We are in the middle of promoting our ministries under the banner of Discipleship and Evangelization Commission. Last weekend, Jacob Levy spoke at our masses to tell everyone about our goals and current successes in this commission, and as you have heard, there is plenty to talk about.



SE BUSCA: DISCIPULOS ALEGRES

Estamos en medio de promover nuestros ministerios bajo la bandera de la Comisión de Discipulado y Evangelización. El fin de semana pasado, Jacob Levy habló en nuestras misas para contarles a todos sobre nuestros objetivos y éxitos actuales en esta comisión, y como han escuchado, hay mucho de qué hablar.

Evangelization is Jesus' mandate to every person baptized, to every follower. In fact, it is so attached to our baptismal reality, as we hear Jesus said, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28: 19-20). Baptism and discipleship are so connected to each other, and the Lord desires that everyone is invited to be baptized and become a disciple for salvation. In other words, every parishioner is required to evangelize, to teach and invite others to Christ.

The Diocese of Joliet is being very pro-active in inviting every person of the Catholic faith to take this as a personal calling. The Bishop has been having a lot of conversations regarding this, calling the priests of the diocese to unify our efforts to do the same. There is also a vision to organize evangelization groups within the deaneries, and have some local contacts from each parish that will work directly on realizing a dynamic and intentional culture of discipleship and evangelization in the entire diocese.

May I say that our parish is at the frontline of this vision. We have been doing the programs, and offering them to people, with the hopes that those who come will find that special connection with God, through the rich traditions, written and oral, of the Church. There has also been an important emphasis in our parish for personal relationships – our relationship with one another, though never perfect, can be used for higher relationships that are perfect and eternal. That is why it is important that we become friends in the walk of faith. Building a strong community of faithful disciples leads to the effective proclamation of the Gospel. Our parish relationships are the fundamental infrastructures where the Word of God and the Truth of Faith becomes real and life-changing to so many. The programs are good, but the key to bearing the fruits of these programs is holy and life-giving relationships. And so, whatever ministry we are involved in here at church, I invite all of us to look at them as opportunities to proclaim the Lord Jesus Christ, and to bring people closer to Him. That should be the one, true and essential reason why we do the things that we do here at St. John Paul II.

And of course, let us do all of it with JOY. There is nothing more attractive than happy disciples. It is good for the soul, it makes those who are looking from the outside curious, while it inspires those who are working within to remain enthusiastic in ministry.

God bless our efforts to build His kingdom on earth. God bless and guide our parish.

La evangelización es el mandato de Jesús para cada persona bautizada, para cada seguidor. De hecho, está tan apegado a nuestra realidad bautismal, cuando escuchamos a Jesús decir: "Ve, por lo tanto, y haz discípulos de todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo, enseñándoles a observar todo lo que te he mandado. Y he aquí, yo estoy contigo siempre, hasta el fin de los tiempos" (Mateo 28: 19-20). El bautismo y el discipulado están tan conectados entre sí, y el Señor desea que todos estén invitados a ser bautizados y convertirse en discípulos para la salvación. En otras palabras, todos los feligreses deben evangelizar, enseñar e invitar a otros a Cristo.

La Diócesis de Joliet está siendo muy proactiva al invitar a todas las personas de la fe católica a tomar esto como un llamado personal. El Obispo ha estado teniendo muchas conversaciones al respecto, llamando a los sacerdotes de la diócesis a unificar nuestros esfuerzos para hacer lo mismo. También existe la visión de organizar grupos de evangelización dentro de los decanos, y tener algunos contactos locales de cada parroquia que trabajen directamente en la realización de una cultura dinámica e intencional de discipulado y evangelización en toda la diócesis.

Permítanme decir que nuestra parroquia está en la primera línea de esta visión. Hemos estado haciendo los programas y ofreciéndolos a las personas, con la esperanza de que los que vengan encuentren esa conexión especial con Dios, a través de las ricas tradiciones, escritas y orales, de la Iglesia. También ha habido un énfasis importante en nuestra parroquia para las relaciones personales: nuestra relación entre nosotros, aunque nunca perfecta, puede usarse para relaciones superiores que son perfectas y eternas. Por eso es importante que nos hagamos amigos en el camino de la fe. Construir una comunidad fuerte de discípulos fieles conduce a la proclamación efectiva del Evangelio. Nuestras relaciones parroquiales son las infraestructuras fundamentales donde la Palabra de Dios y la Verdad de la Fe se vuelven reales y cambian la vida de muchos. Los programas son buenos, pero la clave para dar los frutos de estos programas son las relaciones santas y vivificantes. Y así, sea cual sea el ministerio en el que estemos involucrados aquí en la iglesia, invito a todos a mirarlo como oportunidades para proclamar al Señor Jesucristo y acercar a las personas a Él. Esa debería ser la única razón verdadera y esencial por la que hacemos las cosas que hacemos aquí en San Juan Pablo II.

Y, por supuesto, hagámoslo todo con ALEGRÍA. No hay nada más otra que los discípulos felices. Es bueno para el alma; hace que los que miran desde el exterior sientan curiosidad, mientras que inspira a quienes trabajan en el interior a permanecer entusiasmados en el ministerio.

Dios bendiga nuestros esfuerzos para construir su reino en la tierra. Dios bendiga y guíe nuestra parroquia.
