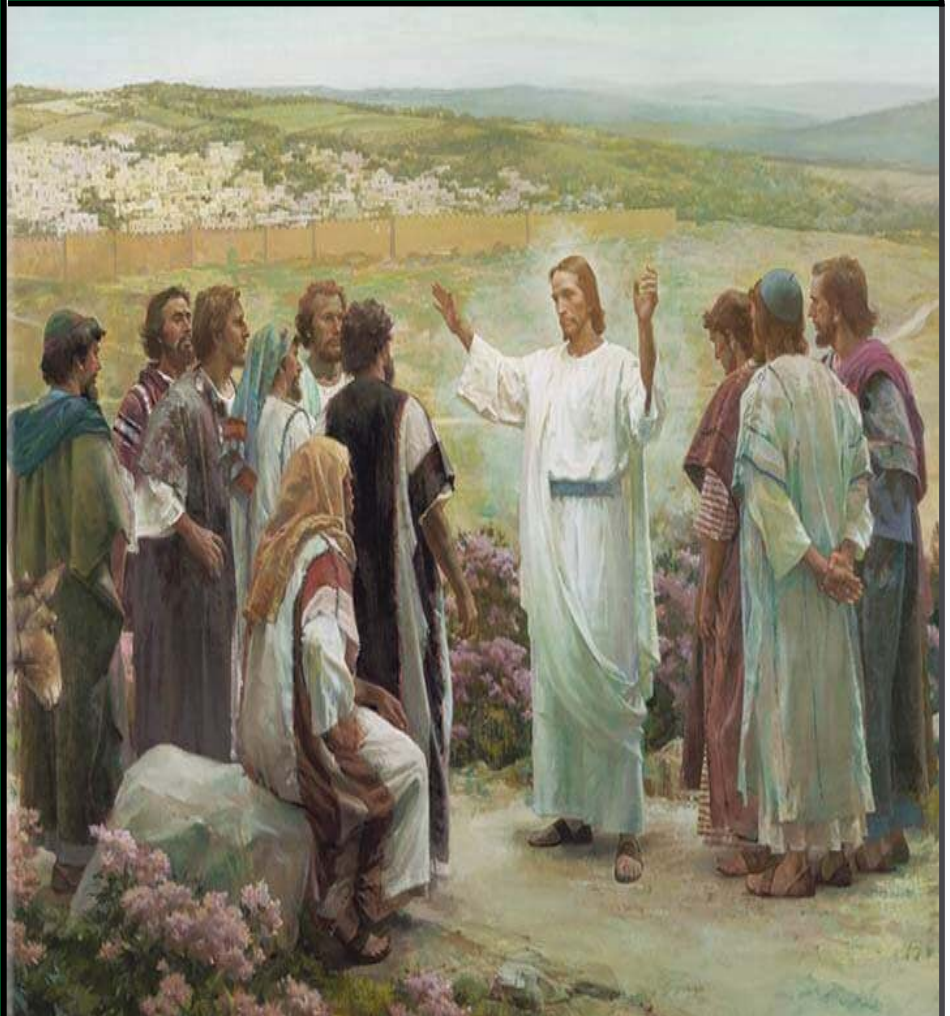

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, St. Matthew recounts, "At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.'" Our Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ, looks upon us with a loving heart. In a rare moment, He asks us to pray for a particular intention: for more laborers in the vineyard, for more servants to assist our Lord in the care of the flock. My hope is that we respond to our Lord's invitation and remember to regularly pray for more laborers in the vineyard, particularly for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. We were blessed to receive six new priests in our diocese last week. Let us continue to pray for and encourage more young men to be open to the call of the priesthood. This past Friday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, which is also the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. Let us pray our priests, that their hearts may be conformed to the heart of the Good Shepherd. After all, our Lord said in Jeremiah 3:15: "I will appoint for you shepherds after my own heart."

Not only was this past Friday the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, but the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. In honor of the 250th anniversary of the United States of America this year, the bishops of the United States together consecrated our country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus this past Thursday, the Vigil of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. May we continue to entrust our country, our community, and our homes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, following the Good Shepherd who loves us and cares for us through the sacraments of His Church and leads us to share in the eternal love of the Trinity in the paradise of heaven.

Please remember to join us on Sunday, June 28th, for the farewell reception for Fr. Roy, following the 9:30am and 1:00pm Masses as he prepares to serve as parochial vicar at St. Joseph Parish in Addison. Fr. Greg Skowron will then join us here at St. John Paul II. Know of my daily prayers for you. Please remember to pray for me and one another.

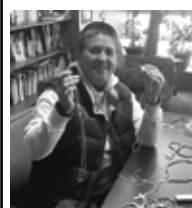

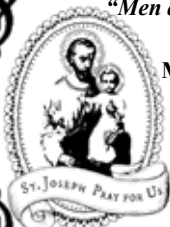
