

2025 SCSBL Awards Criteria

All-Star Teams

Eligibility:

- Each team selects 3 players to be placed on the All-Star ballot
- Players must have played in at least 6 regular-season games

Voting Pool:

- A total of 20 players will make up the All-Star pool
 - 18 players selected (3 per team)
 - 2 additional players added by the Commissioner
- Each voter selects 10 out of 20 eligible players
 - Coaches may not vote for their own players
 - All other voters may vote for any of the 20 eligible

Voting Process:

- Voting conducted via Google Doc
- Voting window: Opens June 18 at 12:00 PM, closes June 21 at 12:00 PM

Scoring System:

- 1st = 10 pts
- 2nd = 9 pts
- 3rd = 8 pts
- 4th = 7 pts
- 5th = 6 pts
- 6th = 5 pts

- 7th = 4 pts
- 8th = 3 pts
- 9th = 2 pts
- 10th = 1 pt

Selections:

- Top 5 vote-getters = First Team All-Stars
- Next 5 vote-getters = Second Team All-Stars

Tiebreaker:

- Most ballot appearances
- If still tied, the Commissioner will decide

League MVP

- Must have played in at least 6 regular-season games
- Awarded to the player with the most total All-Star points
- No separate MVP ballot - calculated directly from All-Star voting totals

Breakthrough Player of the Year

Eligibility:

- Must have played in at least 6 regular-season games
- Must not have been selected to an All-Star team in any prior season
- First- and second-year players who are rising sophomores or below
- Recognized for consistent impact on all aspects of the game

Voting Format:

- Ballot includes all eligible players
- Coaches are NOT allowed to vote for their own players
- Each voter selects 1 player
- Most votes wins

Defensive Player of the Year

Eligibility:

- Must have played in at least 6 regular-season games
- Recognized for impact in on-ball defense, rebounding, steals, blocks, etc.

Voting Format:

- Ballot consists of the original 20-player All-Star pool
- Coaches are NOT allowed to vote for their own players

- Each voter selects 1 player
- Most votes wins
