



A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we celebrate Laetare Sunday, which means "Rejoice." We are over halfway through our Lenten penances, and so this rose-colored Sunday in the midst of the purple season of Lent reminds us that the light of the Risen Lord will soon conquer the darkness of sin and death. Our time of celebration is drawing near. The great Feast of our Redemption is approaching. Holy Week begins in two weeks, and then we will celebrate the Paschal Mystery (the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord), by which God in His love and mercy has conquered sin and death and redeemed us.

As we prepare for Easter on April 20th, there are a few events I would like to bring to your attention. The celebrations of the Holy Triduum (from the evening of Holy Thursday through the evening of Easter Sunday) work together to help us enter into the mystery of Christ suffering, death, and resurrection for our salvation. In addition to the Masses on Easter Sunday, the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday at 6 pm, the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday (3:00 pm in English and 7:00 pm in Spanish), and the Mass of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday at 7:45 pm are all moving celebrations that help us to truly enter into the Sacred Triduum. When we walk with Jesus from Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday, we discover that it is He who walks with us and lifts us up. Other liturgies celebrated during Holy Week include lauds (Morning Prayer) at 7:30 am on Holy Thursday and Good Friday and at 8:00 am on Holy Saturday and Tenebrae on Wednesday, April 16, at 7 pm. The Settles Center will be open for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament on Holy Thursday from 7 pm until midnight. Stations of the Cross on Good Friday will be in English at noon, and the Spanish Living Stations of the Cross will be at 5 pm on Good Friday. There will be reflections on the Seven Last Words of Christ on Tuesday, April 15, at 7 pm. The Easter Basket Blessing, which is when families are invited to bring the food for the Easter meal to be blessed, will be on Holy Saturday at noon, followed by the annual Easter Egg Hunt.

Please continue to pray for one another, and know of my continued prayers for you and your loved ones during this most sacred season of Lent.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este fin de semana celebramos el Domingo de Laetare, que significa "Alégrese". Estamos a más de la mitad de nuestras penitencias de Cuaresma, por eso el color rosa de este domingo en medio del morado de la Cuaresma, nos recuerda que la luz del Señor resucitado pronto vencerá las tinieblas del pecado y la muerte.

Nuestro tiempo de celebración se acerca. La gran fiesta de nuestra redención se acerca. La Semana Santa comienza en dos semanas y luego celebraremos el Misterio Pascual (la Pasión, Muerte y la Resurrección de nuestro Señor), por el cual Dios, en Su amor y misericordia, ha vencido al pecado y a la muerte y nos ha redimido.

Mientras nos preparamos para la Pascua, el 20 de abril, hay eventos sobre los que me gustaría llamar su atención. Las celebraciones del Santo Triduo (desde la tarde del Jueves Santo hasta la tarde del Domingo de Pascua) trabajan juntas para ayudarnos a entrar en el misterio de Cristo sufriendo, muriendo y resucitando por nosotros. Además de las misas del Domingo de Pascua, la misa bilingüe de la Cena del Señor el Jueves Santo a las 6:00 pm, la Celebración de la Pasión del Señor el Viernes Santo (3:00 pm en inglés y 7:00 pm en español) y la misa bilingüe del Sábado de Gloria a las 7:45 pm, son todas celebraciones poderosas que nos ayudan a entrar en el Sagrado Triduo. Cuando caminamos con Jesús desde el Jueves Santo hasta el Domingo de Resurrección, descubrimos que es Él quien camina con nosotros y nos sostiene. Otras liturgias celebradas durante la Semana Santa incluyen Laudes (oración de la mañana) el Jueves Santo y Viernes Santo a las 7:30 am, el Sábado Santo a las 8:00 am y Tenebrae el miércoles 16 de abril a las 7:00 pm. El Settles Center (el gimnasio) estará abierto para la oración ante el Santísimo Sacramento el Jueves Santo desde las 7:00 pm hasta la medianoche. El Vía Crucis Viviente del Viernes Santo será a las 5:00 pm en español. Habrá reflexiones sobre las Siete Últimas Palabras de Cristo el martes 15 de abril a las 7:00 pm. La Bendición de Canastas de Pascua, cuando se invita a las familias a que traigan sus alimentos para la comida de Pascua para ser bendecidas, será el Sábado Santo al mediodía, seguida de la Búsqueda Anual de Huevos de Pascua.

Por favor, sigamos orando los unos por los otros. Rezo por ustedes y sus seres queridos durante esta temporada sagrada de la Cuaresma.

Later, the Pro-Life crowd was huge and energetic in front of the Capitol building, with the Bishop of Springfield, Thomas John Joseph Paprocki, leading the crowd in the St Michael prayer. After the rally, everyone marched around the Capitol building. Some were chanting, some singing, some praying; all looking with hope to the end of this culture of death, to celebrating life from conception until natural death.

St. John Paul II parents with students in kindergarten through 12th grade may apply. PRESCHOOL STUDENTS ARE NOT ELEGIBLE.






