A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

UNA CARTA DEL PÁRROCO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Conversations have changed a lot in the last decade and a half. They have a lot more interruptions. When there is a question or a doubt, somebody inevitably goes to their phone to google the answer. It is remarkable how much information we have at our fingertips. Additionally, I know that I feel lost without the phone because of its many apps and features. If I schedule an appointment or make a commitment, what do I do? I put it on the calendar on my phone. If I need a calculator, I go to my phone and use the calculator app. If I want to take a picture, I use my phone. Yet, the amount of information able to be received and the tasks to be accomplished on the phone pale in comparison to what the Word of God can do, which is, as our second reading tells us, “living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart” (see Heb. 4:12-13). I encourage you to listen carefully to the word of God proclaimed at Mass and to read the Bible or the daily Mass readings every day. However, we do not want to read it simply for the sake of reading it. Through the reading of Sacred Scripture, we want to know God, the story of salvation, and God’s will for us and allow the Word to transform us. The Bible shows us the way and forms our lives. While watching a documentary on the Civil War, I was struck by the letters of the young soldiers. Many of them had minimal education, and yet they wrote eloquently. Their words were beautiful, confident, and filled with hope. From where did these words come? The Bible. It formed their vocabulary and their communication with their loved ones. May our prayers and devotional practices form us as well. Let us stay close to our Lord, listening to Him in prayer and allowing Him to shape our lives.

Don’t forget to join us next Sunday for our St. John Paul II Festival. It is important for us to come together as a community, especially in honor of our patron saint, whose feast day is October 22nd. Also, with joy and gratitude, I am happy to bless the statue of the “Pregnant Holy Family—Expecting” outside the church in the flower bed under the Faith Formation Center sign this weekend after the 8:00 a.m. Mass. The plaque on the base of the statue has a quote from Pope St. John Paul II: “The family is the heart of the culture of life.” I am grateful to the pro-life committee and David Panozzo for this beautiful depiction of the dignity of human life and the family. Know of my daily prayers for all of you. Please continue to remember me and one another in prayer as well.

Si necesito una calculadora, uso la aplicación de la calculadora en mi teléfono. Si quiero tomar una foto, uso mi teléfono. Sin embargo, la cantidad de información y los deberes que se pueden realizar por el teléfono palidecen en comparación con lo que la Palabra de Dios puede hacer, que es, como dice nuestra segunda lectura, “viva, eficaz y más penetrante que una espada de dos filos. Llega hasta lo más íntimo del alma, hasta la médula de los huesos y descubre los pensamientos e intenciones del corazón”. (Hebreos 4: 12-13).

Los animo a escuchar con atención la Palabra de Dios proclamada en la misa y a leer la Biblia o las lecturas de la misa cada día. Sin embargo, no queremos leerla simplemente por leerla. A través de las lecturas de la Sagrada Escritura, queremos conocer a Dios, la historia de la salvación y la voluntad de Dios para nosotros y permitir que la Palabra nos transforme. La Biblia nos muestra el camino y forma nuestras vidas. Hace unos años, mientras mirando un documental sobre la Guerra Civil, me sorprendieron las cartas de los soldados jóvenes. Es importante que nos reunamos como comunidad, especialmente en honor a nuestro santo patrono, cuya festividad es el 22 de octubre. Además, con alegría y gratitud, bendigo la estatua de la “Sagrada Familia Embarazada – Esperando” que se encuentra afuera de la iglesia, en el huerto de flores, debajo del letrero del Centro de Formación en la Fe, este fin de semana después de la Misa de 8:00 a.m. La placa en la base de la estatua tiene una cita del Papa San Juan Pablo II: “La familia es el corazón de la cultura de la vida”. Agradezco al comité provida y a David Panozzo por esta hermosa representación de la dignidad de la vida humana y la familia. Sepan de mis oraciones diarias por todos ustedes. Por favor, sigan recordándome a mí y al igual que a los demás en oración.
