## **DISCUSSION:**

- 1. Association's Updates Need to register for BC societies for 2024, cost of insurance for 2025 to date \$117, cost for meeting refreshments \$20.95. Dues collected total = \$10
- 2. 2024 Budget—Balance \$734.47. Current CHRA funds total \$972.97, and with\$170 cash on hand.
- Pollinator Field NSG funded for 2025 requested for \$500. Also, Bob asked the city to apply for grant money from BC Hydro, and \$900 was granted. The next volunteering event will be in late April/ May – date to be confirmed.
- 4. The Meet & Greet event will be discussed in the future. Possible for fall.
- 5. Nominations for the CHRA Board, moved to next meeting
- 6. Neighbourhood Small Grants—Applications for funds are open until April 15th. A typical grant is \$500. The event must be completed by November 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 7. The group suggested having a booth at the next School Carnival. Sally spoke about the benefits of hosting a table and the need for more volunteers. Last year's event helped raise awareness, and as a membership drive, several new members were added to the distribution mail-out list. Possibly donate a prize.
- 8. Complaints about the 7/11 being gone and the lack of places to purchase groceries in the neighbourhood, e.g., 'food desert.'
- 9. The next meeting is to have a poster with a QR code. Distributed to a few spots. Invite a neighbour.
- 10. Motion to invite Liaison Councilor Daniel Fontaine, 2<sup>nd</sup> and voted in favour.
- 11. A suggestion was made to have a guest speaker at the next meeting. A motion proposed spending up to \$50 on an honorarium. Additional ideas included having a guest speaker on a common interest and fun topic, such as gardening, professional speaking, or demonstrating their skills.
