

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion - April 13, 2025
Domingo de Ramos De la pasión del Señor - 13 de Abril, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this day, the Sunday before our Lord's death and Resurrection, the disciples of Jesus praised Him as He entered Jerusalem, "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest." However, the tone abruptly changed, and only a few days later, the palm and olive branches were replaced by the wood of the cross. On Palm Sunday, Christ was lifted up by shouts of praise. On Good Friday, Christ was lifted up on the cross to shouts of condemnation and then lowered into a tomb. On Easter Sunday, Christ was lifted up again in glory so that we may be lifted up by His mercy and grace into the eternal Kingdom of Heaven.

Hosanna is not only the song of the first disciples; it is our song. We acclaim it at every Mass as we give our offering to our Savior: "Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest." Holy Week is remembered and realized in every Mass, which is when Christ comes to us, receives our offering of praise, and unites it to His perfect and salvific offering on the cross, which He established on Holy Thursday as He entered into His Passion. The Eucharist is the perpetual memorial of the sacrifice of Christ, recalling the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus (see 1 Cor. 11:23-26). Every Mass reaches back to the sacrifice of Christ, and in His perfect and eternal love for us, He gives Himself to us, holding nothing back so that He might be our strength and our salvation.

My prayer is that as we walk with Jesus this Holy Week, remembering the most powerful, humble, and loving act that has changed the course of history, we may also become ever more aware of the timelessness of Jesus' loving act of redemption, memorialized in the very sacrament Jesus instituted as He began His work of salvation on Holy Thursday: the Holy Eucharist, the Mass.

May this week be an opportunity to see, know, and love Christ as well as be a time for renewal: renewing our faith and our awareness of Christ's presence, mercy, and redemption. I encourage you to take part in the special liturgies and devotions this week.

May each and every one of you have a blessed and fruitful Holy Week and a Happy Easter.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

En este día, el domingo antes de la muerte y la resurrección del Señor, los discípulos de Jesús lo alabaron al entrar en Jerusalén: "¡Hosanna! ¡Viva el Hijo de David! ¡Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor! ¡Hosanna en el cielo!" Sin embargo, el tono cambió abruptamente y, sólo unos días después, las palmas y ramas de olivo fueron reemplazadas por el madero de la cruz. El Domingo de Ramos, Cristo fue levantado en gritos de alabanza. El Viernes Santo, fue levantado en la cruz con gritos de condenación y luego bajado al sepulcro. El Domingo de Pascua, Cristo fue levantado en gloria de nuevo para que así seamos levantados por Su misericordia y gracia al Reino eterno del Cielo.

Hosanna no es solo el cántico de los primeros discípulos; es nuestro canto. Lo aclamamos en cada misa al ofrecer nuestra ofrenda a nuestro Salvador: "Santo, Santo, Santo es el Señor, Dios del universo. Llenos están el cielo y la tierra de tu gloria. Hosanna en el cielo. Bendito el que viene en nombre del Señor. Hosanna en el cielo." La Semana Santa se recuerda y se celebra en cada misa, cuando Cristo viene a nosotros, recibe nuestra ofrenda de alabanza y la une a su ofrenda perfecta y salvífica en la cruz, la cual instituyó el Jueves Santo al entrar en su Pasión. La Eucaristía es el memorial perpetuo del sacrificio de Cristo, que recuerda la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesús (cf. 1 Cor. 11:23-26). Cada misa se remonta al sacrificio de Cristo, y en su amor perfecto y eterno por nosotros, Él se entrega a nosotros sin reservas para ser nuestra fuerza y nuestra salvación.

Mi oración es que, al caminar con Jesús esta Semana Santa, recordando el acto más poderoso, humilde y amoroso que ha cambiado el curso de la historia, estemos más conscientes de la intemporalidad del acto amoroso de redención de Jesús, conmemorado en el mismo sacramento que Jesús instituyó al comenzar su obra de salvación el Jueves Santo: la Sagrada Eucaristía, la misa.

Que esta semana sea una oportunidad para ver, conocer y amar a Cristo, así como un tiempo de renovación: renovar nuestra fe y nuestra conciencia de la presencia, la misericordia y la redención de Cristo. Los animo a participar en las devociones y liturgias especiales de Semana Santa y el Domingo de la Pascua de la Resurrección.

Que todos y cada uno de ustedes tengan una Semana Santa bendecida y fructífera y una feliz Pascua.



FROM OUR DIOCESE

STRENGTHENING THE CHURCH AT HOME



Close to 40% of dioceses in the United States and its current and former territories are considered “home mission dioceses,” meaning that local conditions such as small, widely dispersed Catholic populations and economic hardships prevent those dioceses from operating their ministries without outside support. For example, with the smallest Catholic population in the 48 continental United States, spread across 66,800 square miles of mountainous terrain and rugged Oregon desert, the Diocese of Baker is so extensive that many parishes are a minimum of 50 miles from each other, and only one town has more than one parish.

Support provided to the diocese from the Catholic Home Missions Appeal covered the cost of having a priest in residence for two rural parishes.

Without this support, more than 400 parishioners would not be able to receive the sacraments regularly. The work of Catholic Home Missions in the diocese extends beyond such basic support to include its family life enhancement program, which helps parishes overcome the isolation that families experienced during the pandemic, isolation that has become an ongoing challenge in rural communities.

What Is a “Home Mission” Diocese?

Home mission dioceses are those Catholic dioceses in the United States, its territories, and former territories that cannot provide basic pastoral services without outside help. Basic pastoral services include Mass, the sacraments, religious education, and ministry training for priests, deacons, religious sisters, and lay people. Nearly 40% of dioceses in the United States and its territories are considered home mission dioceses.
