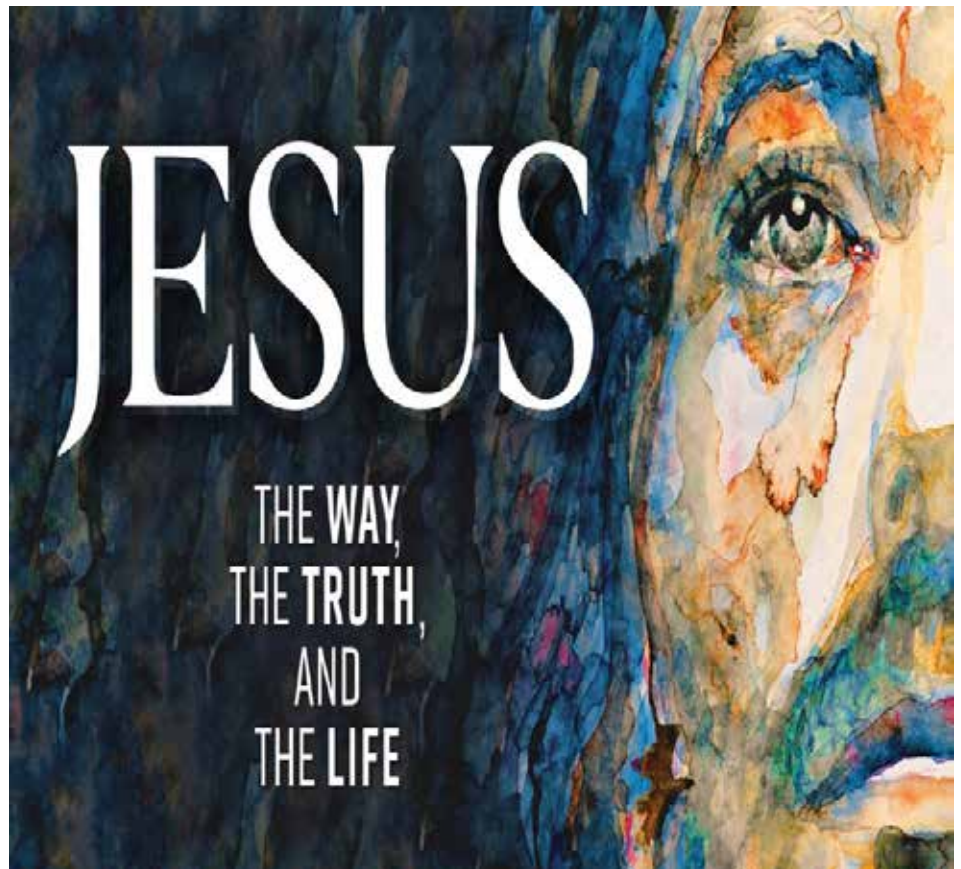

HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

Over the past nine years, I have been singing to our mothers during the mass. I did not intend to make it a personal tradition during my time here in Kankakee, but it just happened. I come from a country where singing to your loved ones is a way of life. That is why it is natural for me to personally express my deepest sentiments and prayers in song, and so, when I greet my mother and all mothers in a special way on this special day, I go back to singing, to a serenade for mothers.

Over the years, I have been surrounded by women in the church. I have built a network of strong friendships with women, who have indeed enriched my life as a priest. I have worked with them in ministry, they have helped me in my stresses, they have given me counsel on how to approach certain issues that I had to face, and most importantly, they have spiritually supported me with their devotions and prayers. I remember the women who gave me food to eat, and the women who would drop goodies at the rectory. I remember the women who cleaned the priest house and set things right and fresh for me to live comfortably. I remember the women who wrote me beautiful letters of encouragement and appreciation. I remember the women who planted flowers in the garden. I remember the women who asked me how I am doing during a stressful day, or asked me how she could help make things better. I remember the women who kept me grounded, and reminded me to do my best and put forward my best self in all that I do; God knows I needed those reminders in many situations that I have faced. I remember the women who told me to not be afraid to use my gifts. I remember the women who gave me hugs and pat my back.

In a sense, I have found in each of them an essence of the most important person in my life -my own mother, Elma Castillo, who is the reason why I am who I am today. God gave her to me as my mother, in order to shape my character and instill lifelong values of faith, hope and love, in service of God and the Church. Every woman that has helped me in my priestly life has become a re-expression of the essence of motherhood that I have known from my own mother. In principle, every woman is a mother, because every woman has a nurturing essence in their soul, that is the little piece of my own mother that I recognize in every woman that comes my way.

And so, our dear mothers, and women of the Church, how can we honor you today and every day? We pray that the rest of us find every possible way to make you know that you are loved, respected and appreciated.

As for me, I pray that all women find within themselves the greatest value and be empowered to use their gifts to live excellently, as God intended for them. And as I have always done in the past, I will sing you a song from my heart. For the years to come, I hope that on Mother's Day, you will remember the Filipino priest that once came your way, and sang from his heart, his love and respect for mothers. God bless you always!

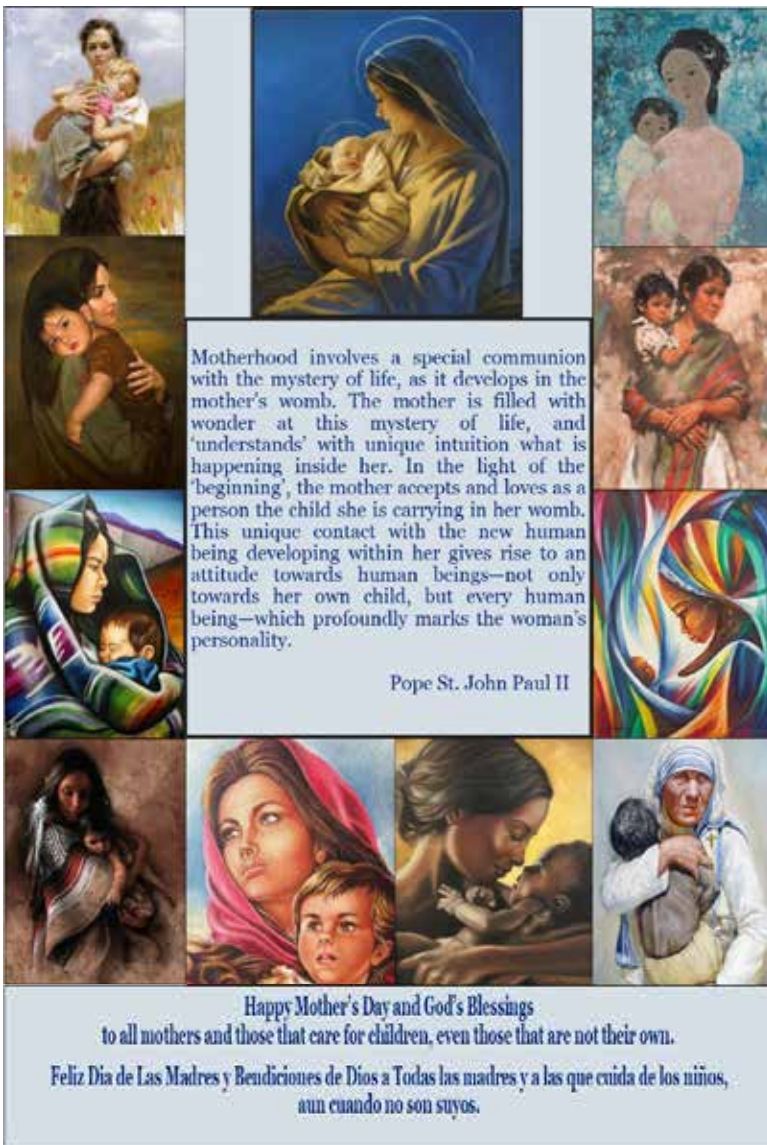

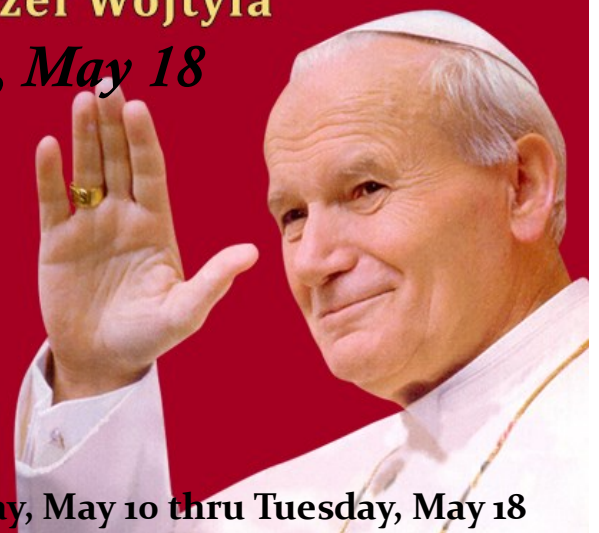

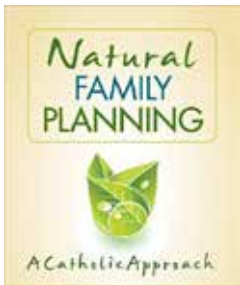
