Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of November is set aside for remembering and praying for the faithful departed. We began the month with All Saints' Day, celebrating the Church triumphant in heaven and asking for their intercession. The following day, November 2nd, we remembered the faithful departed. During the noon Mass we lit candles in memory of those who have died this past year. People have brought pictures of their deceased loved ones, which will remain in the church until next weekend, and we remember in our prayers those who have died whose names you have written in our Book of Remembrance.

When we speak about what happens after death, I find that there is often confusion around purgatory. For the most part, we understand heaven and hell, but purgatory seems less clear to many. When speaking about purgatory in sections 1030 through 1032, the Catechism says: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." It references St. Gregory the Great, who died in 604 and taught that, "As for certain lesser faults, we must believe that, before the Final Judgment, there is a purifying fire." St. John Chrysostom, who died in 407, said, "Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them." This practice of praying for the dead is mentioned in the Bible: "In doing this [Judas Maccabeus] acted in a very excellent and noble way, inasmuch as he had the resurrection of the dead in view... If he did this with a view to the splendid reward that awaits those who had gone to rest in godliness, it was a holy and pious thought. Thus he made atonement for the dead that they might be freed from this sin" (cf. 2 Macc. 12:43-46). Confident in God's mercy and love after we depart from this world, let us continue to invoke our Lord and ask for His grace and pardon upon our loved ones. Let us offer Masses, rosaries, and prayers at the cemetery. What a holy and pious act it is to pray for those who have gone before us. May they rest in the peace of Christ.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

El mes de noviembre está dedicado para recordar y orar por los fieles difuntos. Comenzamos el mes con el Día de Todos los Santos, celebrando a la Iglesia triunfante en el cielo y pidiendo su intercesión. Al día siguiente, el 2 de noviembre, recordamos a los fieles difuntos. Durante la misa del mediodía, encendimos velas en memoria de quienes fallecieron el año pasado. Personas trajeron fotos de sus seres queridos fallecidos, las cuales permanecerán en la iglesia hasta el próximo fin de semana y, recordamos en nuestras oraciones a aquellos que murieron cuyos nombres ustedes han escrito en nuestro Libro Memorial.

Cuando hablamos sobre de lo que sucede después de la muerte, a veces hay confusión sobre el purgatorio. En su mayor parte, entendemos el cielo y el infierno, pero el purgatorio parece menos claro para muchos. Al hablar sobre el purgatorio en las secciones 1030 a 1032, el Catecismo dice: "Los que mueren en la gracia y en la amistad de Dios, pero imperfectamente purificados, aunque están seguros de su eterna salvación, sufren después de su muerte una purificación, a fin de obtener la santidad necesaria para entrar en la alegría del cielo." Se refiere a San Gregorio Magno, quien murió en 604 y enseñó que: "Respecto a ciertas faltas ligeras, es necesario creer que, antes del juicio, existe un fuego purificador..." San Juan Crisóstomo, quien murió en 407, dijo: "Llevémosles socorros y hagamos su conmemoración. Si los hijos de Job fueron purificados por el sacrificio de su padre, ¿por qué dudaríamos que nuestras ofrendas por los muertos les den algo de consuelo? No dudemos, pues, en socorrer a los que han partido y en ofrecer nuestras plegarias por ellos." Esta práctica de orar por los difuntos está mencionada en la Biblia: "Las mandó [Judas] a Jerusalén para ofrecer un sacrificio por el pecado, obrando muy hermosa y noblemente, pensando en la resurrección... Si lo hizo con miras a la magnífica recompensa reservada a aquellos que duermen piadosamente, fue un pensamiento santo y piadoso. Por eso mandó hacer este sacrificio expiatorio en favor de los muertos, para que quedaran liberados del pecado" (cf. 2 Mac. 12: 43-46). Confidados en la misericordia y el amor de Dios que duran para siempre, sigamos invocando a nuestro Señor y pidiendo su gracia y perdón para nuestros seres queridos. Ofrezcamos misas, rosarios y oraciones en el cementerio. Orar por los que nos han precedido es una acción santa y piadosa. Que descansen en la paz de Cristo.




