

A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The cross has become a normal part of our lives. We begin and end our prayers and receive blessings with the sign of the cross. We hang up crosses in our bedrooms and wear them on necklaces. Crosses adorn our churches and holy books and devotionals. The cross is so ubiquitous because of its importance, meaning, and power. Although it is an ordinary part of our lives, it is an extraordinary symbol. Through the cross of Christ, the love of God has conquered sin and death and won for us salvation. God Himself entered into our suffering so that we might share in His glory. God chose to redeem us by being close to us, entering into our suffering with us, and conquering death for us. All of this being motivated by love: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends" (Jn 15:13). Always remember our Lord's love for you. Even when you experience the cross and suffering in your own life, raise your eyes to the cross of Christ, remembering that He is with you always.

The night before Jesus died, as He was entering into His passion, our Lord took bread and wine and said, "This is my body... This is the chalice of my blood." In every Eucharist, the perfect and loving offering on the cross on calvary that has conquered death itself is shared with us. In the Mass, we are not imitating Christ in the Last Supper, but we are joining ourselves to the Risen Lord who has given us this holy sacrament at the Last Supper, a sacrament which nourishes us and draws us into the mystery of our salvation: "We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again." We also cry out to our Lord, "Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free." Let us continue to recognize the presence of the Risen Christ and the reality of His saving love shared with us in every Mass.

Please join us this Sunday for doughnuts and fellowship after the 9:30 Mass as well as for the annual Mexican Independence Day Kermes from noon to 6:00, during which there will be food sales, music, dances, and more. The annual Oktoberfest will be Saturday, October 18th. It is always great when we are together. I hope you can join us. Know of my daily prayers for all of you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este fin de semana celebramos la Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz. La cruz es algo habitual en nuestras vidas. Comenzamos y terminamos nuestras oraciones y recibimos bendiciones con la señal de la cruz. Colgamos cruces en nuestras habitaciones y las llevamos en el cuello. Las cruces adornan nuestras iglesias, libros sagrados y devocionales. La cruz es omnipresente por su importancia, significado y poder. Aunque sea una parte ordinaria de nuestras vidas, es un símbolo extraordinario.

A través de la cruz de Cristo, el amor de Dios venció al pecado y a la muerte y nos ha ganado la salvación. Dios mismo entró en nuestro sufrimiento para que compartíramos Su gloria. Dios eligió redimirnos estando cerca de nosotros, compartiendo nuestro sufrimiento y venciendo la muerte por nosotros. Todo esto motivado por el amor: "No hay amor más grande que dar la vida por sus amigos" (Jn 15:13). Recuerden siempre el amor de nuestro Señor por ustedes. Aún cuando experimenten la cruz y el sufrimiento en sus propias vidas, eleven la mirada a la cruz de Cristo, recordando que Él está siempre con ustedes.

La noche antes de morir, al entrar en su pasión, nuestro Señor tomó pan y vino y dijo: "Esto es mi cuerpo... Este es el cáliz de mi sangre." En cada Eucaristía, se comparte con nosotros la ofrenda perfecta y amorosa en la cruz del Calvario, que ha vencido a la muerte misma. En la misa, no imitamos a Cristo en su Última Cena, sino que nos unimos al Señor Resucitado, quien nos dio este santo sacramento en la Última Cena, un sacramento que nos alimenta y nos introduce en el misterio de nuestra salvación: "Anunciamos tu muerte, proclamamos tu resurrección. ¡Ven, Señor Jesús!" También clamamos a nuestro Señor: "Salvador del mundo, sálvanos, tú que nos has liberado por tu cruz y resurrección". Sigamos reconociendo la presencia de Cristo Resucitado y la realidad del amor del Salvador que nos comparte en cada misa.

Los invitamos a unirse a nosotros este domingo para disfrutar de donuts y convivencia después de la misa de las 9:30 y a la Kermés anual del Día de la Independencia de México, desde el mediodía hasta las 6:00 p.m., durante la cual habrá venta de comida, música, bailes y mucho más. El Oktoberfest anual será el sábado 18 de octubre. Siempre es un gozo estar juntos. Espero que puedan acompañarnos. Sepan que rezó diariamente por todos ustedes.
