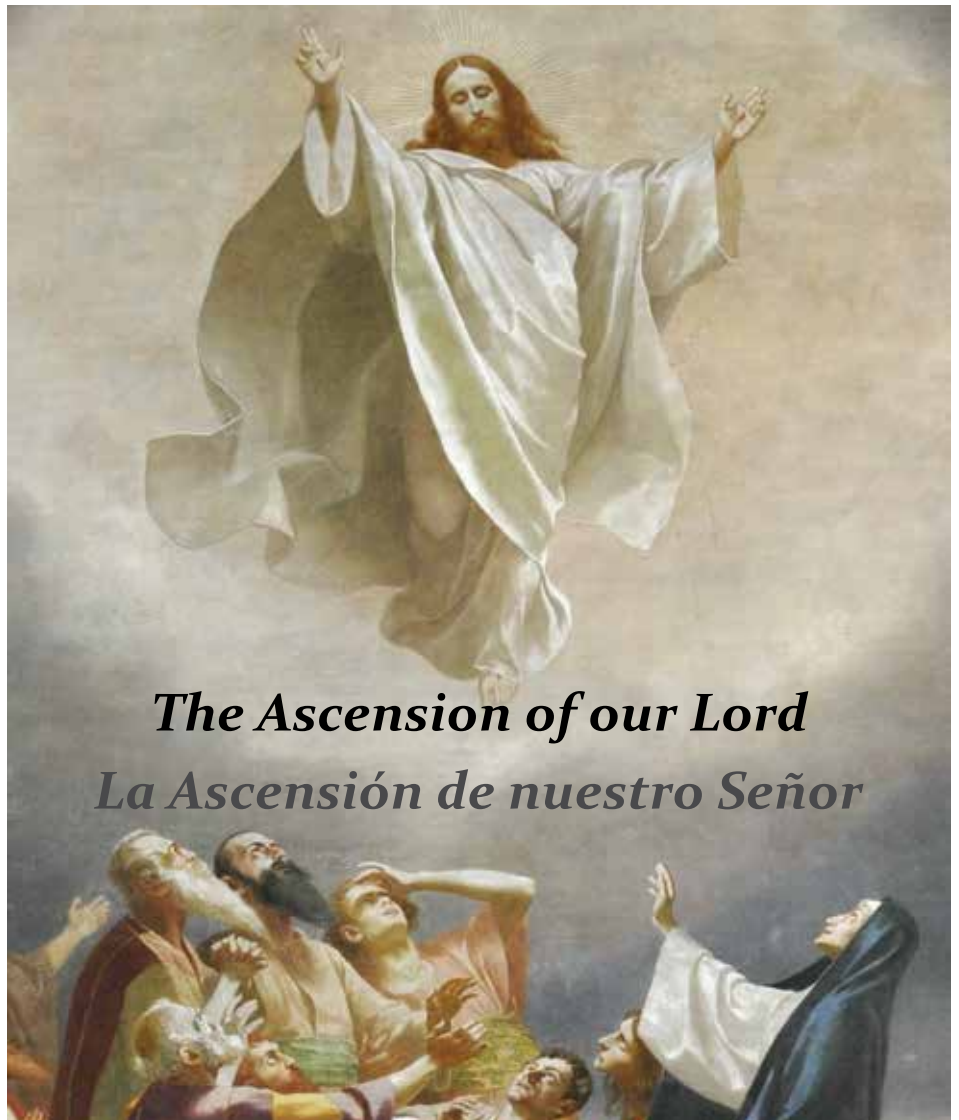

GETTING READY TO RE-OPEN: STEPS TOWARDS A SAFE RETURN TO CHURCH



Over the past few weeks, I have been involved in conversations with Bishop Pates and other priests of the Diocese of Joliet to see how we can prudently re-open our churches for sacraments, services and masses, with the hope that our parish will somehow return to a level of normalcy. Over the past two months, we have tried our best to reach out to our parishioners through social media and other extraordinary observances, but deep within, we all just hope to be able to get back to church.

The Diocese of Joliet has unfolded a three-phase plan into getting back to church, with guidelines to maintain some level of safety from possible contagion.

How have we been lately? As it is, we have been faced with all kinds of reactions from people across the board, from those who are anxious to get back to church to those who are literally upset that churches have been closed, to people who are calm about it and are accepting of the guidelines from our Bishop or the collective efforts of the Illinois Government and local entities of healthcare and the church. Some have looked at this with a political lens, conspiracy theories, legalities, canonical norms, some have blamed the Bishops, but let me tell you all that majority of our parishioners, especially those who have come during our drive-by celebration of our patron's centennial birthday, have expressed nothing but sentiments of appreciation and gratitude for all the efforts that we have put out during this pandemic.

Where are we headed? The Phase 1 of our return to church is to offer baptisms, reconciliation, weddings and funerals, with a maximum restriction of ten people, with social distancing. The Phase 1B of the process is to open the church for visit and eucharistic adoration, still maintaining a maximum restriction of ten persons, also with social distancing. The Phase 2 is a return to public masses, without a specific restriction of numbers, but with social distancing still in effect, our people will be asked to use ticketing strategies to be able to ensure safety and participation. Our parish implementation team is being mobilized and trained for these purposes these days.

One important point to be underscored is that in our conversations with Bishop Pates, who has been collaborating with the Illinois Province of the Catholic Church, the obligation for Sunday mass will remain lifted and dispensed until further notice. There is also a great emphasis to keep utmost care for the safety of the vulnerable during this time, and to make sure that those who feel ill or under the weather or may be experiencing any symptoms of sickness, are strongly asked to stay home in the spirit of charity.

As I end this bulletin article, allow me to thank the leadership of our parish for their constancy in supporting the decisions that have been passed on to us the local church. I also want to say thank you to the many that have continued to engage us in our efforts to remain connected during this pandemic. Special thanks for the unforgettable celebration of our patron's centennial birthday last weekend. I just watched our children praying the rosary together online, and I knew our Church is well... and the Holy Spirit remains. God bless us all.

PREPARANDONOS PARA RE-ABRIR: PASOS HACIA UN REGRESO SEGURO A LA IGLESIA

En las últimas semanas, he estado involucrado en conversaciones con el Obispo Pates y otros sacerdotes de la Diócesis de Joliet para ver cómo podemos re-abrir prudentemente nuestras iglesias para sacramentos, servicios y misas, con la esperanza de que nuestra parroquia vuelva de alguna manera a un nivel de normalidad. En los últimos dos meses, hemos hecho todo lo posible para llegar a nuestros feligreses a través de los medios sociales y otras celebraciones extraordinarias, pero en el fondo, todos esperamos poder volver a la iglesia.

La Diócesis de Joliet ha desarrollado un plan de tres fases para volver a la iglesia, con directrices para mantener cierto nivel de seguridad ante un posible contagio.

¿Cómo hemos estado últimamente? Tal como está, nos hemos enfrentado a todo tipo de reacciones de la gente en general, desde los que están ansiosos por volver a la iglesia a los que están literalmente molestos porque las iglesias se cerraron, a las personas que están tranquilas al respecto y aceptan las directrices de nuestro Obispo o los esfuerzos colectivos del Gobierno de Illinois y las entidades locales del departamento de salud y la iglesia. Algunos han visto esto con un lente político, teorías de conspiración, legalidades, normas canónicas, algunos han culpado a los obispos, pero déjenme decirles a todos que la mayoría de nuestros feligreses, especialmente los que han venido durante la celebración de-pasada del centenario de nuestro patrono, no han expresado nada más que sentimientos de aprecio y gratitud por todos los esfuerzos que hemos hecho durante esta pandemia.

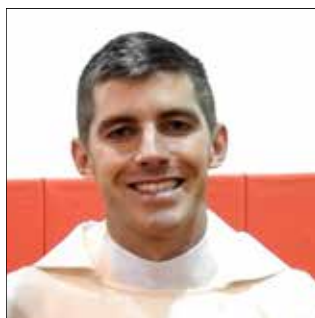
¿A dónde nos dirigimos? La fase 1 de nuestro regreso a la iglesia es ofrecer bautismo, reconciliación, boda y funeral, con una restricción máxima de diez personas, con distanciamiento social. La Fase 1B del proceso es abrir la iglesia para visita y Adoración Eucarística, manteniendo una restricción máxima de diez personas, también con distanciamiento social. La Fase 2 es un regreso a las misas públicas, sin una restricción de cifras específica, pero con el distanciamiento social todavía en vigor, se le pedirá a nuestra gente que use estrategias de boletos para poder garantizar la seguridad y la participación. En estos días, nuestro equipo de implementación parroquial está siendo movilizado y entrenado para estos propósitos.

Un punto importante a destacar es que en nuestras conversaciones con el Obispo Pates, que ha estado colaborando con la Provincia de Illinois de la Iglesia Católica, la obligación de la misa dominical permanecerá levantada y dispensada hasta nuevo aviso. También se hace gran hincapié en mantener el máximo cuidado por la seguridad de los vulnerables durante este tiempo, y en asegurarse de que los que se sienten enfermos, decaídos, o puedan estar experimentando cualquier síntoma de enfermedad, se les pida encarecidamente que se queden en casa en el espíritu de la caridad.

Al terminar este artículo del boletín, permítanme agradecer al liderazgo de nuestra parroquia por su constante apoyo a las decisiones que nos han sido transmitidas como iglesia local. También quiero dar las gracias a tantos que han continuado comprometiéndose con nuestros esfuerzos para permanecer conectados durante esta pandemia. Un agradecimiento especial por la inolvidable celebración del centenario de nuestro patrono el pasado fin de semana. Acabo de ver a nuestros niños rezando juntos el rosario en línea, y supe que nuestra Iglesia está bien... y el Espíritu Santo permanece. Dios nos bendiga a todos.

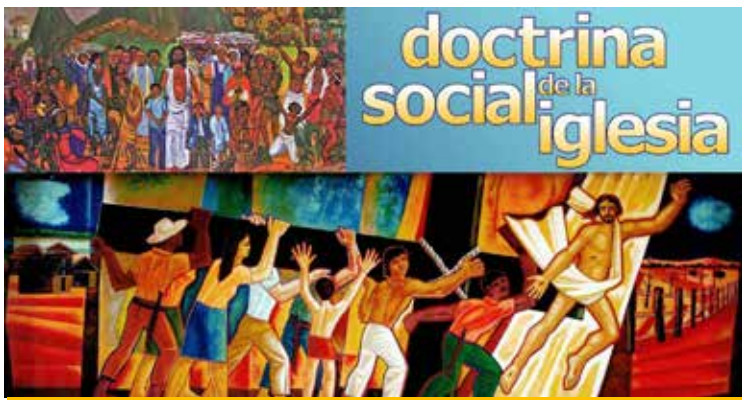

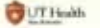
