Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday is different from the other Sundays of Advent. Today, the candle on the Advent wreath and the vestments of the priests and deacons take a break from purple, a color which symbolizes penitence and preparation, and are adorned in rose (or pink). None of the other Sundays in Advent have a name, but today is “Gaudete Sunday”—Gaudete is Latin for “Rejoice!” We take a break from the nighttime purple of Advent to rejoice with the color rose as the light of the Son of God begins to dawn. The coming of Christ on Christmas is near, and the feast of the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, which is the cause of our joy, is quickly approaching.

So what does this Sunday tell us about the rest of Advent? We need this Sunday because, practically, we need a glimpse of Christmas joy and a reminder that the reason for our preparation, the coming of our beloved Savior, will soon be here. It focuses us. Advent is not a mini and pre-emptive Christmas season. Rather, it is a season of preparation and waiting. Waiting is an act of hope by which we create and prepare a space to receive the one we expect, in this case Jesus Christ. As the church moves from being a somewhat silent space to being filled with decorations and instruments in celebration of the joyful feast of our Lord’s Nativity, let us do the same. During this Advent, have we created that space to receive our Lord? Have we set aside time for prayer? Have we prepared our souls to receive Christ anew through the sacrament of penance and reconciliation? Have we stopped to reflect on the lights and evergreens as a reminder of the radiant coming of Christ, the author of life? The lights, trees, bows, presents, and parties are not the end, but they assist us in our celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ. Let us receive Him anew! While the world is always being distracted by constant movement, chaos, and conflicts, it received its Creator and Savior in the silence and stillness of the night in the little town of Bethlehem. Let us continue to create that serene, quiet, and trusting place in our lives so that we may receive with great joy our Beloved Lord Jesus Christ: “Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near” (Phil. 4:4-5).

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Este domingo es diferente de los otros domingos de Adviento. Hoy, la vela en la corona de adviento y las vestiduras de los sacerdotes y diáconos descansan del morado, que simboliza la penitencia y la preparación, y se adornan en rosa. Ninguno de los otros domingos en Adviento tiene un nombre, pero

hoy es el "Domingo Gaudete". Gaudete en latín significa "¡Alégrate!" Hacemos una pausa en la púrpura nocturna del Adviento para regocijarnos con el color rosa cuando comienza a amanecer la luz del Hijo de Dios. La venida de Cristo en Navidad está cerca, y la fiesta de la Natividad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que es la causa de nuestra alegría, se acerca rápidamente.

Entonces, ¿qué nos dice este domingo sobre el resto de Adviento? Necesitamos este domingo porque, prácticamente, necesitamos un vistazo de la alegría navideña y un recordatorio de que el propósito de nuestra preparación, la venida de nuestro Salvador, pronto estará aquí. Nos enfoca. El Adviento no es una temporada navideña pequeña y preventiva. Más bien, es una temporada de preparación y espera. Esperar es un acto de esperanza por el cual creamos y preparamos un espacio para recibir al que esperamos, en este caso Jesucristo. Mientras la iglesia pasa de ser un espacio un tanto silencioso a llenarse de adornos e instrumentos para celebrar la alegre fiesta de la Natividad de nuestro Señor, hagamos lo mismo. Durante este Adviento, ¿hemos creado espacio para recibir a nuestro Señor? ¿Hemos reservado tiempo para la oración? ¿Hemos preparado nuestras almas para recibir a Cristo nuevamente a través del sacramento de la penitencia y la reconciliación? ¿Nos hemos detenido a reflexionar sobre las luces y los pinos como recordatorios de la radiante venida de Cristo, el autor de la vida? Las luces, los árboles, los moños, los regalos y las fiestas no son el fin, pero nos ayudan en nuestra celebración del nacimiento de Jesucristo. ¡Recibámoslo nuevamente! Mientras que el mundo está siempre distraído con el movimiento constante, el caos y los conflictos, recibió a su Creador y Salvador en el silencio y la quietud de la noche en la pequeña ciudad de Belén. Sigamos creando en nuestras vidas ese lugar sereno, tranquilo y confiado para que podamos recibir con gran alegría a nuestro Amado Señor Jesucristo: “Alérgense siempre en el Señor; se los repito: ¡alérgense! El Señor está cerca”. (Fil. 4: 4-5).


