A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

UNA NOTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are approaching our Passover: Easter. On the first Feast of Passover, the Hebrew people were enslaved by the pharaoh in Egypt. As Moses pleaded with the pharaoh on behalf of his people to let them go, the angel of death passed over the houses of the Hebrew people who had sprinkled the blood of a lamb on the wood of their doorposts. This event led them to be freed from slavery to the pharaoh and, guided by God, begin their forty year journey to the Promised Land. Jesus' betrayal and death occurred on the Passover in order to fulfill it. Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God, our lamb, whose blood was poured forth upon the wood of the cross. By Jesus' death and resurrection, death has passed over us and we have been set free from slavery to sin so that we can journey to the Promised Land of Heaven. Easter reminds us of our salvation, who we are, and where we are going. We have been given a great gift, a gift more precious than anything the world can ever give. The Creator Himself, God, has given Himself to us so that we can have eternal life. I can't earn eternal life by my own merits and actions. I am only human, but God has chosen to unite humanity to Himself, and, in a perfect act of love and mercy, has conquered sin and destroyed death so that we might have life and have it in abundance in the Promised Land of Heaven.

Next Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday, the 27th through the 29th of March), Fr. Roy and I will be presenting the parish mission on, "The Still Days: a Retreat on the Passion of Jesus". We will be reflecting on what our Lord accomplished on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter, and how we experience it today. I encourage you to attend.

Know of my daily prayers for all of you, and let us continue to pray for one another.

Nos acercamos a nuestra Pascua. En la primera fiesta de la Pascua, los hebreos fueron esclavizados por el faraón en Egipto. Cuando Moisés le pido al faraón en nombre de su pueblo que los dejara ir, el ángel de la muerte pasó por encima de las casas de los hebreos que habían salpicado la sangre de un cordero en los postes de sus puertas. Este evento los llevó a ser liberados de la esclavitud del faraón y, guiados por Dios, comenzar su viaje de cuarenta años a la Tierra Prometida. La traición y la muerte de Jesús ocurrieron en la Pascua para cumplirla. Jesucristo es el Cordero de Dios, nuestro cordero, cuya sangre fue derramada sobre la madera de la cruz. Por la muerte y resurrección de Jesús, hemos sido liberados de la esclavitud al pecado y la muerte para viajar a la Tierra Prometida del Cielo. La Pascua nos recuerda nuestra salvación, quiénes somos y hacia dónde nos dirigimos. Se nos ha dado un gran regalo, un regalo más precioso que cualquier cosa que el mundo pueda dar. El Creador mismo, Dios, se ha entregado a nosotros para que podamos tener vida eterna. No puedo ganar la vida eterna por mis propios méritos y acciones. Soy solo humano, pero Dios ha decidido unir a la humanidad con él mismo y, en una acción perfecta de amor y misericordia, ha vencido el pecado y destruido la muerte para que podamos tener vida y la obtengamos en abundancia en la Tierra Prometida del Cielo.

El próximo domingo, lunes y martes, 27 al 29 de marzo, Padre Roy y yo presentaremos el retiro parroquial sobre "Los Días de Silencio Absoluto: un Retiro sobre la Pasión de Jesús".
