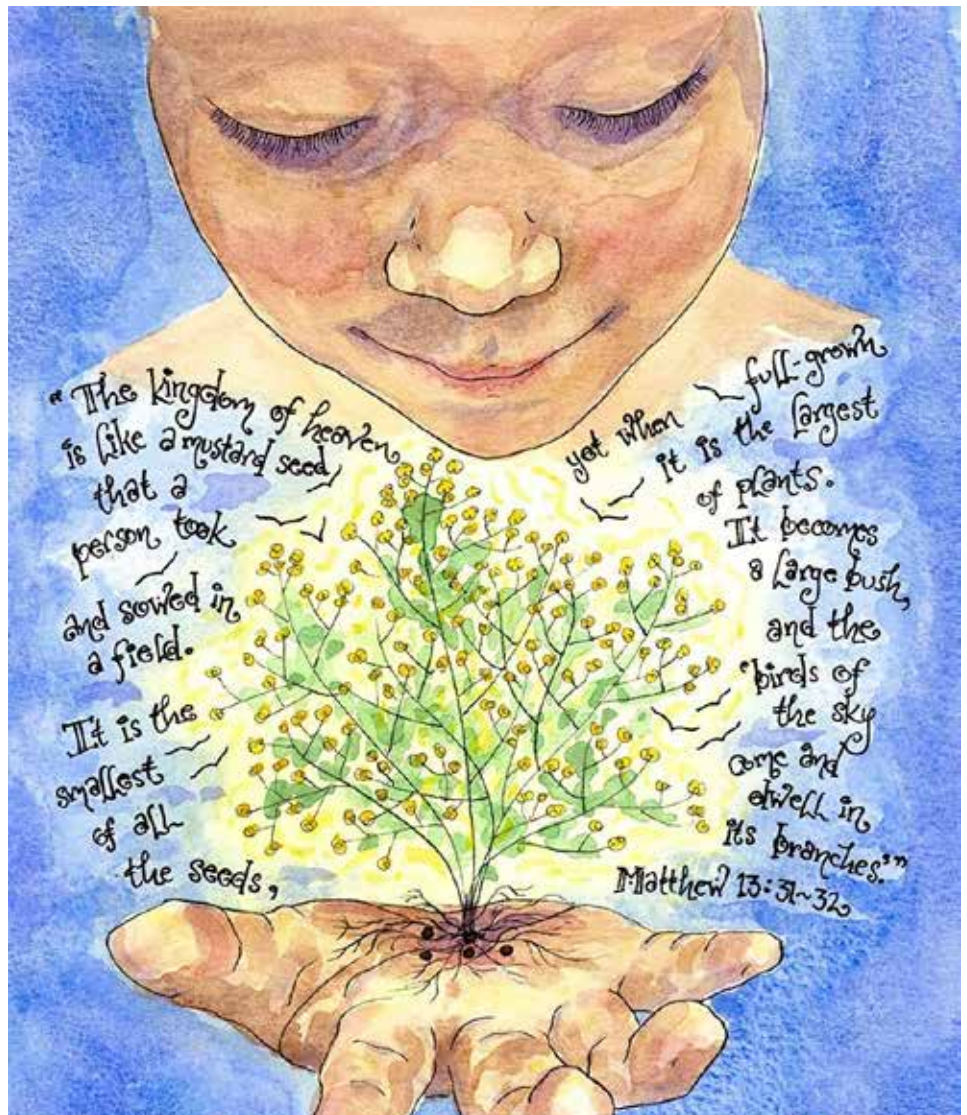

"Bringing Jesus to Everyone and Everyone to Jesus!"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Recently I have been thinking about the activities I used to do that I have not done as much this year—particularly baseball games, summer vacations, and Fourth of July holidays spent with family and friends. Even though the number of tasks and duties was lessened this year, I found myself surprisingly in need of short breaks during the Shelter in Place Order. Not only was there stress around the situation and all of the changes and uncertainty that accompanied it, but I also came to realize that it is good and necessary to take a break every once in a while and recharge the batteries. Not only are annual vacations and holidays throughout the year important for us, but for us Catholics, the Lord's Day is critical for our spiritual well-being. Sunday is our day of rest. Every Sunday, Christians have remembered that first Easter Sunday, when our Lord saved us by rising from the dead, and we have celebrated that day with the very sacrament Christ instituted as He began the work of redemption: the Holy Eucharist. Sunday is meant to be set aside as time for God and family. It is tempting to approach Sunday like any other day or to fill the day with chores and tasks left over from the weekend's to-do list. However, we need that day of rest, spending it in charity: loving God and neighbor. Even though there is still a dispensation from the Sunday obligation because of the pandemic, I encourage you to continue to make the holy Eucharist a part of your Sunday routine. If you are in good health, able, and comfortable to attend Mass, you can call the parish office to reserve a seat. We have reservations because of the limited amount of seating due to social distancing restrictions. Another way to stay close to our Lord who is truly and really present in the Holy Eucharist, in addition to watching the Mass online, is to visit the tabernacle that has been set up behind the windows on Charles Street. It is easy to find, and you can pray a spiritual communion or spend time with our Lord from your car or outside.

I also encourage you to give yourself a break each day, to refresh the soul through prayer. St. Therese of Lisieux wrote, "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." When we look toward heaven and lift up our hearts to God, we approach that throne of grace by which a weary soul receives refreshment. It is like going to the well, and our Lord extends to us the very same life-giving water that will bubble up within us and last forever that he promised the Samaritan woman. Let us take a break each day and turn to our Lord in prayer. There we can gain peace, hope, mercy, wisdom, and joy. So, I encourage you to find time each day or throughout the day for prayer. Then, the prayer of St. Augustine will ring true for each of us: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord. And our heart is restless until it rests in you."

Queridas Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Recientemente he estado pensando en las actividades de los años anteriores que no he hecho este año— particularmente los partidos de béisbol, las vacaciones de verano y las fiestas del 4 de julio con familiares y amigos. Aunque la cantidad de tareas y deberes se redujo este año, me encontré sorprendentemente en la necesidad de descansos breves durante la Orden de Quedarse en Casa. No sólo hubo estrés por la situación y los cambios e incertidumbre que la acompañaron, sino que también me di cuenta de que es bueno y necesario tomar un descanso de vez en cuando y recargar las baterías. No sólo las vacaciones anuales y las festividades durante el año son importantes para nosotros, para nosotros católicos, el Día del Señor es fundamental para nuestro bienestar espiritual. El domingo es nuestro día de descanso. Todos los domingos, los cristianos han recordado el primer domingo de Pascua, cuando nuestro Señor nos salvó resucitando de la muerte, y hemos celebrado ese día con el mismo sacramento que Cristo instituyó cuando comenzó la obra de la redención: la Sagrada Eucaristía. El domingo está destinado a ser reservado como tiempo para Dios y la familia. Es una tentación tratar el domingo como cualquier otro día o llenarlo con quehaceres y tareas incompletas de la lista de quehaceres del fin de semana. Sin embargo, necesitamos ese día de descanso y caridad: pasarlo con amor para Dios y el prójimo. Aunque todavía hay una dispensación de la obligación dominical debido a la pandemia, los animo a que continúen haciendo la sagrada Eucaristía una parte de su rutina dominical. Si tienen buena salud, pueden y se sienten cómodos para asistir a misa, llamen a la oficina parroquial para reservar un asiento. Tenemos reservaciones porque hay una cantidad limitada de asientos debido a las restricciones de distanciamiento social. Otra forma de permanecer cerca de nuestro Señor, que está verdaderamente presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía, además de ver la Misa por internet, es visitar el sagrario que se ha instalado detrás de las ventanas en la calle Charles Street. Es fácil de encontrar, y pueden rezar una comunión espiritual o pasar tiempo con nuestro Señor desde tu auto o afuera.

También los animo a darse un descanso cada día, para refrescar el alma por medio de la oración. En su autobiografía, Santa Teresa de Lisieux escribió: "Para mí, la oración es un impulso del corazón, una sencilla mirada dirigida al cielo, un grito de agradecimiento y de amor tanto desde dentro de la prueba como desde dentro de la alegría." Cuando miramos hacia el cielo y elevamos nuestros corazones hacia Dios, nos acercamos al trono de gracia de donde el alma cansada recibe descanso y paz. Vamos a la Fuente de nuestro Señor quien nos extiende la misma agua vivificante que prometió a la mujer samaritana. Tomemos un descanso cada día y vayamos a nuestro Señor en oración. Allí podemos recibir paz, esperanza, misericordia, sabiduría y alegría. Por eso les invito a reservar tiempo cada día o durante todo el día para orar. Luego, la oración de San Agustín es verdadera para todos nosotros: "Nos hiciste, Señor, para Ti; y nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descansa en Ti".

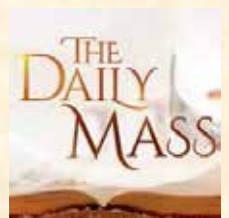

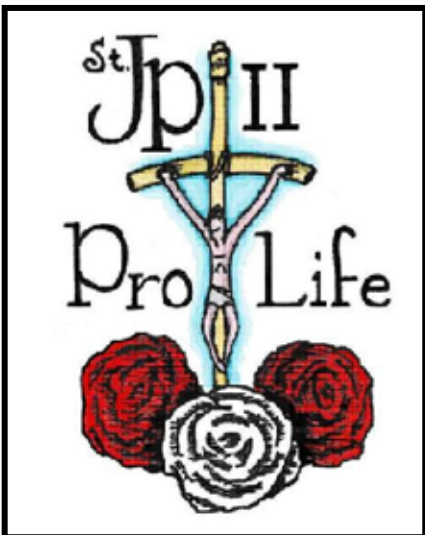

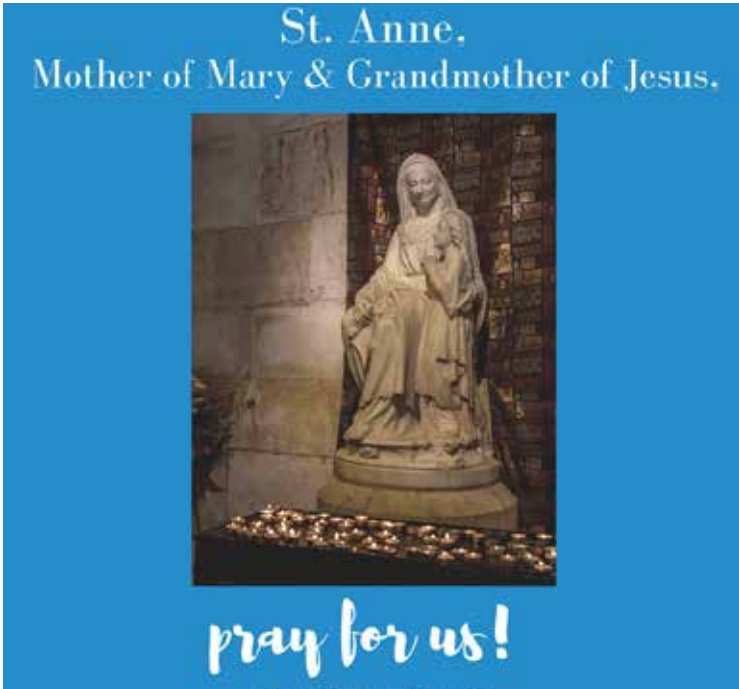
