I know there is a pack of 4 wolves in the area where I hunt yet my trail cams are capturing photos of all classes of bucks from spikes to 8+ points and many different bucks within the 6-8 point class. The deer came through last winter and summer in top condition. I have had to protect my apple and young oak trees from the overabundance of deer!

saw no wolves

Wolves aren't the problem, uneducated deer hunters are.

I haven't seen any Wolves yet. Mostly just Coyote tracks and yips in the evening. Lots of deer sign. Warm weather has made it not so fun to go out combined with just don't have time.

A wolf pack uses my property yet they are not impacting the deer. Many of the bucks I am seeing on my trail cam are 6-8 points and larger. Also seeing many spikes and 4 points.

Results vary by geographic area...I hunter several U.P. counties...Houghton and Baraga counties are looking good this season compared to last, but Iron county for example was dismal.

Deer numbers are way down in the eastern UP.

Deer seem to be very on edge even in early bow season when there isn't a lot of human pressure. Seeing way less deer in general as well.

Looks like we are down about a third from last year
