II are held on Sunday mornings, beginning late September, and culminate in the celebration of sacraments at Easter-time. Call the parish office now to register or for more information at 815.933.7683.

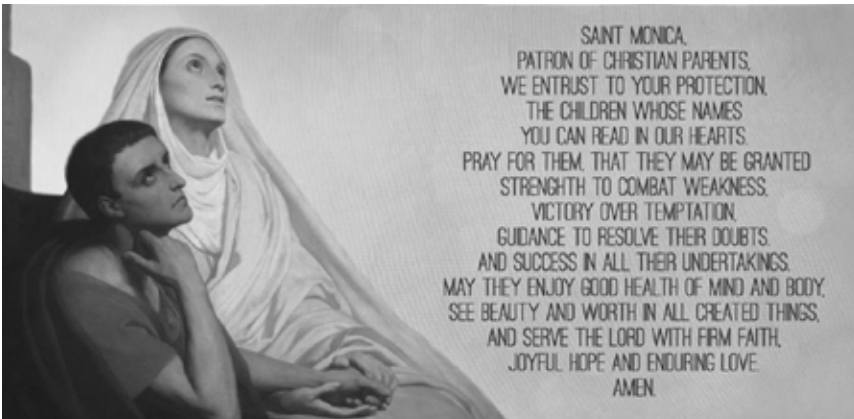
