



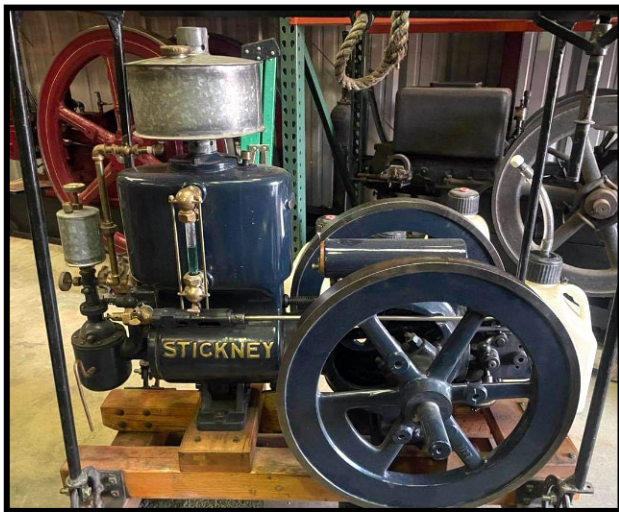

A TRIBUTE TO A FATHER

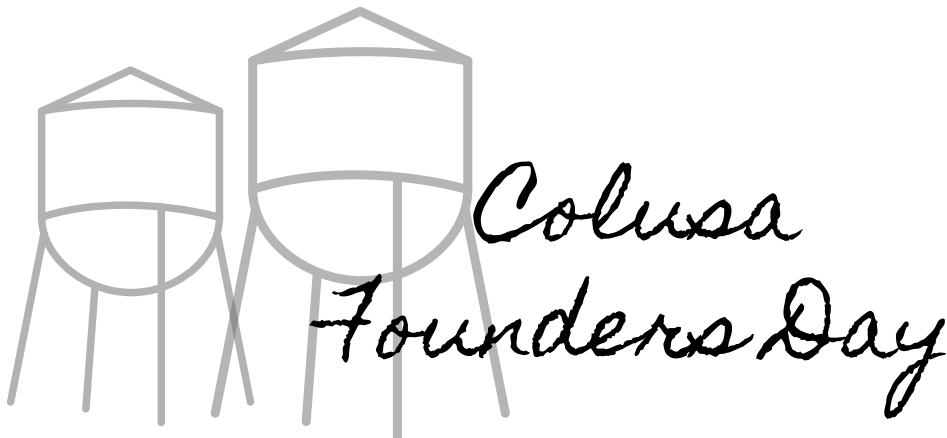

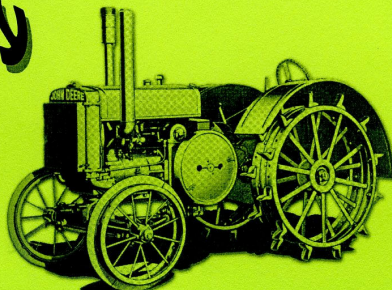
