

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, in the earliest days of the Church, we see Jesus being a bit demanding. To the seventy-two disciples being sent out to every town and place He intended to visit, Jesus says, "Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way" (Lk 10:3-4a). Why such strict requirements on these first ministers of his?

For humility, integrity, generosity, and joy. Christ wanted to keep the seventy-two focused on the mission to proclaim the Kingdom of God. This mission is unlike any other mission. It is not theirs, but it is Christ's. Christ has come to proclaim the Kingdom of God and spread it, and He does it through us. By demanding simplicity on the seventy-two, Christ was reminding them to rely on Him and to know that it is Christ who works through them. As the seventy-two went out to glorify our Heavenly Father, Christ did not want them to be distracted. He did not want them to see their mission as a 9 to 5 job, but something that is woven and accomplished throughout their daily lives. He wanted them to be free to simply proclaim the Kingdom of God. This freedom from the cares of the world enabled them to be free to joyfully and generously care for God's people.

Most of us are not called to the same degree of poverty as the seventy-two: we have families, jobs, etc. However, all of us are sent out to proclaim the Good News where we are: in our families, places of work, our schools, our friendships, and our community organizations. It is good for us to reflect on the role of simplicity, humility, and joy in our daily lives. Do we allow a lot of distractions in our lives, or are we free to spread the Good News and love of Christ? Are we open to and aware of Christ working through us and in our lives?

May Christ continue to bless you and your loved ones. Know of my prayers for you always. Please continue to pray for me and one another.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

En el Evangelio de hoy, en los primeros días de la Iglesia, vemos que Jesús es un poco estricto. A los setenta y dos discípulos que son enviados a cada pueblo y lugar que Él quería visitar, Jesús dice: "Pónganse en camino; yo los envíé como corderos en medio de lobos. No lleven ni dinero, ni morral, ni sandalias y no se detengan a saludar a nadie por el camino". (Lc 10: 3-4a) ¿Por qué tan estrictos requisitos para estos primeros ministros suyos?

Por la humildad, la integridad, la generosidad y la alegría. Cristo quería mantener a los setenta y dos enfocados en la misión de proclamar el Reino de Dios. Esta misión es diferente de otras misiones. El trabajo no es de ellos, sino de Cristo. Cristo ha venido a proclamar el Reino de Dios y difundirlo, y lo hace por medio de nosotros. Al exigir simplicidad en los setenta y dos, Cristo les recordaba que confiaran en Él y que supieran que es Cristo quien obra por medio de ellos. Cuando los setenta y dos salieron a glorificar a nuestro Padre Celestial, Cristo no quería que se distrajeran. Él no quería que vieran su misión como un trabajo de 9 a 5, sino como algo que se teje y se logra a lo largo de su vida diaria. Quería que fueran libres para proclamar el Reino de Dios. Esta liberación de las preocupaciones del mundo les permitió ser libres para cuidar con alegría y generosidad del pueblo de Dios.

La mayoría de nosotros no estamos llamados al mismo grado de pobreza que los setenta y dos: tenemos familias, trabajos, etc. Sin embargo, todos somos enviados a proclamar la Buena Nueva donde estamos: en nuestras familias, lugares de trabajo, escuelas, amistades y organizaciones comunitarias. Es bueno para nosotros reflexionar en el rol de simplicidad, humildad y alegría en nuestras vidas diarias. ¿Permitimos muchas distracciones en nuestras vidas, o somos libres de difundir la Buena Nueva y el amor de Cristo? ¿Estamos abiertos y conscientes de que Cristo trabaja a través de nosotros y en nuestras vidas?

Que Cristo continúe bendiciéndoles a ustedes y sus seres queridos. Conozcan mis oraciones por ustedes y, por favor, sigan rezando por mí y por los demás.

Fr. J. Rodolphe Arty, C.S.C. (also known as Fr. Dof) is a Catholic priest who entered the Congregation of Holy Cross in 1986. Originally from Haiti, he grew up in a multicultural environment. He was ordained a priest on December 29, 1994, after studying theology at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome.

Fr. Arty's ministry experience includes spiritual retreats, pastoral work, and education, where he taught high school and served as assistant director of the Holy Cross Seminary. He has held leadership roles within his religious order in Haiti as District Superior and Provincial Superior. His parish experience includes serving as Parochial Vicar at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, Pastor at St. Patrick's Parish, and Assistant Pastor at St. Isaac Jogues Parish.

He is described as courageous and someone who brings hope and enjoys connecting with people from diverse backgrounds.

El P. J. Rodolphe Arty, C.S.C. (también conocido como P. Dof) es un sacerdote católico que ingresó en la Congregación de Santa Cruz en 1986. Originario de Haití, creció en un entorno multicultural. Fue ordenado sacerdote el 29 de diciembre de 1994, tras estudiar teología en la Pontificia Universidad Gregoriana de Roma.

La experiencia ministerial del P. Arty incluye retiros espirituales, trabajo pastoral y educación, donde fue profesor de secundaria y subdirector del Seminario de la Santa Cruz. Ha desempeñado funciones de liderazgo dentro de su orden religiosa en Haití como Superior de Distrito y Superior Provincial. Su experiencia parroquial incluye el cargo de vicario parroquial en la parroquia de Santo Tomás Apóstol, párroco en la parroquia de San Patricio y vice-párroco en la parroquia de San Isaac Jogues.

Se le describe como una persona valiente que trae esperanza y disfruta conectando con personas de diversos orígenes.

She is a member of the Oikos Sisters, a small community of nuns who have dedicated their lives to serving the poor. *One of your very own parishioners, Steve Kelly missioned with the Oikos Sisters last year!*

The Sisters minister to those living in very poor barrios (villages) in distant outlying areas, many that have been devastated by the typhoons that visit their regions frequently. They have an education sponsorship program, a garden project enabling families to grow their own food, a dental clinic and a charity pharmacy providing free medicine (the only one in their area) to name just a few.

This year 'Pilgrims of Hope' is the theme for Jubilee Year 2025 named by Pope Francis. Sr. Sarah will tell us heartwarming stories full of hope about the people the Oikos Sisters serve.

It amazes us all how these eight Sisters and two novices are able to serve so many and doing it *all* on donations. Their lives are not easy ones but they are filled with joy as they are committed to do God's work and care for whomever comes to their door in need.

Come hear the Oikos Sisters' story at all July 5-6 Masses. Her stories will surely touch your hearts!

Este año, "Peregrinos de Esperanza" es el lema del Año Jubilar 2025 proclamado por el Papa Francisco. La Hna. Sarah nos contará historias conmovedoras y llenas de Esperanza sobre las personas a las que ellas sirven.

A todos nos sorprende cómo estas ocho hermanas y dos novicias son capaces de servir a tantas personas y hacerlo todo con donaciones. Sus vidas no son fáciles, pero están llenas de alegría, ya que están comprometidas a hacer el trabajo de Dios y a cuidar de quienquiera necesitado que llegue a su puerta.
