A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Thank you to all who have donated to the organ! We have met our goal. While we prepare for the installation of the organ in the next month or so, we are also planning on refinishing the pews, putting in new flooring in the church, as well as installing new spring lift kneelers. The pews are in dire need of refinishing, and we have received donations throughout the years for new flooring and kneelers. Thanks to recent donations as well as restricted donations from individual donors and events such as the Oktoberfest, we have the funds to refinish the pews, put tile in the church, and change the carpet in the sacristy and confessional. We have some funds set aside for the kneelers, which will be new and light-weight. To offset the cost, there will be an envelope for new kneelers on February 2nd, if you would like to contribute to it. The project will not affect Sunday Masses other than chairs being set up to replace pews as they are being restored week after week.

After consulting the finance council and parish council and speaking with members of the parish, this is a need and a good time to enhance and care for our church. After all, at the heart of who we are as a family of faith is our worship, which brings us together in Christ. Last week, we celebrated Epiphany, recalling when the Magi found the baby Jesus and adored Him, presenting Him with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Baptism of the Lord this weekend, we recall that God has visited His people, entered into our history, and redeemed us. This is good news! Like the Magi, our adoration and worship are a response to the Good News of God's presence and our redemption. In that context, we hear Isaiah's command in our first reading this weekend: "Go up on to a high mountain, Zion, herald of glad tidings; cry out at the top of your voice, Jerusalem, herald of good news! Fear not to cry out and say to the cities of Judah: Here is your God! Here comes with power the Lord GOD... Like a shepherd he feeds his flock; in his arms he gathers the lambs, carrying them in his bosom, and leading the ewes with care." God is present, and He feeds us. Central to who we are is the Mass, when, out of gratitude and faith, we come together in the Lord and are fed by Him. Thank you for your generosity and devotion, and know that I remember you and your loved ones in my daily prayers.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

¡Gracias a todos los que donaron para el órgano! Hemos alcanzado nuestra meta. Mientras nos preparamos para la instalación del órgano el próximo mes, también estamos planeando renovar las bancas, poner pisos nuevos en la iglesia e instalar nuevos reclinatorios con resorte. Las bancas necesitan renovarse urgentemente y hemos recibido donaciones a lo largo de los años para pisos nuevos y reclinatorios. Gracias a las donaciones recientes, así como a las donaciones restringidas de donantes individuales y eventos como el Oktoberfest, tenemos los fondos para renovar las bancas, poner pisos en la iglesia y cambiar la alfombra de la sacristía y el confesionario. Tenemos algunos fondos para los reclinatorios, que serán nuevos y livianos. Para compensar el costo, habrá un sobre para nuevos reclinatorios el 2 de febrero, por si desea contribuir. El proyecto no afectará las misas dominicales, semana tras semana se instalarán sillas para reemplazar las bancas a medida que se restauran.

Después de consultar al consejo de finanzas y al consejo parroquial y hablar con los miembros de la parroquia, esta es una necesidad y un buen momento para mejorar y cuidar nuestra iglesia. Después de todo, en el corazón de quienes somos como una familia de fe está nuestra adoración, que nos une en Cristo. La semana pasada, celebramos la Epifanía, recordando cuando los Reyes Magos encontraron al niño Jesús y lo adoraron, presentándole regalos de oro, incienso y mirra. Al celebrar la Solemnidad del Bautismo del Señor este fin de semana, recordamos que Dios ha visitado a su pueblo, ha entrado en nuestra historia y nos ha redimido. ¡Esta es una buena noticia! Al igual que los Reyes Magos, nuestra adoración y culto son una respuesta a la Buena Nueva de la presencia de Dios y nuestra redención. En ese contexto, escuchamos el mandato de Isaías en nuestra primera lectura de este fin de semana: "Sube a lo alto del monte, mensajero de buenas nuevas para Sión; alza con fuerza la voz, tú que anuncias noticias alegres a Jerusalén. Alza la voz y no temas; anuncia a los ciudadanos de Judá: Aquí está su Dios... Como pastor apacentará su rebaño; llevará en sus brazos a los corderitos recién nacidos y atenderá solícito a sus madres." Dios está presente y nos alimenta. En el centro de lo que somos está la Misa, cuando, por gratitud y fe, nos reunimos en el Señor y somos alimentados por Él. Gracias por su generosidad y devoción, y sepán que los recuerdo a ustedes y a sus seres queridos en mis oraciones diarias.




