

God Bless You Fr. Michael Groth The parish family of St. John Paul II congratulates you on your Ordination to the priesthood.



Years ago, Sister Rose Urbanczyk, a Missionary

Sister of the Holy Family, saw something in one of her students at St. Martin of Tours Catholic School in Kankakee and said to him: You're going to be a priest one day.

That student, Michael Groth, had no clue what that meant. After all, he was only in third grade.

Sister Rose's prophecy came true, as Michael is one of seven men who are going to be ordained this month.

The first inkling as to this call coming from his year was the time of his First Communion, he said. In a letter he wrote about First Communion, which Michael looked at years later, he declared in it that he could see himself becoming a priest one day.

A big influence on his vocation was Father Dennis Settles, the pastor of St. Martin's Church, at the time, whom Sister Rose also told that the Young boy was going to be a priest one day. Father Settles acted as a mentor when Michael became an altar server and helper at other events, such as when the bishop came for Confirmations and setting up for Baptisms.

"He gave me a visión for what the priesthood was like apart from the Sunday Mass," Michael said. "I learned about the realities of the priesthood, (and learned from) his care for the people of the parish and his care for me and my family and walking me through what the priesthood looked like."

While he was a student at the local community college, he worked part-time at his parish and also ended up going on a mission trip to the Philippines.

During this time period, he felt it was the right time to apply to seminary and "begin to take this more seriously," he said. "It, (the call), never really went away," he said. "It was there in the background. It was always on my heart."

No one was surprised, he added... Especially not Sister Rose!

Hace años, la Hna. Rose Urbanczyk, una Hermana Misionera de la Sagrada Familia, vio algo en uno de los estudiantes de la Escuela Católica San Martín Caballero en Kankakee, y le dijo: tú vas a ser sacerdote un día.

El estudiante, el Diácono Michael Groth, no tenía idea de lo que eso significaba. Después de todo, él sólo estaba en tercer grado.

La profecía de la Hna. Rose se hizo realidad, ya que Michael es uno de los siete hombres que serán ordenados este mes.

La primera pista a este llamado viene de su año de la Primera Comunión, dijo él. En una carta que escribió sobre la Primera Comunión, la cual Michael vio años después, en ella el declaró que se podía ver a si mismo siendo sacerdote un día.

El Padre Dennis Settles fue una gran influencia en su vocación, el pastor de la Iglesia San Martín, en ese tiempo, a quien la Hna. Rose también le dijo que el niño sería un sacerdote un día. El Padre Settles actuó como su mentor cuando Michael se convirtió en monaguillo, y ayudante en otros eventos, tales como cuando el obispo venía para Confirmaciones y preparando para los bautismos.

"Él me dio una visión de lo que es el sacerdocio, aparte de la Misa Dominical," dijo Michael. "Aprendí sobre las realidades del sacerdocio [y aprendí de] su cuidado hacia las personas de la parroquia, su cuidado por mí y mi familia, y me guio a través de lo que es el sacerdocio."

Mientras era un estudiante en el colegio comunitario local, él trabajó en esta parroquia medio tiempo y también fue a un viaje misionero a las Filipinas.

Durante este periodo, él sintió que era tiempo de aplicar al seminario y "comenzó a tomarlo más seriamente," dijo. "Estaba ahí en los antecedentes. Siempre estuvo en mí corazón."

Nadie se sorprendió, añadió – especialmente la Hna. Rose.




The **CCW Woman of the Year** is selected from nominations based on characteristics that exemplify the CCW expectations.

They will be scheduling the youth to work at the local food pantries in the area including



- Northern Illinois Food Bank truck unloading in both Kankakee and Pembroke.


