Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

At the end of the great Jubilee Year of 2000, Pope St. John Paul II began his Apostolic Letter *Novo millennio ineunte* by inviting us “to remember the past with gratitude, to live the present with enthusiasm, and to look forward to the future with confidence: ‘Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever’ (Hb 13:8).” These words are just as true for us at the dawning of a new millennium as they are for us today. We must live with gratitude, enthusiasm, and confidence. Gratitude is essential. It recognizes the gifts we have received, acknowledges that we are the recipients, and then turns our hearts to express our affection and love to the giver of the gift. We express our gratitude first in word, verbally expressing our thanks, and then in action, taking care of the gifts and using them well. When we recognize Christ as the one through whom the Father bestows on the world all that is good (see the end of Eucharistic Prayer III), this changes our lives. We are compelled to thank Christ and give Him honor and glory in all that we do (personal, professional, social, environmental, etc.). In our readings this weekend, we hear how the work of God changed the lives of the lepers. In our first reading, Naaman was cured and then desired to give a gift to God in return. In the Gospel, Christ cured ten lepers, but only one returned to Christ to thank Him. We do not always recognize the gifts we receive, and when we do, we do not always take the time to recognize and thank the giver of the gifts. The lives of Naaman and the unnamed leper were changed not simply because they were healed, but because they then lived with a sense of enthusiasm and gratitude to God. Do we recognize the gifts God has given us, particularly that of eternal life? Christ has saved us from sin and death. He has cured our souls. Do we recognize the gifts of the Church, sacraments, prayer and grace? Do we recognize the gifts of human life, friendship, family, married life, consecrated life, priesthood, and our neighbors? Do we recognize the gifts of our physical bodies and the environment? Do we recognize the gifts of our talents and our work? There is so much to recognize, and we remember that it is Christ through whom all good things come. He is the source of truth, beauty, and goodness. May not a day pass by without us giving God thanks in word and deed. May God shape the entirety of our lives, and may we live in gratitude and love of God now and forever.

Don't forget to join us next Saturday for the annual Oktoberfest. It is a fun event, a great fundraiser, and a joy when we come together as a parish family. Know of my prayers for all of you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Al final del Gran Jubileo del 2000, el Papa San Juan Pablo II comenzó su Carta Apostólica *Novo millennio ineunte* invitándonos “a recordar con gratitud el pasado, a vivir con pasión el presente y a abrirnos con confianza al futuro: ‘Jesucristo es el mismo, ayer, hoy y siempre’ (Hb 13,8).” Estas palabras son tan ciertas al inicio de un nuevo milenio como lo son para nosotros hoy. Debemos vivir con gratitud, entusiasmo y confianza. La gratitud es esencial; reconoce los dones que hemos recibido, que somos los recipientes y luego vuelve a nuestros corazones para expresar nuestro afecto y amor al dador del regalo. Expresamos nuestra gratitud primero en palabra, expresando verbalmente nuestro agradecimiento, y luego por acción, cuidando los dones y usándolos bien. Cuando reconocemos a Cristo como aquel por quien el Padre concede al mundo todos los bienes (ver el final de la Plegaria Eucarística III), nuestras vidas son transformadas: agradecemos a Cristo y le damos honor y gloria en todo lo que hacemos (personal, profesional, social, ambiental, etc.). En nuestras lecturas de este domingo, escuchamos cómo la obra de Dios cambió la vida de los leprosos. En nuestra primera lectura, Naamán fue curado y luego deseó dar un regalo a Dios. En el Evangelio, Cristo curó a diez leprosos, pero solo uno volvió a Cristo para agradecerle. A veces no reconocemos los regalos que recibimos, y cuando lo hacemos, a veces no reconocemos ni agradecemos al dador de los regalos. Las vidas de Naamán y del leproso cambiaron no solo porque fueron sanados, sino porque luego vivieron con un sentido de entusiasmo y gratitud hacia Dios. ¿Reconocemos los dones que Dios nos ha dado, particularmente el de la vida eterna? Cristo nos ha salvado del pecado y de la muerte. Él ha curado nuestras almas. ¿Reconocemos los dones de la Iglesia, los sacramentos, la oración y la gracia? ¿Reconocemos los dones de la vida humana, la amistad, la familia, la vida matrimonial, la vida consagrada, el sacerdocio y el prójimo? ¿Reconocemos los dones de nuestros cuerpos físicos y el medio ambiente? ¿Reconocemos los dones de nuestros talentos y nuestros trabajos? Hay tanto que reconocer y recordemos que es Cristo a través de quien vienen todos los bienes. Él es la fuente de la verdad, la belleza y la bondad. Que no pase un día sin que demos gracias a Dios en palabra y obra. Que Dios transforme la totalidad de nuestras vidas y que vivamos en gratitud y amor a Dios ahora y para siempre.

No olviden acompañarnos el próximo sábado al Oktoberfest anual. Es un evento divertido, una gran recaudación de fondos y una alegría cuando nos reunimos como familia parroquial. Sepan que rezo por todos ustedes.


